





Last week I was going out into the swamp evenings to try and capture green herons, great egrets and blackcrown night herons in flight. Knowing where they were roosting in the evenings helped me to get in a good position to catch them flying to that area. About dusk a funny flying bird came out of that roosting area at a real

far distance from me and flew off. All that could be seen was it was good size and flying differently than the normal birds I see. A few distant shots were taken in hopes that when the images were enlarged it would give me a clue to what it was. It turned out to be a white ibis, a Florida bird! It's a white bird with about a 3-foot wingspan with blacktipped wings. It kind of looks like an egret except its long bill curves downward and is a reddish orange color. I've never seen one before around here, and I didn't get a good picture of it but I considered myself lucky to see it.

The next evening I visited the same general area but this time I wore some good camouflage and hunkered down in the tall grass near some cattails. My butt no sooner hit the ground that a doe with two cute fawns came to the water's edge just across the borrow ditch. She never really spotted me, and I got some neat shots of them.

Then not much later a peregrine falcon came tearing low across the borrow ditch chasing some small bird. They were so low that they almost knocked my hat off! It all happened so fast that there was no chance to get the camera on him. This is only the second falcon I have seen in the swamps. After calming down I went back to trying to capture my intended targets when about 15 minutes later here he comes again but this time hits what looks like a Virginia Rail in mid-air! He turns and flies across in front of me and I get off four quick shots; two are perfect! The rest of the evening brought me some good opportunities on flight shots of my targeted birds with the Great Egrets

really cooperating. The shots of the falcon carrying off his supper really made the day. The next day a gal named Jackie and her Aunt Becky sent me an email about a leucistic hummingbird at their feeders on Lake Alice. Leucistic is a condition where there is a partial lost of color pigmentation causing an animal or bird to have areas of white. It is a very rare condition in nature. I once had the chance to photograph a leucistic cardinal, and the deer they call "piebalds" are results of the same condition. From past experience it has been learned that you don't put off trying to get a image of these creatures, so I headed up to Lake Alice that evening.

When I arrived Becky was out by the mail box and said he is here right now! We sat down on the back porch and eventually I got some good shots of this beautiful and rare Ruby-throated hummingbird. He was mostly white with patches of green on his sides and back. Boy, was I running a lucky streak here!

This week I went up one evening to see if I could get some hovering shots of this bird. After having some success I headed to nearby Lake Ontario near Sunset Beach to see if I could get a good sunset shot. A friend greeted me there, and as we were walking to good area to capture the colorful sunset that was developing she mentioned that there had been a Bald Eagle hanging around the area and this evening it sat in a near by tree next to the water, just watched some boats and people go by. She pointed to a conifer tree up ahead and mentioned that it was the tree where they have been seeing it perched a lot. As I looked the tree over I spotted an eagle's head and could see it was a 3-year-old bird just starting to get its white head and tail.

We walked to the tree and the eagle never moved, so I walked to the other side of the tree and past it a ways in hopes of getting a clearer shot even though lighting conditions had gotten poor. The sun was setting and some great color was forming, so after getting some good images of the eagle I rushed back the to best spot area to capture some great sunset colors on the calm Lake. So I got lucky on another photo adventure!

Now I'm starting to worry that something unfortunate is going to happen to me! Can this good fortune continue? Well, yes, because a lot of great readers of this column have contacted me about their nature sightings this year and given me many chances to get some great shots. 

BONK, 24, of Albion, attempted to escape custody by running out of the Medina Hospital Emergency Department where he was being treated for reported health issues. When the Emergency Department door opened, Bonk ran out the door, though the lobby and out of the building. Bonk had reportedly pulled his leg shackles up higher on his legs to make it easier to run. Bonk was pursued by two nurses from the E.D., Capri Sullivan and Stephanie Atwell along with Orleans County Sheriff's Office Correction Officer Steven Corrigan. Sullivan and Atwell were able to catch Bonk and take him to the ground about 80 yards north of the hospital on Ohio Street. The nurses, Officer Corrigan and Chriss Jones, a physician assistant from the E.D. attempted to pin Bonk down and handcuff him as he continued to resist and fight. Shortly thereafter, the Medina Police Department and Sheriff's deputies arrived and Bonk was secured.

