



HOW THE BALD EAGLE **RETURNED TO NEW YORK**

carriers

Your chances of seeing a bald eagle soaring across the sky or sitting in a tree around a marsh in this area is pretty good today, and this situation is getting better every year. I spend a lot of time photographing in our refuge areas and also keeping tabs on our nesting eagles, so I see eagles quite frequently. Just this last week I saw a new pair of adult eagles in our "swamp," so a new nest may be on its way. We have four active nests between the federal and state

refuge areas here. There are several more on private land in the surrounding area and probably a couple more we haven't found yet.

However, this has not always been the case, because mankind screwed them up, along with a lot of other birds with the insecticide DDT back in the 1940s. At that time it was believed to be a "wonder cure" for controlling mosquitoes and many crop-eating insects. However, it killed small birds outright and the fish and small mammals were being contaminated, which in turn affected the larger birds of prey such as the osprey, peregrine falcons, and of course our bald eagle. The effect was gradual, but what happened was that it accumulated in the bodies of these birds of prey and in time caused them to have very thin eggshells. This in turn caused the eggs to easily break while being incubated and eventually there was no successful reproduction. Being long-lived birds this was not noticed in the early years, but eventually we caught on and the DDT was banned in 1972. By this time the damage had already been done.

In 1976, New York State only had one nesting pair of eagles left (Hemlock Lake) and they had produced only a few young in 11 years because the female just had too much build up of the DDT and most of her eggs were unsuccessful. Because eagles do not mate until they are 4 or even 5 years old you can see where things were headed; no young to mature to mating ages, no birds to fill the loss of old birds.

The peregrine falcon had been pushed almost into extinction because of heavy DDT usage east of the Mississippi River, but some Cornell folks figured out a way to breed and raise them in captivity and then eventually released into the wild to start to rebuild their numbers.

In 1976, two young men working for the DEC were given the task to learn all they could about bald eagles for the next two years and eventually come up with a plan for the restoration of the birds in New York State. This they did with dedication and working with the fellow who led the way for restoring the peregrine falcon they came up with a plan; one that was totally new with bald eagles.

What these two fellows decided to try was something called hacking, where a young bird from another nest would be put in the nest, at the right time, of the last remaining eagles in NYS that would hopefully accept and raise it. That happened and the idea for a large-scale hacking program was formulated and the new restoration project started. Young eaglets were gotten from other states where the eagles were being successful and raised in special hacking towers here that were basically large cages up 35 feet on telephone poles. The birds were hand raised with minimum human contact and released into the wild at the proper time. Hopefully these "new" birds, that were not laced with DDT, would become the nucleus of a new generation of bald eagles in NYS.

Of course this had to be done on a large scale across the state and it would be at least four years to find out if this project was working and even longer for the eagle population to really take off.

So these two young men, with the help of volunteers, dedicated their lives to bringing

the eagle back to us. Eventually four different hacking sites were used across the state from 1976 until 1988. It has been a long journey, but a very successful one with one of the first three new eagle nests actually popping up on the Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge in 1986 as a direct result of hacking program in the State Oak Orchard Wildlife Management Area in 1981 and 1982 where a total of 42 eaglets were raised.

These two dedicated men, Peter Nye (head of the NYS Endangered Species Unit) and Mike Allen (a Wildlife Technician in Avon), have given us back our national bird. Both these men have retired, but they are still very active in the welfare of our eagles. Now the eagles may be up against other dangers such as new chemicals in the environment, wind turbines and possible mining near the Iroquois National Refuge. We didn't know all the problems we created in the 1940s with DDT, do we really know what kind of problems we are creating now?

To hear the whole story of the return of the bald eagle to NYS join one of these dedicated eagle men, Mike Allen, on Nov. 2, at the Barker High School Cafeteria at 1628 Quaker Road at 7 p.m. The event is free to the public and you really don't want to miss this wonderful opportunity to look into the restoration of our National bird that WE almost drove into extinction through our ignorance!

More nests are showing up along the Lake Ontario shoreline and we need to know where they are so they can be protected from predators (raccoons) and US!

