The winter holidays are a time to enjoy the company of friends, family, and co-workers. Where does substance use fit into this picture? Holiday parties give more chances to use drugs and alcohol resulting in an increase in drug- and alcohol-related tragedies.

The widespread availability of alcohol at holiday parties gives our youth many opportunities to sneak alcohol or to convince a relative to let them enjoy "just one" alcoholic drink.

So you might ask, where is the harm in that?

- The younger a child is when he starts to drink, the more likely he
 or she will have alcohol-related problems later in life.
- Alcohol use by teens affects still-developing brains and impairs memory and learning.
- Teens who drink are more likely to commit or be the victim of violence and to experience stress, depression and suicidal thoughts.

By allowing underage drinking during the holidays, adults deprive teens of clear, common sense and consistent guidelines they need to make good choices all year long. It is clear that parents who talk with their teens about underage drinking, set expectations for behavior, and enforce consequences for violating the rules are significantly less likely to have children who use alcohol.

Orleans United encourages more dialogue around underage drinking- especially before and during the holiday season. The conversation should not be whether the behavior is right or wrong, but rather the health effects to the developing brain and bodies of our youth.

OPENING DAY AT CAMP

It started out as a perfect day to spend in the woods. When the cabin was left it was still dark, but the temperature was 47° (later it got up to 61°) and the stars were showing with no wind; it was not a normal mid-November morning!

A tree stand near the cabin was chosen for the first day of the gun season for deer. It was actually a stand set up for archery, but offered good observation and coverage for gun, too. Bow season is always looked forward to as its a great time to be in the woods; the temperatures are mild, the deer are not yet on high alert,

and the clean fresh smell of fall flows through the air. However, this year I had to bypass bow season due to some shoulder injuries, but this morning I was getting the same kind of conditions.

I picked this particular stand because it showed good deer activity, it was close to the cabin (something important when your legs are not what they used to be), there was going to be drastic change in the weather and I had a nearby tent-type ground blind I could retreat to if the weather got really bad. They did in fact predict fast-dropping temperatures with rain and then snow and high winds, all of which would probably send deer into the nearby thickets which I could oversee.

As the first light began to show I thought that even if no deer showed up it was going to be a super relaxing morning, until that predicted storm hit. That didn't last long as about 7:15 a.m., a wide-racked eight-point came strutting out of the thicket like he owned the woods. He was headed right toward me, but the problem was I had to turn 180 degrees to get the shotgun pointed in his direction. Deer eyes are super at detecting movement so this had to be done slowly and preferably when his view was slightly obstructed by a few bushes. However, it couldn't be done too slowly as his pace was such that he would be on top of me shortly and the chance of me being detected was greater.

The move was successfully made and the cross hairs were placed on his chest and just before the trigger was squeezed the thought ran by my mind on what the weird angle I had the gun at was going to do to my injured shoulder. However, big bucks have a way of making you forget everything else and the slug was off. He bolted and tore across the opening in front of me into another thicket; I held my breath and then it was heard, his death crash in the bush! I think my breath was being held from the moment I squeezed the trigger!

I took off my jacket and dropped it to the ground and then unloaded the gun and lowered it to the ground on my pullup cord. Getting out of the tree carefully (deer have a way of making you careless sometimes) and then loading the bolt-action shotgun again, the sneak over to the side of the thicket was made. Glancing into the tangle of bush his white rump with the wide rack above it caught my immediate attention and a sigh of relief was given.

When his side was reached some time was spent in admiration of his wide eightpoint antlers and his large, slick body. What a magnificent animal he was, and I was grateful not only that my tag could be put on him, but that his end had come swift and clean. There is always a moment when the hunter feels some sadness having taken the life of such a beautiful animal, and I had mine.

I returned to the cabin and shed my hunting clothing, putting on some old clothing for the task at hand. The ATV and a plastic sled was run over to the buck and some time was again spent to admire him and then there was the taking of pictures of him where he fell. The task of removing his entrails was completed after which he was given a ride in the sled to the meat pole.

