Money Management Tips For Recent Grads



Millions of students graduate from colleges and universities each year. Upon earning their degrees, many students shift their financial focus from paying tuition to repaying their student loans.

Student Loan Hero, a loan consolidation and management company, says Americans owe nearly \$1.3 trillion in student loan debt. New grads may not be thinking about retirement, but the earlier adults begin saving for retirement, the more money they will have available to them when they do stop working. - Protect against identity theft. Grads should keep careful track of their money and spending so they will know if they have been victimized by a security breach. Many people, and especially young people, live much of their lives online, making them highly susceptible to identity theft if they are not careful. Grads should always be aware of money coming in and going out of their accounts while also making sure to never share sensitive information online.
- Pay off debt. Pay off high-interest debt first. Explore consolidation when repaying student loans and examine options regarding income-based repayment, which ties monthly payment amounts to income levels rather than total debt.

The future is just beginning for new graduates, and making smart financial choices is a large part of the years ahead.

A Message Of Awareness Through One's Grief

"My, grandson passed away just over three weeks ago at the age of 25. The grief our family feels is still overwhelming. He was one of the great joys of our lives.

I remember him in innocent times running, playing and wanting me to time him with my pocket watch as he ran. I remember him, his sister and his cousin crawling all over me giggling every moment. I remember the way he used to get so sleepy as a small child that he would fall asleep at the table face forward into his food.

He was so very full of love, laughter and boundless energy. As he grew into a young man he discovered a talent for drawing, and for a long time I thought he might set his goals in that direction. Something, however, got in the way. That something was drug addiction.

It began with pot and gradually worked its way the heroin. It became an illness which controlled far too much of his life. He settled for jobs that required a lot of manual labor and often put him with people facing the same illness as his own. He was a very hard worker and gave every job he held his all. There wasn't a lazy bone in his body. It was what he did after work that caused him problems.

During his moments of sobriety, and there were many often lasting significant amounts of time, he was a pleasure to be around. We loved to have him over for dinner and see the joy a good meal brought him. Sometimes, we would watch a movie together. The best part of anytime with him was the big hug he would give along with the words, "I love you." We miss those hugs and those words. I will forever be grateful that they were the last words we said to each other the very day he died just outside of Boston from an overdose of heroin laced with fentanyl. Last week on the evening news it was announced that such deaths are now the leading cause of death in our nation. It kills more people than heart disease, cancer, traffic accidents, and more. What wasn't reported were the countless families who have to deal with the immeasurable grief such tragedies bring. Our family is still struggling with that grief. We miss him more than words could ever express. I have no idea when our grief will begin to subside. I do know that I don't want any other family to have to face such a tragedy. I can only pray that my words might speak to one young person dealing with the illness of addiction and that he or she might seek the help that is needed to become free to live a long and fruitful life." - The Reverend Dr. Michael L. Physician Ambassadors

The Department of Veterans Affairs has a new program: the Physician Ambassador Program, which pairs volunteer medical personnel with VA medical centers and clinics. Since they will be volunteers, they'll be working for free. These won't be the nice ladies who bring around a cart of magazines. These will be licensed and trained physicians and clinicians for mental health, cardiac care, emergency medicine, primary care, urgent care, rural care and more. They'll work alongside the health teams in any of the 1,700 VA facilities.

And did I mention that they'll work for free? I have questions:

--Who is going to check their credentials?

--In the event of a dispute, who does the veteran patient turn to if the medical person in question isn't part of the VA?

--Who has the authority to hire/fire a volunteer? Each volunteer will have the credentials, but we know that doesn't actually mean anything when it comes to the level of care given. Since they'll be volunteers, will they answer to the Voluntary Services Office, the same department that provides the magazine cart lady?

