The sign was presented at the weekly KCMM meeting by Marcia Hall, Executive Director of PRCV, to Marie Schoenacker, current President of KCMM.

Also present, among other Kiwanis members, were Kiwanis officers Dave Harclerove, VP/Incoming President; Ron Muchard, Treasurer; Mike Williams, Secretary; and Roxann Roberts, Assistant Secretary. Roxann Roberts, (who hails from Perry) sponsored Cheri VanBuren, Center Director of the PRCV Mount Morris office, as a new member and she was installed to the Kiwanis Club by President Marie Schoenacker.

Cheri, who was a teen mother, is a native of Perry. She started work at the PRCV as a volunteer a few years ago. In October of 2016 Cheri was hired as Outreach Coordinator for the organization. In Mid-April Cheri became Center Director for the Mount Morris office and is currently holding both positions.

PRC of the Valleys' services range from pregnancy tests, limited ultra-sound, options consultations, and post-abortive support, as well as a range of pre-natal, parenting, life skills and men's classes. These classes are a part of our Earn While You Learn Program.

Clients earn points for each class they attend and then apply these points for material goods they may need to support their infants and family. Items range from diapers, clothing, to big ticket items such as cribs and car seats. Because PRC is a non-profit, all items are based on availability. PRCV relies on donations from individuals, churches and businesses. PRCV has volunteer opportunities for anyone who may have as little as 2 hours per week. We also have opportunities for those who can serve for special events, such as manning a booth at the Wyoming County and Hemlock Fairs, the Italian Festival, or one of our three major fundraisers. Material donations are also accepted. A tax receipt will be given for new or gently used clothing and safe baby products.

Material donations may be dropped off at their Mount Morris location at 83 Main Street, Mount Morris NY 14510. Any financial donations can be mailed to the administration office at 22 Liberty Street, Bath NY 14810.
