IT HAS STARTED!

The last few weeks have found me at camp a lot cutting, splitting and stacking firewood. My wood for this year was actually done last year, as I'm a firm believer that firewood needs a good year to dry before using. We heat solely with firewood at home and camp, but in both cases the dwellings are well insulated and the wood stoves are very efficient, so the amount of wood needed is not extremely high. However it still involves a great deal of work. As they often say wood

warms you many times: when you cut the trees down and then into firewood sizes, when you haul it out of the woods, when you split it, when you stack it, when you eventually haul it into the dwelling where it will be used, and when you carry it into that dwelling to actually burn. WOW, no wonder I'm tired all the time!

So being at camp this time of the year is work but a lot of pleasure also comes around. The temperatures are dropping, making working conditions more comfortable, and the air seems more refreshing. You also get to watch Nature unfold her fall show as the leaves on the trees begin to show their hidden colors. This past week you could see that change coming, and on the way home from camp during the beginning of the week you could notice that some trees were getting into it, especially some red maples.

The next few weeks Nature will be putting on a real show of colors, and you can bet my camera will be used a lot. Although hundreds of pictures of fall foliage have been taken in the past I just can't seem to get enough. To me it provides a challenge to capture the beautiful colors with the camera the same as my eyes see them and then preserving them before they are gone.

So what causes these color changes? Many folks think "Jack Frost" is responsible for the fall colors, but in reality frost will inhibit the pigment producing the various shades of red. Actually those colors are always there but are masked by the green color of chlorophyll pigment during the summer. In the fall daylight length and temperatures drop causing the chlorophyll to break down and thus expose the other (hidden) colors.

As a rule maples give out reds, oranges and yellows. Aspens, hickory and birch will show yellow and most oaks are brownish but will sometimes be a dark red.

The leaves themselves begin to fall from the trees when a layer of cells forms at the base of the leaf stalk. This causes the tissues to weaken at this point allowing the leaf to fall. This is why we sometimes see leaves falling like snow when there is no wind.

If you are really into fall's color show you can enjoy its beauty at least twice in New York State. The show usually starts in the Adirondacks near the end of September, while the display in the Southern Tier doesn't really get going until after the first week of October. Of course areas differ due to various weather conditions. I think this year is not going to be as spectacular as usual because of the dry and warm conditions we have had, but there will always some outstanding trees here and there to bring pleasure to our eyes.

Two wildflowers that are bringing a dash of color right now are the Golden Rod and New England aster. The Golden Rod provides a nice touch of yellow to our uncultivated fields when surrounding the blue flowers of the New England aster.

For several years some of these aster were dug up from surrounding areas around camp and transplanted by the cabin and pond. They have expanded a lot now and put on a great show for me each year as they announce the coming of fall. By "pinching" off the tops throughout the summer they are forced to branch more and thus provide more flowers. For some reason I have one bunch of these asters near the front porch of the cabin that are a exceptionally deep blue, so much so that I have been "forced" to take their portrait on several different days!








Whereas professionals may have once worked for the same company for the majority, if not the entirety, of their careers, nowadays it's not uncommon for men and women to change jobs several times before reaching retirement. Changing jobs and changing careers are not necessarily the same thing. Professionals mulling a career change will have to consider a host of factors that men and women looking to change jobs may never have to contemplate. Such factors may include returning to school and lifestyle changes designed to make living on less income more feasible

Professionals changing careers may also need to develop a strategy for handling job interviews. When changing jobs as opposed to careers, professionals can draw attention to their résumés, essentially letting their experience speak for itself. But while experience is often a feather in a job candidate's cap, professionals changing careers may need to focus more on their futures than their pasts when interviewing for a new career.

• Draw attention to those skills that will apply to your new career. All of your experience and skills likely won't transfer to your new career, but that does not mean you're going in with an empty briefcase. Make a list of your most transferable skills, and develop an interview strategy that highlights those skills and explains how they can be applied in both the near future and over the course of your new career.

• Use your contacts to your advantage. Even if much of your experience won't transfer to your new career, your professional network might still be valuable to a prospective employer. The longer you have been working the larger your professional network likely is, so highlight those contacts in your interview and illustrate how you can put them to good use should you be hired. • Showcase how you have adapted in the past. Much of the business world moves at a breakneck pace. That pace has become even faster thanks to advancements in technology that routinely affect how businesses operate. Even if you have never before changed careers, that does not mean you have not adapted to change. Make a list of the changes your employers have instituted throughout your career, highlighting how you adapted to those changes and benefitted from them in their aftermath. • Remain positive throughout the interview. Even if you are changing careers because you're unhappy and/or unfulfilled in your present line of work, avoid bad-mouthing that industry and your past employers. Doing so will only reflect negatively on you and raise a red flag with prospective employers. Instead, explain your reasons for pursuing a new career path in terms that excite potential employers about your candidate. The decision to change careers can induce both excitement and anxiety. Maintaining a positive attitude and employing various strategies when interviewing with prospective employers can help make the transition to a new career go smoothly.



· Health educator: The United States Bureau of Labor Statistics reports that between 2012 and 2022, the job outlook, which projects the percent change in employment, for health educators and community workers was 21 percent, nearly twice the average growth rate for all occupations during the same period. Health educators perform a host of tasks, including teaching and promoting various wellness practices. Health educators may also develop strategies and campaigns to promote wellness.

• Massage therapist: Massage therapists help people recover from injury and relieve stress, but they also might be used to improve circulation and increase relaxation, both of which can contribute to their patients' long-term health. The BLS projects the job outlook for massage therapists between 2012 and 2022 to be 23 percent, indicating that there figures to be an array of opportunities available to men and women interested in pursuing massage therapy. 