HEAP SEASON BEGINS NOV. 14, 2016







Indicators It's Time to Change Air Filters

Vehicle maintenance can protect drivers' investments and help their automobiles run efficiently. One area drivers should pay particular attention to is their vehicles' air filters. When operating at optimal capacity, an air filter improves fuel efficiency while ensuring vehicles accelerate smoothly without taxing the engine. But when air filters are clogged, fuel efficiency is reduced and emissions are increased, a 1-2 punch that costs motorists money and hurts the planet at the same time. Drivers can check their owners' manuals to determine the recommended intervals to replace air filters, but the following are a handful of indicators that suggest it's time to change them.

• Gas mileage: Unless you just purchased your vehicle, you likely know how many miles you can drive on a full tank of gas. If that gas mileage is suddenly slipping and you find yourself visiting the filling station more frequently, then it might be time to replace your air filter.

• Engine light: Drivers may be alerted to engine issues when the "Check engine" lights up on the vehicle's dashboard. This light may come on to indicate a problem with the air filter, as clogged air filters reduce air flow to the engine, resulting in an imbalanced air-fuel mixture that adversely affects the engine.

• Starting and idling problems: Vehicles sometimes don't start up as smoothly as they once did, and drivers may also notice vehicles are not idling smoothly. These symptoms may indicate misfiring spark plugs that are being polluted (and made less effective) by a dirty air filter that is reducing the flow of air to the engine.

Automobiles that are operating at peak capacity accelerate quickly. But dirty, worn out air filters adversely affect acceleration. Drivers who notice that their cars are struggling to accelerate when stoplights turn green or on highways may need to replace their vehicles' air filters.

• Dirty air filter: Perhaps the biggest indicator that an air filter needs to be replaced is the filter itself. If you cannot find the air filter on your own, consult your vehicle owner's manual to determine where it is. Once you find the air filter, examine it in broad daylight. Clean air filters are white, so if the filter has darkened, it may need to be replaced.





Protect Your Vehicle From Snow, Ice, & Damage from the Cold

Winter can be an unforgiving season. Freezing temperatures coupled with snow and ice can take its toll on people who live in climates where cold weather is a fact of winter life.

While winter can test people's patience, it also can be harsh on cars and trucks. Understanding what components of a vehicle can be compromised by dropping temperatures and snowy roads can help drivers take action to safeguard their automotive investments.

While winter can wreak havoc on just about every part of a vehicle, there are some parts that seem to bear the brunt of Old Man Winter's abuse. Properly servicing and caring for a car or truck can help.

Drivers should take their vehicles for a tune-up and inspection before wintry weather arrives. A mechanic will examine the car battery and check antifreeze levels and make sure that the thermostat, defroster, brakes, and even wiper blades are working effectively. Have the tires inspected for adequate tread, which can make navigating roads safer. If the treads are worn, replace the tires.

In addition to visiting their mechanics, drivers can perform some inspections and fixes themselves.

· Check that all of the vehicle's lights are operational so your car can be easily seen during inclement weather. Exchange your existing windshield washer fluid with one that will not freeze in cold conditions. Check the nozzles on the windshield-washer system routinely and clear out any blockages of ice or debris. While addressing windshield washer fluid, also replace worn out windshield wiper blades with ones that can withstand snow and icv weather.

· A new coating of wax can serve as a shield against road salt, snow, sleet, and rain. Try a polymer wax to protect the paint. Whenever possible, rinse off salt and grime so it does not dry on the car and gradually wear away at the paint. Some drivers mistakenly believe that salt stops being a problem once it dries simply because moisture is the active ingredient for a corrosive reaction. But humidity in the air is enough to keep the salt eating away at the car's paint, and that can contribute to rust. Be sure to rinse off the undercarriage of the vehicle as well.

· Have your tires' alignment checked toward the end of winter or early spring. A season of traveling over pothole-ridden roads or hitting curbs buried under snow drifts can affect the alignment. Get everything back on track. Similarly, inspect tires routinely, as weather changes can affect tire pressure and strength.

· Use a soft snow brush or a foam brush to clear snow off of the car. Avoid hard plastic scrapers you might use on your windshield, as they can scratch painted surfaces.

• Try to park the vehicle in a garage or under a car port, each of which can protect cars and trucks from the often harsh elements of winter.



