

CAPSTONING EXPERIENCES GET PRECISION MACHINE TECH STUDENTS PREPARED FOR CAREERS

Students in Bill Rakonczay's Machine Precision Technology Program at the Orleans Career and Technology Center are being mentored and employed by some area machining companies. Because of the high demand for skilled workers in this field, companies contact Mr. Rakonczay every year looking for students they can give a paid internship to and potentially groom to be a full-time employee after

they graduate.

"Capstoning is a great process for both my students and employers," says Mr. Rakonczay. "It allows my students to have a broader understanding of what it is like to work for a manufacturing company. If they don't like the experience they can reassess their career goals before graduation, and if they do like it, it allows the company to employ them for several months to see if they are what they are looking for and where they will fit in to their operation."

Nick Gifford has been capstoning at Niagara Precision Inc. in Lockport. "I thought it was fun. I have learned a lot there." Jack Muscarella has been at Voss Manufacturing working. "I liked it a lot. I learned a lot more than I thought I would. It is great to go from books in the classroom to a real-life manufacturing place." Classmate Craig Heitzenrater has been at Pivot Punch Corporation in Pendleton capstoning. "I learned a lot that you can't learn in school like how a real machine shop works." All three students have accepted full-time employment after graduation at their capstoning locations.

"The need for trained professionals in the machining field is incredible," says Mr. Rakonczay. "I have almost 100 percent placement rate with my students if they want to go right into the working world. Capstoning is a great experience because it is learning in action. Part of my teaching process is to provide students with skills in the classroom and an opportunity to get their foot in the door of a local company so that they can learn about the organization and increase their skills in managing their time, conflict management and being part of a team."

CULINARY ARTS STUDENTS GET LESSON ON SPONGE CANDY

Students in James Atzrott's Culinary Arts program, at the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center, recently got a lesson in a Buffalo favorite, sponge candy. The treat is uniquely a western New York one due to the fact that it is very sensitive to heat and humidity and does not travel

Candy maker Dave Selig spent an afternoon with the students showing them how he makes the candy. He starts by making the toffee center which is comprised of sugar, corn

syrup, gelatin and baking soda. "When you are making candy, it is very important to get the temperature right. It can change the whole character of the product," he explains to the students. "Once it hardens, you have to saw off the exterior to get to the soft inside." He told the class that the recipe makes about 5, to 6 pounds a batch and a lot of stores sell it for \$18-20 a pound. "Not bad for three and a half hours of your time."

After the sponge is cut into pieces the students dipped it into chocolate and then were able to enjoy the end product and share with staff. "It was great that Mr. Selig was able to come in and show my students how to make this traditional Easter candy," says Mr. Atzrott. "It is very hard to get this in other places, so it is unique to us. There is a real art to making it."



Sister Lucille Socciarelli, the teacher who made a lifelong impression on newsman Tim Russert, died Sunday at Mercy Convent in South Buffalo. She was 82. Russert credited Sister Lucille, his seventh-grade teacher at St. Bonaventure School in West Seneca in 1963, with leading him to a career in journalism by making him the editor of the school

