The week before I was checking an eagle nest near Oak Orchard Creek in the State Wildlife Management Area when I noticed the signs of a rare animal in the recent snow. If it had not been for this long channel of packeddown snow I may have missed the tracks;

someone had been "sledding" on the dike next to the creek. I had seen the same type of sign several years ago over in the Tonawanda WMA – otter!

Otters are considered very intelligent animals and love to play. They love to slide on mud or snow and will have "slides" down steep banks that go into the water. In snow they will take 3 or 4 bounds and then slide for many feet and then repeat the process again. They are real clowns and seem to really enjoy life.

This water-loving animal is between 3 and 4 feet long including the tail and will weigh between 10 and 30 pounds (females being smaller). Its long, slender body is well designed for swimming and his thick tail is about one-third the length of the body.

His lustrous brown fur is on the short side in length but is very dense. Its fur is the most durable in North America, and back in 2006 a good otter pelt could fetch \$100 or more. With the fur market at rock bottom right now the pelt is only worth about \$25. The hollow guard hairs are oily and waterproof with the under fur being thick and downy, which holds air bubbles against the skin when they submerge. The inside of the skin has a very dense layer of fat that also helps to keep the animal warm. If you ever have a chance to run your hand over otter fur you will understand how they can slid through the water so easily.

The otter has short powerful legs, webbed feet and streamlined bodies that make them terrific swimmers so they can catch fish under water. The muscular tail helps to make sharp turns and steer them. They have transparent lens that cover their eyes that protects them from particles in the water when submerged. He also has very long and stiff whiskers that are extremely sensitive and help to locate food even in muddy water.

Otters are great nomads that have circuits they are consistently traveling. They travel from one waterway to another and may take weeks to cover these circuits and cover up to 60 square miles. They will travel good distances over land to get from one waterway to another.

About 80 percent of an otter's diet will consist of aquatic organisms like fish, crayfish and water insects. They will take muskrats, turtles, ducks and small beaver. Their diet can also include land mammals, birds, berries and fruits. Trout fishermen dislike the otter because he may take a few trout but he usually concentrates on slower fish like suckers, chubs and bullheads. Breeding takes place in March and April and the cubs are born about one year later. Otters have delayed implantation that causes this long delay in birth. Both sex do not become sexually mature until they are two years old but males don't become successful breeders until they are 5 to 7 years old. The male will mate with more then one female and generally does not help with the raising of the young. Generally there are two or three cubs born in a nest that maybe in an abandon beaver lodge, a log jam, loose rock piles and even old woodchuck holes. Their eyes do not open until they are almost 5 weeks of age and are not weaned until 4 or 5 months old. They stay in the den for about two months. They must be taught to swim by the mother but float easily like a cork because of their fluffy fur that holds air bubbles. They will remain together as a family unit for about 13 months. So if the otter disappeared from Western New York, how did they get here? Sportsmen and trappers played a big part, especially the trappers. Tune in next week and learn why this animal now exists in Western New York. If you spot an otter or see some signs of them (slides) let me know or contact the DEC.

When Renting Can Be a Smart Decision

You are young. The National Association of Realtors says the typical first-time home buyer is 31 years old. People who are younger than that and uncertain about their futures should not feel pressured into buying simply because it is presumed to be the "adult" thing to do. Renting and feeling your financial way, which can include seeing how a job pans out or where your budget lies after paying off debts, might make more financial sense than buying.


· The price-to-rent ratio is too high. Buying may seem like a wise idea, but it could be causing you to spend more than necessary, particularly if you check the price-to-rent ratio and find homes in your area are not fairly priced. Figuring a P/R ratio includes finding two similar houses (or condos or apartments) where one is for sale and the other is for rent. Divide the sale price of the first place by the annual rent for the second. The end result is the P/R ratio. So if a home sells for \$300,000, and there is a house around the corner renting for \$1,200 a month, divide \$300,000 by \$14,400 (the annual cost of renting). The ratio would be 20.8. A rent ratio above 20 means the cost of home ownership will exceed the cost of renting. The higher the P/R ratio, the more sense it makes to rent instead of buy.

· Home prices continue to rise. Some people find themselves being priced out of certain neighborhoods or cities. RealtyTrac recently analyzed median wage and home-price growth between 2012 and 2014, ultimately finding that, while the typical worker's earnings increased a meager 0.3 percent during the study period, median house prices were up by 17 percent. Wages have not recovered from the Great Recession as quickly as home prices have, and some people may need to rent out of necessity.

A market shortage makes it harder to find an affordable home. The number of homes available for sale in many areas of the country has fallen below the number that realtors say is required for the market to be in balance. Therefore, even when a home becomes available, demand drives the price up to where it may not be affordable or fiscally smart to purchase. In such instances, renting may be the best option.



Black Forrest Roulade

Serves 8-10

- 1 teaspoon sunflower oil,
- for oiling 6 ounces semisweet chocolate
- 2 to 3 tablespoons kirsch or cognac
- 5 eggs
- 1 cup superfine sugar 2 tablespoons confectioners' sugar, sifted
- ____

Filling

1 1/2 cups heavy cream 1 tablespoon kirsch or cognac 12 ounces fresh black cherries, pitted, or 14 ounces canned sour cherries, drained and pitted

Preheat the oven to 375 F. Lightly oil and line a jelly roll pan with nonstick parchment paper. Break the chocolate into small pieces and place in a heatproof bowl set over a saucepan of gently simmering water. Add the kirsch and heat gently, stirring until the mixture is smooth. Remove from the pan and set aside.

Place the eggs and sugar in a large heatproof bowl and set over the saucepan of gently simmering water. Whisk the eggs and sugar until very thick and creamy and the whisk leaves a trail when dragged across the surface. Remove from the heat and whisk in the cooled chocolate.

Spoon into the prepared jelly roll pan, the tap the pan lightly on a counter to smooth the top. Bake in the preheated oven for 20 minutes, or until the top feels firm to the touch. Remove from the oven and immediately invert onto a whole sheet of parchment paper that has been sprinkled with confectioners' sugar. Lift off the pan and its lining paper, then roll up, encasing the new parchment paper in the roulade. Let stand until cooled.


