


MEDINA TEACHER AND STUDENTS RECOGNIZED AT **ORLEANS COUNTY YOUTH AWARDS**

The Orleans County Youth Board honored Clifford Wise Intermediate School Physical Education teacher Eric Gross and Clifford Wise students Serenity Baumgart and Robert Vidovich and High School students Sarah Granchelli, Zachary Petry and Vincent Viterna for their service to the community during the 35th annual Youth Recognition Banquet on Thursday at Hickory Ridge Golf and Country Club.

The people recognized do numerous acts of service, from volunteering at animal shelters, their local fire department, nursing homes and other community organizations.

Eric Gross received the Helen R. Brinsmaid Professional Award, given to a paid professional whose work exceeds normal expectations.

Mr. Gross is a physical education teacher and coach at Medina's Clifford H. Wise Intermediate/Middle School. A co-worker, Kristy Young said, "Mr.Gross is a humble person with a contagious positive attitude. He gives his own money and time to help student athletes at Medina, taking them to appointments and making sure they have the proper equipment."

He grew up in Medina and has worked as a teacher for 16 years, coaching cross country, track and wrestling. He says he is fortunate in his job to have strong support from Medina families, his co-workers and the staff at the school, as well as his own family. "It was very nice to be nominated by my colleagues and being recognized for what I do and enjoy doing every single day working with youth and trying to help them."

Serenity Baumgart who is 12 years old, volunteers at PAWS Animal Shelter and has helped with community clean-ups and can often be found picking up garbage or cleaning debris off the side of the road after inclement weather. She often babysits and pet sits for friends and family and known for being very hard working and polite. She was nominated by school counselors, Lindsay Fassel and Tina DeSimone. Serenity said that she felt proud of herself for winning the award. "It was exciting for me knowing that I was recognized and that all my hard work paid off."

Robert Vidovich III who is 13 years old is known for being a kind and caring young man and is often seen picking up debris and garbage, especially after windstorms. He has also been known to shovel snow for others. When his family home caught on fire he managed to get his whole family out and their two dogs. Thanks to quick action, the house was able to be saved. Robert said, "I just did what I was supposed to and I try to help out in the community as much as I can." He was nominated by his technology teacher Giovanella Pelligra.

Sarah Granchelli, is 18 years old and has logged countless hours of community service. In the last year alone, she has volunteered 120 hours helping the residents at the Orchard Manor Nursing Home. She is very active in her church and has been a Sunday school assistant teacher since 2010. Last year she spent a week as a leadership intern for Camp Intervention, which is a STEM learning camp working with students in grades 3-4. She also assisted in the Red Cross Blood Drive and has volunteered to work with the students at Oak Orchard Primary School. "I was pretty surprised I won. My teacher didn't tell me I had been nominated until I learned that I won. It was a big thrill for me." She was nominated by teacher Scott

Zachary Petry is 18 years old and has been a member of the Shelby Volunteer Fire Company for over two years. Before that he was a junior firefighter. He is very active in the company and has trained very hard since joining. He has also helped out at many fundraising events at the fire hall and has learned to run and drive firetrucks and off-road vehicles. Vincent Viterna, is 17 years old and also active in the Shelby Volunteer Fire Company. He has completed his firefighter training during the 2016-17 year and has put in 104 hours of hard work. CAN YOU SHOOT CARDINALS OR PAINT BIRDS?

I have had it happen with other birds before, but not as bad as with this guy, and it has been going on for almost two weeks now. This male cardinal starts attacking my living room windows just about the time it starts to get light in the morning and he doesn't quit until about darkness in the evening. Mostly his "attacks" have been to the high east living room window, but he makes side trips to the lower south windows mostly to the ones right behind the couch.

He will sometimes sit on the window sill and look in the window and then suddenly fly up, hitting the window all the way to the top. Other times he

just comes flying in and attacks the window. He bangs against the window with enough force that you would think he would eventually hurt himself, but that is not the case. There are no feathers knocked out and he doesn't leave any kind of mouth residue on the glass like a robin did several years ago. The "banging" gets very annoying, especially when you are on the couch and he suddenly hits the window right behind you. Kay, our Jack Russell, gets very upset when he starts on those couch windows, but doesn't seem to mind the high windows facing east. Amy, our yellow lab, is just about deaf now so it is no problem for her, but I find it to be a pain especially early in the morning.

So why is this guy harassing us? Well, it is a territorial thing and when he sees his reflection in the windows he thinks it is another male cardinal invading his territory and he wants to drive him out. Mama probably has a nest near by in the yews and so he is not going away anytime soon. My hopes is that once the eggs hatch out that he will have to help get food for the babies and it will take his mind off the "other guy."

You would think he would recognize himself, but then again sometimes I don't recognize myself! So can anything be done to stop this activity? Well, they recommend putting decals on the windows to spook the birds, putting an owl decoy near the windows, hanging flashing CDs or mylar ribbons near the glass, or covering the windows completely with a tarp or a plastic that won't reflect the bird's image. From what I gather, none of these things really work. The one thing that some folks have had work is to hang that fine bird netting that they use to cover berry plants to keep the birds from eating the fruit. Personally I don't want to go to all that trouble as ladders and I don't get along very well anymore and I do enjoy watching him beat his brains out sometimes!

On to another subject matter, is someone painting birds? I ran across a Canada goose last week that looked like someone had spilled white paint on his head and neck. I have seen geese similar to this in the past; one that sticks out was the one with his whole head and neck being white but his body being the normal colors. Another was on the pond in Lyndonville by the school this winter whose whole body looked like it had faded real bad. He was almost white, but you could see where the black neck and head was along with many of the body feathers lightly tinted dark. Then this past week a friend emailed me that she had a robin that had some white tail feathers and various white patches on his body. A few years back a friend had a cardinal that was mostly white, but had a pinkish cap, wings and tail.

No one is painting these birds they just have a genetic condition called leucism. It is a partial lost of pigmentation in feathers, fur or skin from defective pigment cells. The results maybe a complete white or pale color to feathers, skin or fur, but more commonly it is just irregular patches of white appearing anywhere on the bird or animal. It is not the same as albinism, which is a complete loss of the pigment melanin, which causes a bird or animal to be completely white with pink eyes.

The white deer at the Seneca Army Depot are leucistic, not true albinos. Last year a friend had a leucistic hummingbird all summer that was speckled with white and green feathers. I have seen deer that have just patches of white on their bodies. One in particular at camp for a few years had just white legs and another was once seen with a white face and but with a dark strip between its eyes.

Birds and animals with this condition are often called piebalds.

If you see such a creature give me a call as I would be interested in photographing it, but don't try painting something up to fool me!

If you have a problem with a bird "attacking" your windows and you can't stand the activity, you can cover your windows and live in darkness, do the netting thing, take your windows out or do like I do – just tolerate them beating themselves up and know that eventually it will stop.
