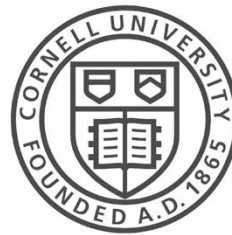

The Orleans County 4-H Fair Turns 70 This Year!

In 1946, our nation was focused on building the future. After enduring the Great Depression and World War II, Americans were ready to look forward. That year, the first general-purpose digital computer was introduced at the University of Pennsylvania, Tupperware came onto the market, the baby boom generation was born, and Orleans County hosted its first youth fair.

The first Orleans County Junior Fair was modest. It fit into four tents at Bullard Park in Albion. But the people of Orleans County ensured that this humble start was just the beginning. Each year, funds were raised, more people attended, and fair infrastructure improved. In 1965, the current location on Route 31 was purchased and the Trolley Building was constructed. More buildings followed along with enhanced facilities to create what we today know as the Orleans County 4-H Fair.

Through this growth, our fair has stayed true to tradition. It features youth and helps them develop the attributes essential to our community - caring, contribution, and character. While recent research has proven the positive impact county fairs have on kids, Orleans County residents have known this for the past 70 years. Making time for kids, helping them strive to achieve their goals, and modeling how to care about and contribute to others are the most important things we can do as parents and community members. Research has also shown that we learn more when we have fun, which means a lot of learning happens at the Orleans County 4-H Fair!

The America of 2016 looks much different than 1946. Computers and the Internet have changed how we live. However, they cannot replace the smile of a child, the taste of homemade pie, holding hands with a sweetheart at the top of the Ferris Wheel, or watching fireworks from a picnic blanket. No matter your age or situation in life, the Orleans County 4-H Fair offers a sense of belonging and community.

I have enjoyed my past two fairs as Director for Orleans County Cornell Cooperative Extension and am excited to welcome Deborah Roberts as Interim Director for the 2016 Orleans County 4-H Fair. This year, I will experience fair as a parent before embarking on a new chapter of life in Colorado. It is hard to imagine a summer without the Orleans County 4-H Fair, and I anticipate returning again. The fair "draws you in" and weaves together memories and friends that last a lifetime.

It is with great pleasure that, on behalf of the Orleans County Cornell Cooperative Extension Board of Directors and Fair Committee, I welcome you to join us for the 70th anniversary of the Orleans County 4-H Fair!

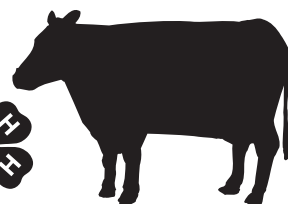
Where can you go to see a team of 6 to 10 people try to scale a greased telephone pole?

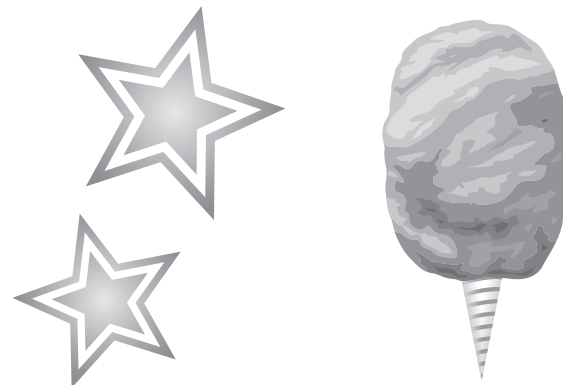
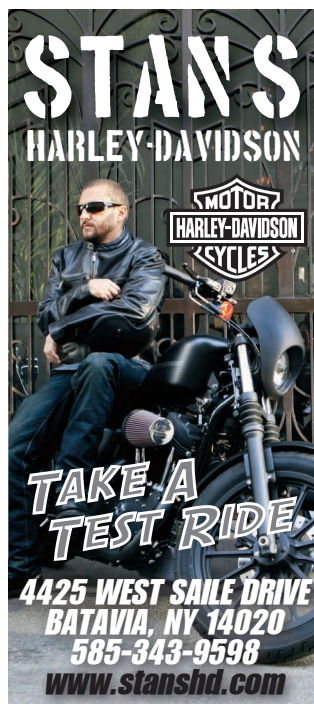