Nurse Sullivan, Nurse Atwell and Correction Officer Corrigan were treated and released for injuries resulting from this incident.

Bonk had been remanded to the Orleans County Jail earlier in the day on Aug. 4, on the charge of CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF A FORGED INSTRUMENT IN THE 1ST DEGREE.

Bonk was charged with ESCAPE IN THE SECOND DEGREE, RESISTING ARREST, TWO COUNTS OF ASSAULT IN THE THIRD DEGREE, ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGEREE ON A CORRECTION OFFICER. Bonk was arraigned before Ridgeway Town Justice Joseph Kujawa. Bail was set at \$30,000 cash, \$300,000 bond. Bonk returned to the Town of Ridgeway Court on Aug. 8, 2016.

This incident was investigated by Sgt D. Foeller, Deputy A. Breuilly, Deputy D. Pahuta, and Deputy J. Doyle. The Orleans County Sheriff's Office would like to commend the staff at the Medina Hospital for the assistance they provided on the evening of Aug. 4, 2016.

## APPEALING IDEAS

Either side in a civil case can decide to appeal the ruling. ## **Tortillas Have Been Enjoyed Throughout History**

Tortillas are a staple of Latin cooking and have been for quite some time, dating as far back as 10,000 BC. Tortillas were prominent during the time of the Aztecs, the dominant people in the area of Mesoamerica, which would be later known as Mexico.

The name "tortilla" can be traced to Spanish explorers who reached the highlands of Mexico in the sixteenth century looking for gold and land. These explorers discovered a wealth of new foods, such as chocolate, peanuts, vanilla, beans, squash, avocados, coconuts, corn, tomatoes, and, of course, tortillas.

The word "tortilla" comes from the Spanish word "torta," meaning round cake. Tortillas aren't cakes but flatbreads made from corn or flour. The original method of preparing tortillas involved kneading a cornmeal dough, called "masa," on a stone called a "metate."

According to La Tortilla Loca, tortillas have become a staple of mainstream diets in the United States and elsewhere around the world.

Although premade tortillas are available at many grocery stores, making tortillas from scratch is part of the fun of preparing Hispanic cuisine. Those interested in making their own tortillas can use the following recipe for "Homemade Corn Tortillas" courtesy of Mely Martinez, founder of the popular food blog "Mexico in My Kitchen."

# **Homemade Corn Tortillas**

Makes 12 tortillas

## **INGREDIENTS:**

2 cups masa harina

1 1/4 cups of warm water (this may vary depending on air humidity and other conditions)

2 pieces of round plastic cut out from a bag (freezer bags are ideal for this purpose)

Use a wooden bowl to combine the masa harina and water. Mix well until the water is absorbed evenly and the dough forms a ball. You are looking for a soft dough consistency; it should not stick to your hands. If it does, add a little more masa



harina. If it looks dry, breakable or crumbly, add more water. Cover with a moist towel to prevent the dough from drying.

Preheat a griddle or heavy skillet over a medium flame. This has to be ready when you start pressing the tortillas.

Using a tortilla press or a heavy dish, place a ball of the dough about 11/2 inches in diameter between the two plastic pieces and press to form a 6-inch round tortilla.

Open the tortilla press or remove the heavy dish, if using, to press the tortillas and peel the top plastic off. If the pressed tortilla has an uneven edge, then the dough is too dry and you will need to add a little water and mix well. Lift the plastic with the pressed tortilla, place the dough in your hand closer to your fingers and carefully peel the plastic off the dough. If the dough doesn't come off easily, then the dough could be a little too wet. Add some more masa harina to the dough mix again until it becomes easier to handle.

Place the tortilla on the griddle and cook for 45 seconds. The edge will begin to dry out. Turn over and continue to cook for 1 minute until brown patches form. Turn over again and cook for another 15 seconds. The cooking time is about 2 minutes. Cook until the tortilla begins to puff. Tap the tortilla lightly with your fingertips to allow even puffing. Wrap with a napkin or clean towel and serve.
