

As many of you know, I located a new bald eagle nest up in the Carlton area this past winter. It was started the year before, but there was no actual egg laying. Sometimes young adult eagles only build a nest their first year without producing eggs. Ospreys often do this too and it seems to be a bonding thing for newly paired adults.

Being involved with bald eagle nests in this area for over 20 years, this "find" was quite exciting for me. I kept tabs on the nest all spring and knew when they started incubating. I had been watching from about 700 yards with a good spotting scope, but getting near the time they should have been hatching (roughly 35 days after laying) I became concerned. A friend who works for the DEC, Denise Appleby, had been helping me keep tabs on the nest and noticed one evening that neither adult were around the nest and temperatures were below freezing. The next evening, (April 3) I went to observe and when I got there about 7:15 p.m., there wasn't a bird seen anywhere around the nest area. About 10 minutes later, the male came in and started incubating. The temperature was around 26 degrees. About 7:45 p.m., the female came in and the male left, but the female eventually followed him to perch near him in a nearby wood lot, but returned to the nest a few minutes later. However, she never started incubating until just before dark, about 8 p.m.

I might mention here that the female could be identified by her larger size, which is always the case with eagles, but also by the "dirty" patches on the sides of her white head. Later, closeup head pictures were sent to NYS eagle expert Peter Nye, who confirmed that it was most likely a 4-year-old bird. Most eagles get their white head and tail at about 5 years of age, but some start earlier.

Periodic observations showed that they were way overdue to hatch, as there were no signs of feeding of young. Eagle eggs hatch about 35 days after they are laid, but we were way past that now. Another call was made to Peter to find out how long they would incubate bad eggs before giving up. He told me he had seen them go 84 days and confirmed my suspicions as we were getting close to 80 days then.

Heat mirage was getting to be a problem from 700 yards because of the warm temperatures we were getting. So I contacted the farmer who owns the land around the nest and he gave me permission to drive back on a lane he had to better observe the nest. On June 2 an eaglet was spotted in the nest and looked to be about a week old! Going back to watch again on June 6, two eaglets were spotted. Peter was contacted again about the good news and he figured the first clutch of eggs were bad. They were a young pair of birds. Maybe they had not been properly caring for the eggs which we had observed earlier or the eggs were just not good and then gave up and laid a second clutch. This is a very rare happening, only about 10 percent of the time will a second clutch be laid if the first fails.

Things went along smoothly and the eaglets were growing fast. I checked on them about every week and on June 24 they were getting their dark feathers. Eaglets don't fledge from the nest until they are around 10 weeks old, so they had a while to go yet. However there were a lot of coon tracks along the bank of the stream that the nest tree was on and I became concerned. I talked to my buddy Mike Elam about going back and putting that guard up around the tree. We were unable to do earlier before they laid eggs because of a late winter storm and lane conditions to get back there. These adults were quite tolerant of people as they were used to the farmer working the fields near the nest, and with the eaglets now being 5 weeks old, there should be no problem doing it the following week. The only problem was about the time we were going to do that I had a major water supply problem and we ended up getting that taken care of instead. Right after July 4 I was able to get away to check on the nest one evening. An hour-andhalf watch showed no adult or eaglets. I was betting a coon got up there one night and got the young since my last visit. The next morning Mike and I went in with metal flange and put a guard up on the nest tree and the one next to it. Then we started searching the creek around the nest tree and eventually Mike found the remains of one of the eaglets. DAMN RACCOONS! We kick ourselves for not getting that guard up earlier. The good news is they were determined parents on their first nesting season and hopefully they will return to that same nest next year and will be safe from the same tragedy. But you hate to see the loss of one pair of young eagles after Peter Nye, his partner Mike Allen and many others worked so hard to get the bald eagle reestablished in NYS after there had been no successful nesting for so many years. 

What to Expect with a Civil Ceremony

Many people dream of a wedding in a church or synagogue before dozens of family members and friends, while there are others who prefer to forgo the fanfare of a large wedding ceremony and are content with a civil wedding instead.

Civil ceremonies are often a choice for couples who may have different religious beliefs or do not belong to a particular religious persuasion. In lieu of being presided over by a pastor, priest or rabbi, civil ceremonies are conducted by an authorized official, such as a judge or justice of the peace. The marriage also can be performed by a licensed wedding officiant. Depending on where a couple lives, mayors or even notary publics can solemnize a marriage. Pilots and ship captains also may be able to preside over the ceremony. Some states and provinces will allow anyone to solemnize a wedding, provided they have filed for a special permit for the day.

In terms of location, the most basic of civil ceremonies take place at the county courthouse, where paperwork is immediately filed. Ceremonies also occur at City Hall. Couples can choose to hire an officiant to go to another location to oversee the marriage ceremony. The latter is the more expensive option and will be based on the officiant's schedule.

The structure of a civil marriage is much more lax than those which follow the more traditional course. Rather than being required to wear a certain wardrobe or meet with the requirements of a particular church or other house of worship, couples often find flexibility with the civil route. Although some brides and grooms prefer to wear a tuxedo or suit and a wedding gown, it is not necessary to do so. There are many couples who have tied the knot in more casual clothing or even costumes.

In order to participate in a civil ceremony, couples must secure a marriage license. This is usually obtained by a county registrar or another officer of records where the couple lives. Regulations will vary as to the time period in which the ceremony can be done after the marriage license is received. Some licenses may be voided if the couple does not tie the knot within a few days of securing the license.

When the ceremony will take place is generally up to the couple and, if a member of the judiciary will be overseeing the wedding, the courthouse. 
There is often a fee collected for the wedding ceremony in addition to what was paid for the marriage license. For those hiring a private officiant, the fee will be much higher than what a clerk of the court will cost. The couple will need to bring the marriage license and photo identification. Certain municipalities require witnesses, who will need to be present with their own photographic identification. These witnesses will be needed to sign the marriage certificate.

Because there is no firm tradition with civil ceremonies, couples may need to be more handson when it comes to executing the wedding. Here are some tips to consider.

• An officiant may not organize the wedding, meaning it will be up to the couple to choose vows, arrange where people will stand, request any clerical blessings, or include any other special elements.

• Some officiants enjoy presiding over weddings, while others see it as just a part of public duty. Couples can try to find an officiant who meets with their approval and will keep with the tone that is expected of the ceremony. • For those adding personal vows, keep them brief and tailored to the occasion. • Know how many people can attend the ceremony in advance. Couples should recognize that space could be limited and restricted to only a few people if the wedding is taking place at the courthouse. • Arrange the venue for a party afterward. Couples may choose to record a video of the ceremony for playback at a reception to enable those who were not in attendance to be part of the special moment where the rings and vows were exchanged. ceremonies Civil are advantageous to those who have factors that may make a religious ceremony unfavorable.

the potatoes are still hot, mash them using a ricer, food mill or potato masher. Add the mayonnaise, vinegar and 1/2 teaspoon salt to the warm potatoes and whip with a wooden spoon until light and fluffy. Set aside to cool.

2. Meanwhile, fill a small saucepan with water, season it generously with salt and bring it to a boil over high heat. Add the carrots and edamame and cook until crisptender, about 3 minutes. Drain, rinse under cold water and dry well.

3. Put the cucumbers in a bowl and sprinkle with 1/2teaspoon salt. Toss to coat evenly and set aside for 15 minutes. Wrap the cucumbers in a kitchen towel or paper towels and squeeze out as much liquid as you can.

4. Add the cucumbers, carrots, edamame, and green onions to the cooled potato mixture and stir to combine well. Taste and adjust the seasoning. Cover and refrigerate for up to 2 days.
