

Stepping Back In Time at the Memorial Salute

The Papa John's Red, White, and Blue Memorial Salute was held Saturday night, May 27, and the audience was taken back in time with the music of the Brick Street Barbershop Quartet from Clinton, the 41st Army Jazz Ensemble, and The Victory Belles from the National WWII Museum in New Orleans. The event was a fundraiser for the Veterans Memorial Museum in Laurel.

The harmonic sound of the Brick Street Barbershop Quartet echoed through the Bush Fine Arts Auditorium on the JCJC campus with songs such as "Hello Mary Lou," "Under the Boardwalk," "Sh-Boom," "Ghost Riders," and the quartet's own "Mississippi." The quartet's comedic act had folks laughing while swaying to the music. The four voices of the quartet included Tommy Steadman – tenor, Greg Gibson – lead, Brad Feaster – bass, and Bill Bacon – baritone.

The 41st Army Jazz Ensemble with two tubas, trombone, trumpet, sax, and entertained with more contemporary jazz music. The highlight of the evening was the performance of the Victory Belles who provided the music and sound of three famous sisters from Minnesota who entertained the troops during WWII. With songs such as "In the Mood," "Boogie Woogie Bugle Boy," "The Trolley Song," "Chattanooga Choo Choo," and "As Time Goes By," the rich three-part harmony of Emily, Hannah, and Mandi took the audience back to the sound of America's war time sweet hearts, the Andrew Sisters.

The fundraising event was organized by John W. "John Boy" Pace. "I fell in love with the Veterans Memorial Museum in Laurel after spending more than two hours in the museum with Jimmy Bass," said Pace. Pace, who is known for organizing fundraising events across the Pine Belt, said he wants to help the museum not only raise money for day to day operations, but raise money to add on to the museum.

A Shepherd's Heart – One life to give

We have recently observed the most solemn day of the year in America, Memorial Day. This day is a day for us as American citizens to pause and remember those who have given their full measure of devotion to this great nation. Their sacrifice was made while they were fighting to protect us as a nation and the freedom that we have as American citizens. This day serves to remind us that our freedom isn't free.

As we witness gatherings across our land on each Memorial Day to honor the lives of the fallen, we also view this day as the beginning of a summer vacation season. Just like other special days in the lives of Americans, we tend to run quickly away from the somber things to the celebratory things. In Derric Johnson's book entitled, "The Wonder of America: Remarkable Stories Celebrating the Spirit of Our Nation," he recounts the story of a man named Nathan Hale. Nathan was a schoolteacher for two years when the war began. He was twenty-one years old and was involved in the Long Island campaign that was bordering on being disastrous. General Washington needed someone to sneak over the lines to gather some information. Nathan knew that spying was a dangerous job, but he also knew that taking on a job that had to be done was the custom of American heroes.

Dressed like a Dutch schoolmaster, Nathan ventured through enemy lines and gathered the information needed. However, on his way back he was found with the information, and he admitted to the British that he was a spy. This led to his scheduled hanging. Before he died, they allowed Nathan to say whatever he wanted to. So with the noose around his neck he told them his name, his rank and then he added: "I only regret that I have but one life to lose for my country." In so doing, he showed the world what Americans are made of.

God's word teaches us about a costly freedom as well. In the Gospel of John, we are reminded of the words of Jesus as he was teaching his disciples, "Greater love has no man that this, than to lay down his life for his friends." Tuesday evening, Laurel Fire Department and three Jones County Volunteer Fire Departments came together to participate in a joint fire exercise at the Laurel Fairgrounds. Chief James Brown of Laurel Fire Department stated, "we had some dilapidated structures that were tore down by the fairground and they asked us to assist in doing away with them and we chose to burn them down, so it gave us an opportunity to work together - city of Laurel and the county volunteers." And with a flick of a match, the firefighters did just that. Both city and county firefighters worked together to ensure the fire remained under control at all times and any surrounding structures were protected from the extreme heat. According to Jones County Fire Coordinator, Dan McKenna, the training and working with the fire hydrants, the training burn also provided a key opportunity for Laurel and county firefighters to work together, as a means to prepare for any incidents that may require mutual aid. "The more we work together on exercises like this is extremely important because when we have a real incident, it's so much easier, it's fluid," said Dan McKenna. Understanding how to work together for future incidents is pivotal for a successful outcome.

