### **KENT MAN ARRESTED FOLLOWING HIT-AND-RUN ACCIDENT**

On Wed., Aug. 17, 2016, the Orleans County Sheriff's Office arrested a Kent man following an investigation into a personal injury hit-and-run motor vehicle accident in the Town of Carlton Tue., Aug. 16, 2016.

On Tue., Aug. 16, 2016, at 8:47 p.m., JEFFERY P. VANNOSTRAND, 52, of Water Street, Kent, N.Y., was travelling west on Baker Road in the Town of Carlton when he struck a bicycle being operated by an 8-year-old female. Vannostrand then allegedly left the scene.

The child was transported by Mercy Flight to Woman's and Children's Hospital in Buffalo.

Vannostrand surrendered to the Orleans County Sheriff's Office and was charged with LEAVING THE SCENE OF A PERSONAL INJURY MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT. Vannostrand was scheduled to appear in the Town of Carlton Court on Sept. 12, 2016, at 6 p.m.

The investigation was conducted by Deputy D. Pahuta and Deputy J. Narburgh. The Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Major Felony Crime Task Force.

### HOLLEY MAN CHARGED FOR ALLEGEDLY LYING **ABOUT MILITARY SERVICE TO GAIN BENEFITS**

## **ANOTHER BIG PROBLEM**

It's been slow developing but it's coming to a head now. Back in the 1970s and 1980s I spent a lot of time up around the St Lawrence River around the Odgensburg area. I went up there almost every weekend during the summer fishing perch, bass, walleye, northern pike and the mighty muskie. In the fall it was waterfowl hunting and in the spring muskrat trapping. Toward the end of my adventures on the St. Lawrence I began to notice a new bird flying up and down the river while I was fishing. They turned out to be double-crested cormorants, a fish-eating bird about the size of a small goose.



The Double-Crested Cormorant is getting to be a real problem.

This blue-eyed bird was native to Canada but wasn't

really found in NYS until the mid 1940s. They a have since increased dramatically (except for a period in the 1960s due to high levels of toxic contaminants in the food chain) from a few hundred in the 1970s to a DEC estimate of 8,000 by 1997.

The double-crested cormorant is a black bird (juveniles are a brownish color) that weights around four pounds and has a wing span of a little over four feet. Their bills, which are hooked at the end, and the lores and throat are yellow. They do not start nesting until their third year and then have 3 or 4 eggs that hatch out in about 25 days and then fledge in 35 to 42 days. They will nest on the ground when trees are not available. They are strictly fish eaters, capable of taking fish up to 12 inches but generally catch fish in the 6-inch range of which they consume 1 to 1.5 pounds per day. They are protected birds by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, but eventually some management programs were allowed such as egg-oiling, nest destruction and hazing and in some instances shooting by DEC personnel. However things have gotten much worse (DEC gave an estimate of 43,000 birds in 2004 and I bet it is staggering now 12 years later) and more drastic measures need to be taken.

So what is so bad about these birds? To start with they can cause problems with fish populations not only by eating the 6- to 12-inch fish but also the fingerlings of game species and the forage fish that our game fish depend on.

Then there is their ability to lay down large amounts of pretty gross feces. Well, sure, everyone craps, so what's the problem? Well these birds are colonial (group) nesters and roost at night in large groups which means the feces becomes very concentrated in an area, which eventually leads to the killing of all the nearby vegetation including trees. They like to sit on the piers going out into the Lake which are frequently used by tourists and fishermen, and so it not only becomes a health problem for other wildlife but also humans. I have seen islands in the St. Lawrence River completely void of vegetation and the land mass covered with their "white wash."

So do we have this cormorant problem around here? Well I have seen (by actual count) 400 of them roosting in the INWR Ringneck Marsh and another 100 plus in the Klossen Marsh in the DEC Tonawanda WMA in the spring and early summer. They have started nesting in this area now too. A couple years ago there were 5 or 6 nests on Ringneck Marsh but an immature bald eagle ate all the young ones! GOOD EAGLE! Now they are nesting in the woods on the east side of Route 63 just south of the Oak Orchard creek in the INWR great blue heron rookery. There is another area of even more concern to me and that is at Point Breeze, here in Orleans County. Of course local folks up along the Lake have been noticing a large spike of them for years but now they are roosting right across the creek from the boat ramp at the Point. There is a chunk of State land there where they are roosting but they are now overlapping on to private land. How many are there? Well one evening I started counting them about 6pm, long before all the birds come to the roosting area. A quick count with field glasses gave me a count of 200 birds plus more were coming all the time and there was a pile of them on the outer breaker wall. This is going to be snowballing with nesting shortly starting. It is going to affect tourism, our salmon and trout fishery, private property and even the marina itself. Folks are going to start finding them roosting around the cottages along the Lake. So what's the problem with their management? Ask the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, as they are the ones who set migratory bird hunting seasons. Can't oil eggs or destroy the nests if they are up in the trees and hazing them only sends them to out to create another problem area. The DEC manages deer and resident geese problems with public hunting, so what's the problem? What are we going to do, wait until the problem is completely out of control? # **Pecan-Crusted Chicken Tenders with Yogurt Dill** Dip

Serves 4

### **INGREDIENTS:**

## For the chicken:

- 1/2 cup pecans
- 1/3 cup whole-wheat flour
- 2 teaspoons paprika
- 2 teaspoons dry mustard 2 teaspoons garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 1 tablespoon expeller-pressed canola oil
- 1/2 cup panko bread crumbs
- 1 large egg
- 1 pound chicken tenders, larger pieces cut in half lengthwise

Preheat the oven to 475 F and line a sheet pan with parchment paper. Whir pecans, flour, paprika, dry mustard, garlic and onion powder, salt, and pepper in a food processor until pecans are ground to a powder, about 30 seconds. Drizzle in the oil with the motor running, blending completely. Transfer mixture to a shallow dish and stir in the panko bread crumbs.

Beat the egg in a second shallow dish and add the chicken tenders, coating them completely. Transfer each tender to the breading, turning to coat evenly. Arrange the chicken on the prepared pan. Bake until golden brown and nearly firm, about 8 minutes.

To make the dip: Stir all the dip ingredients together in a small bowl.

Enjoy the cooked chicken immediately with the dip.

Note: Chicken tenders come from the undersides of chicken breasts and are naturally portioned into strips, saving you time in cutting them. If you don't have chicken tenders, substitute chicken breasts cut into 4- x 1-inch strips. Downtown Lyndonville