3. Drive a vehicle with stop/start technology.

Stop/start systems, in which engines shut off automatically when drivers brake and restart automatically when the driver lifts his or her foot off the brake pedal, can make more efficient use of fuel. Once exclusive to hybrid cars, stop/ start technology is now more widely available and can cut less money getting to and from their offices, and finding ways back on fuel consumption and vehicle emissions. That's especially attractive to eco-conscious commuters who live in big cities where stop-and-start traffic is unavoidable. What's more, many modern air conditioning compressors operate off Poorly maintained vehicles endure undue stress that can be electricity and not via a car's engine, meaning vehicles with

MEDINA STUDENT DONATES \$190 FOR NEW K-9


On Oct. 6, 2016, Aurora Owczarczak, 7, and a student at Oak Orchard Elementary in Medina visited the Sheriff

ALBION MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS DEDICATE HISTORIAL **MARKER TO HERBERT TAYLOR**

Family farmers who have suffered of at least 30 percent of their production due to the high winds may be eligible for FSA loans. Proceeds from crop insurance and any FSA programs are taken into account when determining eligibility for physical and production losses. Losses must be supported with documented records. Under the FSA Emergency Loan Programs farmers may be eligible for physical and production loss loans of up to 100 percent of their actual losses, or the operating loan amount needed to continue in business, or a maximum principal balance outstanding of \$500,000, whichever is less. Farmers must be unable to obtain credit from private commercial lenders. The interest rate on Emergency

· Trim the fat. Less is often more regarding résumés. List all of the pertinent information, then go over the résumé again and again and cut out any irrelevant information to remove clutter. Only include information that is relevant to your career goals.

· Highlight what you have done. Rather than listing every job responsibility and position in chronological order, use a résumé to highlight specific career accomplishments. This is a time to be your biggest fan and tell the world all of the great things you have accomplished. Remember to include evidence to back up the claims. According to a 2015 survey by CareerBuilder, employers say that résumés that include links to a candidate's portfolio, website or blog garner more attention than résumés without such links.

· Put your own voice in the résumé. Rather than using standard verbiage on your résumé, personalize what you want to say. Hiring managers want to hire a human, not a machine. When speaking about yourself, be sure to use strong action words that define your skills even further. HR professionals cite terms like "managed," "achieved" and "improved" as examples of positive, assertive words.

Apple Bobbing

Apple bobbing once was used as a way to weed out potential marriage suitors. Since then, it has become a fun Halloween party game primarily for children.

Apples are synonymous with autumn. Apples ripen as the cool days of fall begin to arrive, and come Halloween, apples are a part of spooky celebrations that can be used for treats and games and as part of seasonal decorating.

Apple bobbing is one autumn tradition that involves the use of apples. Despite the popularity of apple bobbing around Halloween, some historians believe the tradition of bobbing for apples is rooted in love and romance and has little to do with trick-or-treating. According to History.com, apple bobbing began as a courting ritual. While the rules of the game varied, the idea was to attempt to bite into the apple named for the young man the woman desired. This method of courting eventually became less popular, but bobbing for apples was resurrected in the early 20th century when Americans who traced their roots to Ireland and England began playing the game at Halloween parties.

Apple bobbing has also been linked to Samhain, the precursor to modern day Halloween. Celts believed apples could be used to determine if marriages would occur during a certain time of year. Young, unmarried people would attempt to bite into an apple floating in water or hanging from a string. The first to bite the apple would be the next to marry.

Although apple bobbing still occurs today, many eschew the tradition because of germs. The concept of sticking one's face into a communal bucket of water isn't appealing in a society that prioritizes sanitary behavior. Those who grew up bobbing for apples and want to continue the tradition in a more sanitary way can create individualized games. Instead of one large bucket, purchase smaller buckets and fill them with water. Place a couple of apples in each bucket and let participants race to see who can grab an apple first. Another variation is to tie apples from strings and suspend them from a clothesline or a horizontal beam, as the ancient Celts once did. Participants try to grab the apples using only their mouths. Some might be surprised to learn that bobbing for apples is rooted in ancient customs that may have had something to do with marriage. While few would pair matrimony with bobbing for apples today, this fun tradition can still be enjoyed by Halloween revelers.