Although these types of training exercises haven't been common in the past, both county and city fire departments plan to conduct more in the future as a means to continue a positive relationship with one another, and to assure the public that they are protected against disaster. 

June 5-9 Wound Care Awareness Week

By Linda Cranford with Becky Collins In accordance with the declaration by Governor Phil Bryant that the state of Mississippi will dedicate the entire week of June 5 to June 9 to educating physicians, patients and the general public about the chronic wound epidemic and the advanced wound care solutions, Mayor Johnny Magee presented a proclamation Tuesday, May 30, declaring June 5 - 9 as Wound Care Awareness Week in the City of Laurel.

According to Becky Collins, Director of Community Relations and South Central Health Care Foundation at SCRMC, the South Central Wound Care and Hyperbaric Medicine Center at South Central Regional Medical Center, a member of the Healogics network, is helping raise awareness of chronic wounds by participating in this fourth annual Wound Care Awareness Week. South Central Wound Care and Hyperbaric Medicine was recently named a Center of Distinction for excellent healing rates and superior patient satisfaction. The center offers advanced therapies to patients suffering from chronic wounds.

It is estimated that chronic wounds affect 6.7 million people in the U.S. and the incidence is rising, fueled by an aging population and increasing rates of diseases and conditions such as diabetes, obesity and the late effects of radiation therapy. If left untreated, chronic wounds can lead to diminished quality of life and possibly amputation of the affected limb.

"We see patients living with non-healing wounds for a prolonged amount of time due to the lack of awareness of advanced wound care options," said Stacy Street, M.D., Wound Care and Hyperbaric Medicine Center Medical Director. "We work to educate community physicians about which of their patients can benefit from advanced wound care, and then provide coordinated care to heal that patient's wounds."

A large crowd gathered at the Veterans Memorial Museum in Laurel Monday morning for a Memorial Day Ceremony remembering those who gave their all in service to our country.

Rob Ruffin, with the museum, welcomed everyone and the Disabled American Veterans color guard presented the colors. As the flag was slowly raised in front of the museum, the "National Anthem" was sung by Penny Walters, as the flag was raised on the flagpole. Walters sang several songs throughout the program. Vic Lee led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and Kent Miller gave the invocation. Ruffin recognized Gold Star Mothers in attendance which included only one, Mrs. Irma Poore who lost her son, Robert Poore, in Vietnam in 1969.

The keynote speaker was Pastor Matt Olson of the First Baptist Church of Sharon. Quoting Ezekiel 22:30 Olson spoke of how the verse describes God's reply to the request of the religious leaders of Israel for God to bless their land again. The leaders had become so wicked and turned away from God that He could not bless Jerusalem and Israel. Olson said, "In Ezekiel 22, verse 30, God said, 'So, I sought for a man among you who would make a wall and stand in the gap before me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it. But, I found no one.' I think God is still looking for men and women today who will stand up. Who will build a wall of protection, and will stand in the gap for God to provide continually for this nation. What we are doing today, is honoring those who have done just that. We are honoring those men and women who have given their lives, that ultimate sacrifice, and said we are building a wall to protect this nation that we love so dearly. God is saying today, I'm still looking for men and women who will stand in the gap. The question we should be asking today, is not will God bless America, but will America bless God."

The program ended with a 21-gun salute by the Rosin Heels Chapter of the Sons of Confederate Veterans and the playing of "TAPS" by John Rhoden, Jr.