A return to the tree stand to collect my pack and jacket was made and then back to the cabin to get things ready to leave camp the next day. By 11:30 a.m., the storm hit with a sudden drop in temperature (from 61° to 46° in half an hour) and high winds and rain. Everything had been readied for the trip home the next morning (I wanted to let him hang overnight to cool properly, especially after such a warm morning) and looking out the cabin window at the weather conditions I was glad I was inside!

The next morning was even worse with the rain changing to snow and wind blowing it all around. The buck was retrieved from the meat pole and put in the van and pointed in the direction of home. Road conditions were not bad until north of Arcade, but some caution was needed until Darien Lake was reached.

So my quest for this year's buck was short lived and I was given a dandy, but the season is not over. My son Jeff and I are headed back down for a few days after Thanksgiving and hopefully he will get as lucky as I did!

6 ounces semisweet chocolate 6 ounces very low-fat fromage frais 2 tablespoons confectioners' sugar 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract 1/2 ounces semisweet chocolate, grated

- 1. Break the chocolate into a bowl over a pan of simmering water. Let it melt, stirring occasionally.
- 2. In a separate bowl, whisk together the fromage frais and sugar. Whisk in the vanilla.
- 3. When the chocolate is melted and smooth, remove from the heat and allow to cool slightly. Slowly whisk the chocolate into the fromage frais mixture, using a rubber spatula to incorporate every bit of chocolate. Cover with plastic wrap and chill for an hour.



Signs of a Heart Attack

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense, but most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before betting help. Symptoms include:

CHEST DISCOMFORT. Most heart attacks involve discomfort in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or that goes away and comes back. It can feel like uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness

DISCOMFORT IN OTHER AREAS OF THE UPPER BODY. Symptoms can include pain or discomfort in one or both arms, the back, neck, jaw or

Signs of a Stroke

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

- 1) Ask the person to SMILE.
- 2) Ask the person to TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE. i.e. It is sunny out today.
- Ask the person to RAISE BOTH ARMS
- 4) Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

OTHER STROKE WARNING SIGNS

- Sudden numbness or weakness of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden confusion, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden trouble seeing in one or both eyes
- Sudden trouble walking, dizziness, loss of balance or coordination
- Sudden, severe headache with no known cause

Little-Known Dietary Contributors to Heart Disease

Red meats, hydrogenized oils -- these are the foods we associate with heart disease and high cholesterol But a few other things many people eat rather frequently could be contributing to future heart problems

White pasta and breads

Researchers have found that eating a diet high in refined grains, including those in most store-bought pastas and white breads, can double the risk of heart disease. These foods are those that have a high glycemic index, or GI. Foods with a high GI quickly release sugar into the bloodstream. Doctors have found a correlation between high GI and heart disease, mainly in women, according to research at the University of Milan. The study questioned 32,578 women and 15,171 men. Those who consumed the largest concentration of high GI foods were 2.24 times more likely to develop heart disease than those with the lowest.

Nutritionists advise that, when choosing grain products, it is important to select those made from whole grains. Not only do these products provide the nutritional benefits of whole grains, including fiber, they also help reduce cholesterol and the risk for heart disease.


While many people associate sugary snacks, beverages and sugar itself with dental decay or unnecessary calories, these items also impact cholesterol levels.

The average American eats the equivalent of 21 teaspoons of added sugar a day, which is two to three times the amount they should, according to an article in the Journal of the American Medical Association. Researchers found that individuals who consumed the most sugary products had the lowest HDL, or good cholesterol, and the highest blood triglyceride levels. Eating large amounts of sugar can then be a major risk factor for high cholesterol and heart disease.

In its 2010 guidelines, the American Heart Association recommended limiting added sugar in the die to no more than 100 calories a day for most women and 150 calories for most men. That's 6 teaspoons for women and 9 for men. To put those guidelines in perspective, consider that a 12-ounce can of soda has between 8 and 10 teaspoons.

In addition, many processed foods contain sugar even if sugar's inclusion seems foolish. Some restaurants and food manufacturers have admitted to adding sugar to foods -- especially those geared to children -- to make them taste better and be more appealing. Therefore, sauces, ready-made dinners and other items may have sugar, and the consumer may not know it without reading the nutrition label Also, it's important to note that beverages are the leading supplier of added sugar for many people Simply reducing the amount of juices, sports drinks and sodas in your diet can greatly reduce sugar consumption.
