Sixth-grade literacy students
are involved in a service-learning

FOGGY ROADS MAY HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO FATAL TWO-CAR ACCIDENT IN KENDALL

The Orleans County Sheriff's Office is investigating a fatal two-car accident in the town of Kendall. At approximately 1:53 p.m., two cars collided at the intersection of Route 18 and Norway Road. Preliminary investigation showed that one car was traveling northbound on Norway Road when it failed to yield the right of way at the stop sign. The second vehicle was west bound on Route 18 and struck the vehicle in the intersection.

The driver of the northbound vehicle was identified as Rebekah M. Hoak, 20, of Holley, who was pronounced dead at the scene. The front-seat passenger of the northbound vehicle was identified as Sarah S Lusk, 19, also of Holley. She was transported to Strong Hospital and was listed in satisfactory condition.

The driver of the westbound vehicle was identified as Richard E. Millard Jr., 56, of Kendall. He was transported to Strong Hospital, where he was treated and released.

The Orleans County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the New York State Police, Kendall and Morton Fire Departments. The accident is still under investigation. Foggy roads may be a contributing factor in the accident.

A VERY OVERDUE BOOK REVIEW!

How overdue is this book report? I bought this book in 1999 as a used book, but it was published in 1962. What can I say? I have been a busy boy! I have a vast collection of books, mostly about nature. Somehow this book got put high on the shelf and it wasn't until this winter that I “discovered” it again and so began reading it. It took awhile and some of it was “dry,” but when finished I asked myself, “Why did I wait so long?” It may be old, but reading it made me start to question some of the things going on now. You have heard the old line “history repeats itself,” and this book made me think along those lines.

Then the other night on Channel 17 there was a documentary on the author and the book. This gave me a even more insight on the book, the author, the subject and what happened back then. As I look back on my teenage years in the outdoors I could see some of what the author was talking about even though I had no clue at the time, like when my cousin and I were trying to get some baby crows for pets.

We would find a crow nest that had birds incubating and keep our eyes on it for when the eggs hatched. The theory was to keep making observations on the nests until we could see the young crows had started to feather out pretty good and then climb up and get a couple. Soon we noticed that the adults were not incubating anymore, but we weren't seeing them feeding any young either. We knew crows are very smart and so thought that the adults knew when we were around and thus avoided going near the nest tree to keep us from detecting it. After awhile we figured something was up so I climbed to the nest and found it empty. Maybe a raccoon got them so we checked a few other active nests and found the same thing.

Years later I got into long-range varmint shooting and I began to notice there were not as many crows around like back in the early-1960s and kind of questioned that. Unknown to me at the time, this was happening to our bald eagles and many other raptors too. It wasn't until I got involved with the local State Wildlife Management Areas in the late-1980s that I learned more about our bald eagle and what had happened and what was being done to correct it in New York State.

As it turned out, the eagles had the same problem as the crows did—the wide use of DDT had worked its way through the environment and was causing weak egg shells that broke very easily before they hatched. It was the DDT we were placing in the environment and thus the eagles, that caused the shells to become weak and eventually made reproduction impossible.

The state led by Peter Nye, from the DEC Endangered Species Unit, began a program of hacking young eaglets from uncontaminated areas to being back the eagle into NY. There was only one nest left in the state by 1976 and it was unproductive. This program worked, along with getting DDT off the market, which eventually got the bald eagle off the Endangered Species list.

This book, “Silent Spring” by Rachel Carson in 1962, awoke the country to what DDT and other chemicals we were using indiscriminately, were doing to our environment. It was a slow process, but these chemicals were having a very adverse effect on nature and also ourselves.

So this book brought awareness to what we doing and eventually DDT and many other chemicals were removed from our shelves. This book not only focused our attention on what the government and the chemical industry was doing to us and the environment but it has brought some questions to me.

Looking at the chemicals we use today is that happening again? These things often take time to manifest themselves so are we trusting the government and chemical industries to protect us again? There is a lot of corruption in today's world so how do we know what is good and what is not?

It is the same “fox in the hen house” deal. Who did the Environment Impact Study for the proposed Shelby stone quarry next to our Federal Refuge? According to Dave Mahar, he did. Our USF&W Service and NYS DEC has let the same “fox in the hen house” mentality decide about the quarry. Who is telling us how great the wind turbines are going to be up by one of the greatest bird migration corridors in NYS? The people building them! Who is telling us the chemicals we are using in our farming practices today are safe? Our government and the chemical industry, the ones who told us how safe DDT was!

There are a lot more questions this book produces and I think if you care about our environment and our youths' health you need to get a copy and read it. I think our young present-day biologists need to be required to read it, not just “know” about it too. Sometimes life gets too busy and we forget about the important things.

NO CONTEST

Individuals who might lose or gain something if a will is carried out as written might choose to contest the will in probate court. If they choose to do so, they may challenge the will on the grounds that the person who made the will, the "testator," lacked the capacity to make a will or was unduly influenced. All three were remanded to Orleans County Jail on \$100,000 bail. The three suspects have traveled from Florida to New York for the purpose of obtaining credit card information. These three suspects are believed to be a smaller part of a larger group of suspects who are using devices and the internet to obtain credit card information. The NYSP is working with the Secret Service, Niagara County Sheriff's Office, OCSO, Genesee County Sheriff's Office and other local law enforcement agencies in the area. At this time it is possible that hundreds of credit card information has been taken. This is still an ongoing criminal investigation.

Salami Paninis with Tomato-Chili Jam

Makes: 3 sandwiches

Ingredients:

- 3 Italian crusty buns
- 1 package salami
- 1 1/2 cups baby arugula
- 4 ounces semi-soft cheese, such as gouda or Havarti, sliced
- 1/2 cup tomato-chili jam (recipe follows)
- 2 tablespoons olive oil

Directions:

1. Cut buns in half lengthwise. Layer salami slices on each bun; top with arugula and cheese slices. Spread tomato-chili jam generously on the inside of the top of each bun.

2. Heat oil in a large frying pan over medium heat. Place sandwiches in pan and place another large heavy pan on top of them. Cook for 8 to 10 minutes or until bread is golden and cheese melted, turning sandwiches halfway through. Cut in half to serve.

Tomato-Chili Jam

Ingredients:

- 1 28-ounce can diced tomatoes
- 1 jalapeno pepper
- 2 teaspoons garlic, chopped
- 2 tablespoons ginger, chopped
- 2 tablespoons fish sauce
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 3/4 cup red wine vinegar

Directions:

1. In a food processor, purée half the tomatoes and their juices with jalapeño, garlic and ginger. Place in a deep pot with fish sauce, sugar and vinegar and boil slowly, stirring constantly.

2. When it reaches a boil, lower heat to simmer and add remaining tomatoes. Simmer gently for 30 to 40 minutes until dark red and jam-like. Pour into a bowl, cool and refrigerate until needed.
