#### **ROCHESTER MAN DEAD AFTER BARRE SKYDIVING ACCIDENT**

The Orleans County Sheriff's Office is investigating a skydiving accident in the Town of Barre that claimed the life of a Rochester man.

Orleans County Undersheriff Christopher M. Bourke reports that at 7:23

p.m. on April 22, 2017, the Orleans County Sheriff's 911 Center received a call of a man down in a field off the Pask Road in the Town of Barre. C.O.V.A. Ambulance, Barre Fire Company and the Clarendon Fire Company Off Road Unit responded to the area. The male victim was located approximately three-quarters of a mile south of Pask Road in an open field. The 30-year-old male was pronounced dead shortly before 10 p.m. at the scene by Orleans County Coroner Rocky Sidari.

He is identified as Erick J. Miller of Michele Drive, Rochester.

The initial investigation indicated that the victim was an experienced skydiving instructor with over 700 civilian jumps. Witnesses report that the Miller and another skydiver, both members of the WNY Skydiving Club, left the Pine Hill Airport and made what is referred to as a "Sport Jump" at about 7 p.m. The second skydiver, upon arriving on the ground, could not locate Miller and immediately began a search for the victim. The jump plane took off from Pine Hill Airport to assist in the search.

Sheriff's Office investigators are working with the Federal Aviation Administration in an attempt to determine the facts leading up to the incident that caused Mr. Miller's tragic death. The investigation indicates that the main parachute had deployed, possibly improperly, and was located nearby but was not connected to the victim. Many questions remain, such as why the backup chute was not deployed by the jumper or why it didn't deploy automatically as it should have. Experts from the FAA are examining the equipment and gear involved with this incident at their Rochester office. Sheriff's Office Investigators are continuing to interview witnesses and search for information on this case. The Monroe County Medical Examiner's Office is assisting in the investigation as well.

The Orleans County Sheriff's Office was assisted at the scene by the New York State Police, Barre Fire Company and the Clarendon Fire Company.

### A LITTLE-NOTICED **JEWEL**

#### By Douglas H. Domedion

The area we now know as the Oak Orchard Wildlife Management area has had a little-known jewel within it that until recently has taken back seat to the Orchard ED Center will offer a different view popular INWR Swallow Hollow trail. It doesn't have all the fancy "trimmings" that the Federal trail has, but it offers a special

"closeness" to nature and is a great place for a "nature" family picnic.

Back in 1974, the Oak Orchard Education facility was constructed on the Knowlesville Road across from Swallow Hollow. It included an enclosed pavilion with electric power, a picnic area and four nature trails. However, since 1985 this facility deteriorated from vandalism and lack of money for maintenance. The pavilion was reduced to a covered picnic area and nothing has been done to update it until recently. Last year Wildlife Technician Denise Appleby led the Oak Orchard Maintenance crew into a project to revamp the area and make it more public friendly and at the same time give the public a closer look into nature in the area.

They started by building a handicapped-accessible 242-foot boardwalk out into the adjacent north marsh. Eventually a wheelchair-accessible trail will be built from the boardwalk to the pavilion and then onto the parking lot. The existing cement benches in the pavilion have been moved around and placed in a manner as to allow for wheelchair access, and four ADA accessible picnic tables have been installed. The preexisting boardwalk has been closed off and will be removed due to its unstable conditions.

Bluebird houses, bat houses, wood duck nesting boxes and mallard nesting structures have been placed around the "Ed Center" property. A kiosk, filled with information about the area, is by the pavilion also. There are four trails (.31, .3, .86, and .32 miles) that take you through various types of habitats and plantings. To the west of the pavilion a small field was planted with wildflowers and grasses. Planted flower species includes partridge pea, wild bergamont, black-eyed Susan, lance leaf coreopsis, catchfly, purple coneflower, and common yarrow. Native lupine seeds (harvested from existing plants on the Tonawanda WMA) were planted just southwest of the pavilion. Other areas along the trails have also been planted with wildflowers and trees that include white cedar, red maple, white spruce, white pine, red oak, sycamore, mountain ash, service berry and highbush cranberry. Switchgrass areas adjacent to North Marsh and the flooded timber area to the north will be periodically mowed to provide for a better view of the area from the pavilion. Signs with a number system that will coincide with a trail guide brochure will eventually be put in place that will encourage closer observation of ecological concepts along the trails.

A photo blind is also on the property for the convenience of nature photographers. For more information on the area call (585-948-5182) or stop in at the DEC office at the INWR headquarters on Casey Road.

Another much-needed improvement in the works is over on the NYS Tonawanda WMA. Anyone traveling on the Bartel/Owen Road between Ditch

Road and Meadville Road will come across the four shooting ranges on the NYS DEC property. The original idea was to keep target practice in a safe place away from the rest of the WMA. Dirt mounds were built at various ranges for backstops and only the use of paper targets is allowed. Shooting times were from noon to sunset.

#### These Home Improvements May Actually Lower Home Value

Home improvements are typically made to improve the functionality and look of a home, but renovations also can increase the value of a home. Certain changes to a home can make it more attractive to prospective buyers, while other renovations may make a home less appealing. For example, a complete overhaul of an outdated kitchen is often a smart financial move, while installing a pool or hot tub may not be worth the cost to homeowners. Separating the good from the bad renovations makes smart financial sense, and homeowners looking to improve their homes' resale values may want to avoid the following projects.

