### BIG STORMS, BIG PROBLEMS FOR WILDLIFE

Well, after a pretty mild winter Mother Nature is showing us she is still around and is still in control. The winds the week before were some of the worse we have ever seen



Everything was OK at my place after the "big wind," so my thoughts went to what damage may have been done to our eagle nests. The first checked was the new one at Ringneck Marsh, and it was fine. The next was the Cayuga nest and it was fine also so I proceeded to the Tonawanda WMA nest, which was a new nest built this winter in a partly dead tree that was leaning. The original nest for this pair of birds has been falling from a huge oak on an island over the last three years. A good solid nesting platform was built in the exact spot of the original nest this last December and the birds began to put sticks on it. Then for some unknown reason they decided to start a new nest on the same island about 70 yards from the platform. It didn't look like a very good situation to me and I expected it to be down after those high winds but no it held! The sticks they had placed on that platform however had been blown off!

The next nest was the new one built this winter over in the Oak Orchard WMA. Their nest tree went down in a earlier wind storm and they had built a new nest with in 42 yards of the Handicap Trail which then had to be closed off to all traffic. This nest was also in a very bad-looking situation; in a partly dead white oak, out on a limb and supported by some dead limbs. DEC people rushed in and got a guard put up on the tree to prevent a raccoon from getting up to the nest and all activity in that area was stopped. When I got to my distance observation spot the nest couldn't be see and a trip back to the area confirmed it had gone down. No eggs had been lain yet so what will happen now is up to the eagles. They have their original nest on an island in Windmill Marsh along with an alternate nest and hopes are they will still be able to have a nesting season by using one of those.

The next nest was the one north of Medina and that was not the best-looking situation either for the huge windstorm we had. The worry here was that these birds had already lain their eggs and were incubating and a complete nesting season could be lost. However the nest held and the female was hunkered down on the nest!

The final nest to check was the Carlton nest, which was way out in a open area but was built in good strong tree and was well supported by a number of limbs. The nest was fine and she was in the nest incubating.

Another possible nest site was also checked south of Albion. This nest had been reported by a reader of this column and "says" to me - eagle nest! I have been to the area to check it several times but no eagles have been seen on it yet. It is a difficult nest to observe and there is still time for eagles to lay eggs so I check it periodically. No birds were seen around the nest after the "big wind" but it was still up so that was a good sign.

There is another nest on the INWR, back in a remote place I do not check on, but there has been no word of it going down from the refuge people.

The bird at the new Tonawanda nest began incubating this past Sunday and hopefully there will be no problems with that iffy nest.

Now with the hard freeze the marshes have been frozen over again with just a few open water spots which are concentrated with waterfowl. The low temperatures and snow also make it difficult for them to find food. Maybe some will move to better weather conditions, some will try to wait it out but some of the weaker ones will not make it and predators such as fox, mink and eagles will take a few.

During these stressful times it is important that the birds are not disturbed and forced to use precious energy, so if you're out observing wildlife keep this in mind. Most of the birds here now are heading much farther north and if their body reserves are low they may not make it.

### **SECURITY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT CLASS VISITS NIAGARA COUNTY HOLDING AND COMMUNICATIONS CENTER**



Students in Steve Browning's security and law enforcement program at the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center recently spent a day at the Niagara County Holding Center and the

Communications Division of the Niagara County Sheriff's Office.

Student Tyler Wisnieski says he had misconceptions on what the Holding Center would be like. "When you see shows on TV it looks much different. It wasn't as bad. The prisoners have a lot more rights than you would expect like watching television, playing basketball or just sitting down to have coffee." His classmate Lindsay Falwell says she was surprised by that as well, but found the visitors center area unnerving. "They had areas that visitors would have to talk on a phone behind glass to the prisoner. Then there was another area that was basically a big triangle where people sit very near the other prisoners and their visitors. I found that intimidating. I would not want to be that close to another prisoner. I would be very uncomfortable visiting someone there."

The class was allowed to tour the facility where they got a chance to talk to one of the prisoners, Ricky. "Ricky gave us all great life advice," said Lindsay. "He has been in and out of prison for years and he told us his story and encouraged us to make better decisions than he did. That was very intense. One wrong turn and you are in jail for 30

The students found the tour very interesting and saw potential careers there. "I think it would be cool to do corrections," says Tyler. Lindsay said although she didn't want to be a corrections officer, she was fascinated by another aspect of the facility. "They had a medical center and I think I would like to pursue the medical field and potentially work there."

Both students described the Communications Center as being a very stressful place to work. "There is a big television that shows the 911 calls coming through and you have 15 seconds to answer them," explained Tyler. "There are two operators for fire and ambulance and three for the police. We actually got to listen to some of the calls that were coming in on an accident in Niagara Falls. I found it very intense. They have what they call a Quiet Room for the operators to go into if they are really stressed out from a call. I know I could never do that as a career."

Lindsay and Tyler said they really enjoy the Security and Law Enforcement class and have gotten a lot out of it. "I really thought I wanted to be a cop, but now I am thinking something in the medical field or science," says Lindsay. "But this class has opened up my mind to possibilities." Tyler said he was inspired to take the class because of all the negative perceptions about law enforcement. "I think cops get a bad rap. I believe that being a good cop would have a positive effect on many and that is what I want to be."

# **Maple Pecan Scones**

Serves 6

### **INGREDIENTS:**

2 cups unbleached all-purpose flour

4 teaspoons baking powder

A good pinch of salt

4 tablespoons unsalted butter,

chilled and cut into cubes

1 cup pecan pieces

1 extra-large egg

1/4 cup pure maple syrup

About 3 tablespoons milk

1 greased baking sheet

### **DIRECTIONS:**

Preheat the oven to 425 F.

Sift the flour, baking powder and salt into a large bowl. Add the butter and rub it in with the tips of your fingers until the mixture resembles fine crumbs. Mix in the pecans.

In a separate bowl, beat the egg with maple syrup and 1 tablespoon of the milk. Stir into the flour mixture with a round-bladed knife to make a soft, coarse-looking dough. If the dough is dry and crumbly and won't stick together, stir in more milk 1 tablespoon at a time. If the dough is very wet and sticky, work in another tablespoon of flour.

Tip out the dough onto a work surface lightly dusted with flour and gently work it with your hands for a few seconds so it looks smoother. Put the dough ball onto the prepared baking sheet. Dip your fingers in flour and pat out the dough to a round about 11/4 inches thick and 7 inches across. Using a knife, cut the round into 6 wedges, but do not separate the dough before baking.

Bake for 18 to 20 minutes until light golden brown. Transfer to a wire rack and leave until the wedges are cool enough to separate. Serve warm the same day. The cooled scones can be wrapped tightly and frozen for up to 1 month.



### **How to Spur Kids' Interest** in the Arts

Celebrate kids' participation in arts-based activities in school and in the community, recognizing their hard work in the same way you would acknowledge their successes in the classroom and in sports.


