



BIRD BOXES

By Douglas H. Domedion

This is a great time of the year to prepare some nesting boxes for our feathered friends. Birds such as bluebirds, wood ducks, and tree swallows will use man-made nesting boxes.

But why do we need to provide nesting structures? What did these feathered friends use before man started building bird boxes? Well, we have lost a lot of our old hollow trees that provided nesting cavities in the past not only for birds, but also animals such as raccoons and squirrels. There are also more non-native birds such as starlings and house sparrows that compete for these nesting cavities. Loss of nesting places, along with loss of habitat, has caused a decline

of certain birds such as the bluebird. The starling and house sparrow drive away bluebirds from nesting cavities. The new farm practices, such as huge crop fields with no hedgerows, fewer grasslands, and use of pesticides, caused an all-time low in populations in the late-1970s. However they began to rebound in the 1980s with the bluebird conservation movement that motivated many people to erect nesting boxes.

Of course there is more than just building a box and sticking it up somewhere. First we need to build the right-sized box with the proper entrance hole. You can find information on building nesting boxes at the library or stop in at the Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge headquarters and pick up blueprints for the latest proven designs.

Winter is a great time to build these boxes because they need to be in place early in the spring. Some birds, like wood ducks, return very early and begin looking for places to nest. Others, such as the bluebirds, will actually use these boxes for roosting in the

Each of the birds I mentioned above have a preferred location, nest height, and nesting material. They also need some kind of predator guard to keep raccoons, cats, and squirrels from getting to the boxes. Let's start with our beautiful state bird - the bluebird. They like short grassland locations such as pastures, large lawns, and golf courses. (If you place boxes in a pasture make sure the farm animals can not rub against them). Try to stay 30 or 40 yards away from brushy areas that will attract house wrens who will destroy bluebird eggs. It will also help to face the boxes away from

They prefer a low box height such as 4 or 5 feet. The best mounting post is 3/4" or double-walled 1/2" electric conduct pipe as it is very hard for a predator to climb. Another way to deter predators is to put grease on the pipe. The common practice of putting a piece of PCV pipe over the stake usually doesn't work as it is big enough to give a predator a "hugging" type grip to climb with. No nesting material is needed inside as they bring their own. If a bluebird trail (a series of boxes) is to be set up they need to be a minimum of 100 yards apart.

The tree swallow will also use a bluebird box. They are a great bird to have around as they eat thousands of flying insects. There is usually competition between these birds and bluebirds and the way to beat this is to put two boxes up (usually facing away from each other) about 15 or 25 feet apart.

The wood duck population decline years ago was due partly to the lack of hollow trees. With the development of nesting boxes and proper management it is now a common waterfowl in our marsh.

These larger boxes should be placed near a body of water although they will use boxes up to 1.5 miles from water. The "woodie" is a shy duck so don't place the boxes to close to human disturbance. They can be mounted on top of steel poles, 4x4 wooden posts, or on trees. Boxes over water only need to be 4 or 5 foot above the high water level. On land 6 to 10 feet is fine. The important thing here is to place a predator guard below the box to keep raccoons, etc. from climbing up and killing the hen that is nesting. If you place it on a tree make sure a predator can't get to the box by climbing from another tree to the nest box tree. Ducks Unlimited puts out a great information folder on wood duck boxes and predator guards. You can pick one up at the INWR headquarters. If you don't put up guards, don't put up a box. You will only be getting a

For nesting material put 4-6" of wood shavings in the box. Your local farm or pet store will carry it. Do not use sawdust as it holds moisture and can suffocate the young ducklings.

Another important aspect of bird boxes is maintenance. Clean the boxes out every year after nesting season and put fresh wood shavings in (where needed) before the birds returns in the spring.

Signs of a Stroke

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

- 1) Ask the person to SMILE.
- Ask the person to TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE. i.e. It is sunny out today.
- Ask the person to RAISE BOTH ARMS
- Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

OTHER STROKE WARNING SIGNS


- Sudden numbness or weakness of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden confusion, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden trouble seeing in one or both eyes
- Sudden **trouble walking**, **dizziness**, loss of balance or coordination

Did You Know?

Dented cans have long been a source of confusion and concern for shoppers. They may be discounted and seem like a good deal, but some of those dented cans may not be safe to eat. Damaged cans may be harboring food that contains botulism and other toxins. According to the United States Department of Agriculture Food Safety and Inspection Services, if a can of food has a small dent but is otherwise in good shape, the food should be safe to eat. However, deeply dented cans should be discarded. Dented cans of food that are safe will have smooth dents or dents that are not on the seams of the can. A person should avoid sharp dents, dents in the seam and dents where the seam and the can meet. In addition, if the can is bulging or swollen, it should be avoided. Dents in a seam can let in air and bacteria. Deep dents may have left pinholes, again where bacteria can enter. When in doubt, avoid dented cans.

Music Can Impact Emotions

Music is an integral part of the human experience. Songs have been sung for centuries, and music plays an integral role in many cultural ceremonies, rites of passage and other traditions. Researchers have had an interest in music and its impact on human emotion and perceptions for many years. Some people were shown a happy face - the person was smiling - while others were exposed to a face with sad or neutral facial expressions. The participants were then asked to rate the emotional content of the face. Researchers found that happy music made happy faces seem that much more pleasant, while sad music exaggerated frowns. Similar effects were found with neutral

These findings illustrate how music can help improve physical and mental health when used in concert with other strategies. The American Music Therapy Association reports that music therapy programs can be used to manage stress, enhance memory and alleviate pain.

The right music can serve as a catalyst for romance. Men and women can increase feelings of affection in their romantic partners by playing love songs in the background while offering gifts and tokens of their love. If a proposal is planned for February, one can set the mood with a favorite song that exemplifies the special relationship shared with a significant other. Those who may not be able to express their feelings verbally may find that music helps to convey those feelings.

Music certainly can impact emotions, though the reasons why are not entirely known. However, people can use music to their advantage, particularly on Valentine's Day. ■





Negotiating a Commercial Lease That Works For You

Leasing commercial space is a fact of life for many business owners. The expense of commercial leasing is considerable, but cost is not the only factor to consider when leasing a commercial space. The following are a few tips for business owners when negotiating their commercial space lease.

- Enlist some professional help. While seasoned business owners may be able to negotiate their commercial lease on their own, new business owners often benefit from the services of real estate brokers and real estate lawyers. Real estate lawyers can negotiate your lease, explaining key terms and conditions that may prove confusing to first-time business owners. Real estate brokers can help you find the right location, and many real estate brokers have a long working history with landlords. Such relationships can make the negotiating process easier, and they also can benefit business owners looking for the best possible location for their businesses. Real estate brokers often get first choice at the most desirable locations, so teaming up with an established real estate broker can increase your chances of landing a desirable property.
- Emphasize affordable renewal options. The length of commercial leases favored by small businesses is often similar to the length of a lease on a private residence. Though the language might be more complex than that of a private residence lease, the length of a commercial lease agreement is typically one to two years. But business owners must be diligent regarding renewal options and the cost of such renewals. Come the end of your lease terms, you don't want to be met with a considerable and unexpected hike in rent just as your business is starting to take off. Work to get the most favorable renewal options possible so more of your operating budget can go into your products and not toward your lease.

• Pay attention to extra fees. Many commercial leases include fees in addition to the FOR RENT: 2-bedroom, lower monthly rent. 


