

LOST STREAM

The STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW YORK resembles another map-known to Pennsylvania anglers as the "Lost Stream Map."

It was completed in 1965 after a 30 year effort by Howard Higbee, a former Penn State Professor.

Professor Higbee painstakingly plotted by hand, the location of 45,000 miles of streams onto the map. It sold extremely well - until the printer declared bankruptcy and hauled Higbee's work to the landfill.

But reprints were impossible because the maps were printed in non-photographic blue. Higbee was even offered \$400 for one of his last maps. And state agencies were forced to keep their copies under lock and key.

Then, at the age of 91, Howard Higbee's dream came true. Computers made it possible to reprint the map.





WHAT ABOUT CAMP?

I have gotten some calls and emails recently regarding my camp down in Alleghany County because I haven't written about it since deer season. No, it hasn't been sold, but there are several reasons why it hasn't been mentioned.

First, I haven't been down there since the end of December. Apple tree pruning and firewood used to be done during the winter, but some health issues prevent that now. Another reason is the guy who owns the woods above me had another logging operation, and he assured me that the road way up through my place would be fixed up after the logging was done. Well, they made a real huge mess, so much that the water now runs down the roadway instead of the ditches to my driveway in front of the cabin, making it a muddy mess. One of my ATV bridges to cross the one ditch was completely destroyed and still lays all torn apart in the ditch. The ditches have been so messed up that when the water runs down them it just jumps up onto the roadway and washes it out some more. I will have to now get a lawyer to go after this guy to get things fixed. Funny thing about this character: he is worth millions but apparently just can't get enough, even if it means screwing over other people. Anyway, I suspected I would find everything in a mess yet and just didn't want to go down and see it.

However I finally headed down to camp this last week to check things out. Of course the road was the same mess but everything was fine with the cabin; no trees fell on it, no one had broken in and no one had been chewing on it. The grass was super high of course and the dock in the pond had been messed up by the ice and the fact that the steel posts had been getting bad.

Ok, let's go try the self-propelled 48-inch brush hog that I tow behind the ATV to mow my lawn and my "deer fields." After filling the gas tank I figured there would be some problems as even though I drain the gas from it in the fall it still sits outside all winter. This has been a great machine for me, as the single blade will cut some pretty big woody stuff but does alright on the lawn when I lower the unit down. It also works good in the "deer fields" as it can be raised up to about 8 inches to cut the top of the weeds off but not hack the clover all up.

So I start yanking on the starter cord of that 13 HP motor and figured it will probably take a good number of pulls to start it. My right hip has been killing me the last three weeks and my one shoulder has been giving me problems, so the thought is, "I'm going to be hurting after this." About 15 pulls and it takes off! I'M A HAPPY CAMPER! Now to see how that hip is going to take riding the ATV, as it bothers me when driving my van. But it doesn't seem to be a problem so off I go to attack the lawn! The lawn is about three acres around the cabin to the pond and around back of it.

I don't cut it down real short, planning on getting back down again in a few days to take it down another level and that way not making a mess with piled up cut grass. The lawn between the cabin and pond is only partly done as I got down to camp late and it is now getting dark. The next morning I get right back on it and once the lawn is done I head up to do the fields and get both of them done. That just about kills the day and I retreat into the cabin for supper and an early bed

The next day it is supposed to rain so I pack up the next morning and head home. I missed one thing at camp though, my Lab companion of 15 years – Amy. In all those years she has only missed going down the few times I ride the motorcycle down. She is just not up to the trip to camp any more and I'm afraid her days are numbered. I'm so used to her being with me that I actually threw some treats on the floor for her before it was realized that she wasn't there. I even spoke to her a few times just out of habit.

So things went pretty good the first trip down, and I will deal with that"good"neighbor later.

The other great thing was the hip seems to be getting better now; guess that ATV vibration was good for it! I just wish Amy could have been down there with Sit back and relax. We'll do the work. FSA Accepting Emergency Loan Applications

Genesee, Livingston, Niagara and Orleans counties have been declared eligible for Farm Service Agency (FSA), formerly Farmers Home Administration, disaster emergency loan assistance effective May 8, 2017, due to damages and losses caused by winter storms, excessive snow and high winds that occurred March 8, 2017, through March 20, 2017. Family farmers who have suffered of at least 30 percent of their physical loss due to the winter storms, excessive snow and high winds may be eligible for FSA loans. Proceeds from crop insurance and any FSA programs are taken into account when determining eligibility for physical losses only. Losses must be supported with documented records. Under the FSA Emergency Loan Programs farmers may be eligible for physical loss loans only of up to 100 percent of their actual losses, or the operating loan amount needed to continue in business, or a maximum principal balance outstanding of \$500,000, whichever is less. Farmers must be unable to obtain credit from private commercial lenders. The interest rate on Emergency Loans is 3.75 percent.

Application for loans under this emergency designation will be accepted until Jan. 8, 2018. The FSA office is located at 29 Liberty St., Suite 4, Batavia, NY 14020.



Ms. Mrzywka gave the class a tour



MISUSING THE LAW