paper. Her motive at the time was simply to keep him out of trouble by keeping him busy. "I was in the back of the class at St. Bonaventure School flicking rubber bands with paper clips, the whole shot, spitballs, the best," he told an interviewer in 2004. "And she had enough of it. ... It was the greatest thing that ever happened to me." Russert often invited her to join him at book signings and speaking engagements. She once vacationed with the Russert family on Nantucket Island. Following Russert's death in 2008, she spoke at his memorial service. He wrote about her in his book about his father, "Big Russ & Me," noting that she played baseball with her students and was considered "the coolest teacher we ever had." Russert remarked that she was particularly devoted to President John F. Kennedy and the Kennedy family. He wrote that when Sen. Robert F. Kennedy visited Buffalo in 1967, Sister Lucille ran 150 yards after his car at the airport to get an autograph and was invited to tour his private plane. Russert noted that she became the topic of a newspaper report and was reprimanded. Russert also established an annual award, the Sister Lucille Socciarelli-Father John Sturm Making a Difference Award, which is given by the Diocese of Buffalo to an outstanding Catholic educator. Sturm was prefect of discipline at Canisius High School when Russert attended. 'Sister Lucille's vibrance, energy and humor, her love of life, her curiosity and astuteness made her the spark that ignited seventh-grade Tim Russert's passion for politics and journalism," Russert's widow, Maureen Orth, said in an email Sunday. "When she made him the editor of the St. Bonaventure newspaper and he sent the White House and members of the Kennedy family copies of the school's commemorative issue about JFK's death, Tim received personal responses back. That was his awakening, when he got it that news could be powerful and a force for public good," she wrote. "Besides, Sister was a natural pol herself and probably would be at least a bishop if she had been a man." "She also taught during the time that the Mercy order rule was that no teaching nun could ever be caught sitting behind a desk," Orth added. "They were expected to be on their feet at all times. What incredible commitment and love." The Russerts' son, Luke Russert, who followed his father into broadcast journalism, in an email, said: "Sister Lucille's life was one of love, selflessness and humor. She gave herself to God, the children she taught and the sick she counseled." "I was happy to be her 'grandson in faith' and can safely say she single-handedly kept Hallmark in business by sending me a card no matter where I lived for every holiday, anniversary or special occasion. I'll miss her ever-present kindness, her belief in the goodness of others and her unwavering support for the Buffalo Bills." Retired NBC News anchorman Tom Brokaw, in an email Sunday night, said, "When we lost Tim, Sister Lucille and I picked up the relationship. I heard from her regularly and she was a joy. She offered pithy observations on the news and the Buffalo Bills. When I appeared at Chautauqua two years ago, she drove over and greeted my family like old friends. They were enchanted. Her life of service to her faith and the downtrodden was an inspiration." Born in Albion, the daughter of Italian immigrants and the youngest of 13 children, she attended St. Joseph's Elementary School and graduated from Albion High School. In his book, Russert notes that she had considered becoming a social worker, a hairdresser and a teacher before she entered the Sisters of Mercy at Mount Mercy Convent in Buffalo in 1953. She earned a bachelor's degree in education from Niagara University and a master's degree in education from the University at Buffalo while teaching and serving as principal at Catholic elementary schools and high schools. She also received a degree in religious studies from Boston College. In the 1980s, she became a director of youth ministry in Florida, then returned to become director of pastoral care at Mercy Hospital. She later was a chaplain at hospitals in Fall River, Mass. She retired and returned to Buffalo in 2015. Survivors include a brother, Donald. and many nieces, nephews and cousins. Kristy Dickinson Vogel, of Brockport, was



unexpectedly taken from us on April 9, 2017, by lupus. Kristy was a beautiful, intelligent, loving woman who attended Brockport HS and SUNY Brockport. She went on to teach inner city children and Rochester Head Start. She was a talented writer, member of the Society of Creative Anachronism, and a generous, loving woman. Her greatest accomplishments include finding her perfect soulmate in Kirk Vogel, her loving and devoted husband of over

20 years. They created three children. The first is Xavier, a bright and talented student at Brockport High School and SUNY Brockport. Xavier is an accomplished musician and computer programmer. 





Broiled Chili-Lime-Crusted Tilapia

April 16, 2017

Serves 4

2 tablespoons olive oil, plus more for the pan

Juice of 1 lime (about 2 tablespoons)

1 tablespoon cornstarch

1 tablespoon chili powder

■ 1 teaspoon ground coriander

1 teaspoon ground cumin

1 teaspoon dried oregano, rubbed in your palm

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

■ 1/2 teaspoon onion powder

3/4 teaspoon kosher salt

1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

4 fresh tilapia fillets

Garnish:

Lime wedges

Torn fresh cilantro leaves

Pico de Gallo (see below)

Place the oven rack in the top portion of the oven. Crack the oven door and preheat the broiler to high. Line a rimmed baking sheet with aluminum foil and lightly brush the foil with olive oil.

In a shallow dish, combine the olive oil, lime juice, cornstarch, chili powder, coriander, cumin, oregano, garlic powder, onion powder, salt, and pepper. Whisk I to blend.

Dip both sides of each tilapia fillet into the spice mixture and use your fingers to coat evenly. Place the tilapia on the prepared baking sheet with the bottom facing up. Broil for 4 minutes, then carefully flip and cook for 4 to 5 minutes more, or until the fish flakes easily.

Serve with lime wedges and torn cilantro or top with a few spoonfuls of Pico de Gallo.

Pico de Gallo

Makes about 2 cups

3 plum (Roma) tomatoes, seeded and diced

■ 1/3 cup finely diced red onion

2 scallions, sliced

2 tablespoons chopped fresh cilantro

1 tablespoons minced jalapeño

■ 1 teaspoon minced garlic


Juice of 1/2 lime

1 teaspoon olive oil

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

I In a medium bowl, combine the tomatoes, red onion, scallions, cilantro, jalapeño, and garlic. Add the lime juice and oil, season with the salt, and stir to combine.

I Serve immediately or cover with plastic wrap and refrigerate until ready to serve.