 Bedroom and garage conversions: Changing a room's traditional function often turns off buyers. For example, turning a garage into a home gym might seem like a great idea for you, but it may not be so appealing to prospective buyers. Buyers can certainly reconvert the space, but they would consider the costs of such a conversion when making their offers on the home.

• Stylized colors on trims and rooms: Painting over unappealing colors is a project many homeowners can handle. However, some may be discouraged by a home that has too many bright colors or textures on the walls and trims. Buyers often want homes that are move-in ready, meaning they can get settled in before undertaking large projects. A living room painted in purple or zebra print may not fit the design scheme of many buyers. Dark colors do not easily disappear, and taping off and painting trimwork or changing it entirely can be equally time-consuming. Stick with neutral colors when selling a home, even if this means giving rooms a new coat of paint before putting your house on the market.

• Outdoor hot tubs and indoor spa tubs: Many people find soaking in a bubbling brew of hot water quite inviting. But buyers often do not want to inherit a used hot tub. Although hot tubs are cleaned and maintained with sanitizing chemicals, some people may view them as unsanitary. Removing a hot tub can be labor-intensive. And much like a pool, a hot tub may not be appealing to buyers with young children.

 Removing closets: Closet space is often high on buyers' priority lists. Turning closet space into an office or removing a closet to make a room bigger may be fine for those who are staying put. But these modifications can be a turn-off to prospective buyers.

• Too many features: In an effort to "keep up with the Joneses," some homeowners will over-improve their home to the point that it outshines all others on the street. There is a case for having nice things, but homeowners may struggle to sell a home that is disproportionate to other homes in the area. Practice moderation when making improvements to attract more buyers. 🔳

### **Crafting an Effective Cover Letter**

A strong cover letter may not guarantee you land a good job, but a poor cover letter may guarantee you won't. On its own, an effective cover letter can catch the eye of hiring managers tasked with finding worthy candidates among stacks of applications, while a poor cover letter may ensure hiring managers never even glance at an applicant's resume.

An effective cover letter should be concise, conveying an applicant's work history and goals in a few paragraphs or less. The following are some additional ways men and women can craft effective cover letters.

• Address a specific person when possible. When responding to a job posting that listed a specific contact, address your cover letter to that person rather than beginning the letter with, "Dear Sir or Madam" or "To Whom It May Concern." Personalize each cover letter you write so the hiring manager does not get the feeling that you are sending out cover letters en masse. Make sure names are spelled correctly and job titles are accurate.

• State your purpose early on. The purpose of your letter, which is to state the job you're seeking, should be made clear early on. Hiring managers often handle the vetting process for a host of positions at their companies, so the earlier the hiring manager knows which position you're applying for the better. Hiring managers may become frustrated when applicants don't make their intentions clear or do so in the final paragraph instead of the first.

• Explain why you are a qualified candidate. While it's good to note your work history, your resume will do the bulk of that legwork. A cover letter is your opportunity to show how your work history makes you a qualified candidate for a specific position. Remember to be concise but relate a specific example that illustrates how your work history would help you thrive in the position for which you're applying.

• Exhibit some knowledge about the company to which you're applying. An effective cover letter should help you stand out among your fellow applicants, and expressing some knowledge about the organization can do just that. The goal here is to illustrate how you and the organization are a good fit, so you don't need to go overboard or be too specific. But hiring managers are likely to be more impressed by applicants who do their homework and show a knowledge of the company than applicants who submit a form cover letter where the company is scarcely mentioned.

• Be cordial in your closing. A cover letter should close with a cordial request for an interview or a friendly way of indicating you look forward to a company's response to your application. In addition, thank the reader for his or her time and mention you would be delighted to answer any questions he or she may have.

An effective cover letter can go a long way toward making a strong first impression on a prospective employer. Men and women should look at their cover letters as their first opportunities to connect with a company and write their letters accordingly.

### Simplify Cocktail Party Prep

Hosting is a big responsibility that only gets bigger when food is being served. Hosts without much time on their hands to prepare foods for cocktail hour need only a few minutes to whip up the following recipe for "Gorgonzola Canapés with Walnuts" from A.J. Rathbun's "Party Snacks!" (Harvard Common Press).

#### **Gorgonzola Canapés with Walnuts** *Makes 30 canapés*

1 1/2 cups crumbled Gorgonzola cheese
1/2 cup chopped walnuts
30 sturdy round crackers
3/4 cup dried cranberries
1/4 cup minced fresh parsley

1. In a medium-size bowl, toss the Gorgonzola and walnuts. When tossing, be gentle, as you don't want to end up with big clumps.

2. Top each cracker with a small mound of the cheese mixture, pressing the mixture lightly onto each cracker to keep it from slipping off. Top each cracker with 3 or 4 cranberries, and sprinkle a touch of minced parsley on top of each. ■

### **Simple Tricks to Satisfy Picky Eaters**

**Experiment with different textures** Sometimes it isn't the food itself but the texture of the food that is the problem. Therefore, parents shouldn't rule out certain foods just yet. For example, a child might not like the texture of a baked potato, but mashed potatoes are fine. Try presenting the food in a different way. to be more adventurous with their selections.

Find ways to mask nutrition Choose foods that children regularly eat and enjoy and experiment with ways to dress them up and make them more nutritious.