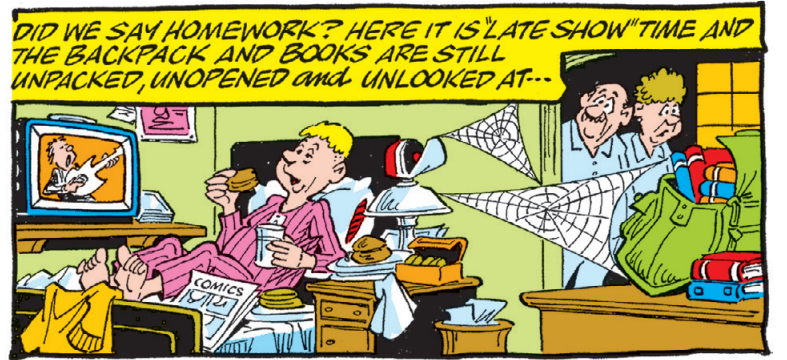
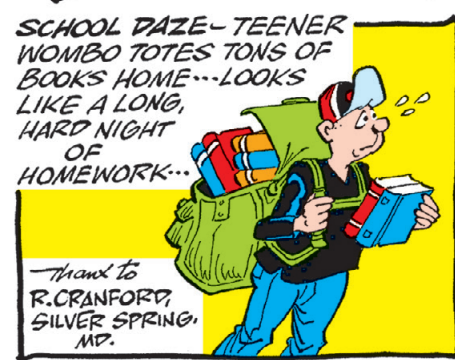
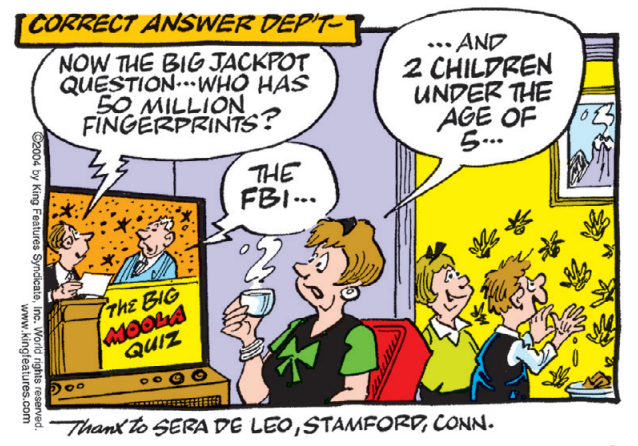
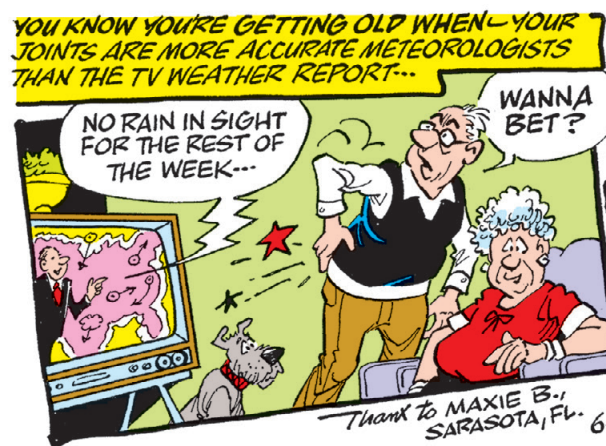

A Story Of A Quilt

On March 8th, 2017 Rachel Bowen laid out some things for her son to take to one of the Goodwill locations in Danville, VA. Not long after, she realized that something very special to her was in taken with that donation pile by mistake- her handmade Log Cabin quilt-started by her grandmother, and finished by friends, just for her.

Devastated, she reached out to the community by all means necessary-Facebook, flyers, news stories, and her story was shared statewide:

“\$500 REWARD!!!

Please help me, Facebook. I just realized that my son took this quilt to Goodwill by mistake on March 8. The top was made by my grandmother and It was finished and given to me by some of my best friends last year. The back is covered in a butterfly fabric and has my name embroidered, plus my mom’s, grandmother’s, and the friends who gave it to me. I am beyond devastated. I thought it was just in another room but went to get it tonight and that’s when I realized it was gone. It was folded on the end of my chaise and I had some things sitting there for Grant to take to Goodwill. I never dreamed he would pick it up too. I have cried nonstop since I realized it is gone. Please please share everyone. It was taken to the Goodwill on Westover drive in Danville, Va. but could’ve been sent to any of the goodwill stores. The square with the names could possibly have been removed. If anyone has seen it or if someone purchased it, please, I will buy it from you. It is beyond priceless to me, because both my mom and my grandmother are in Heaven now. Please Facebook help me with this. I am heartbroken.

At one point, her post had been shared over 28,000 times. Rachel stated in a Facebook post:

“I wish I could thank each and every one of you individually and give you all a hug. Even if I never get my quilt back, I will never, ever forget the kindness and compassion you guys have shown me. God is definitely at work here. Thank you all again, from the bottom of my heart. And please keep sharing and praying if you don’t mind. God bless you all.”

And she was right. God was at work, and a large community of people were helping to get the word out. Even with the extensive help for the community, the search for the quilt was not without disappointments. She would get a message of a possible sighting of the quilt, only to find that it wasn’t in fact hers. When something is donated to Goodwill, you never know at which location it will end up, so even with something as original as a handmade quilt, the search still seemed like looking for a needle in a haystack. In her next post about the quilt, Rachel stated that the employees of Goodwill had been working behind the scenes to try and locate the quilt-but the probability of it already being out and sold was very high, and requested that her friends just keep praying that the right person will see her plea.

And she did.

On April 12th, Rachel received a call from the Goodwill in Blackstone, VA.

“GOD IS SO GOOD!!!

The Goodwill in Blackstone called me a few hours ago, and this sweet, wonderful lady had come into their store to shop, saw my flyer, and immediately told the manager, “could you please call this lady, I think I have her quilt.” So, I am now on my way back from Victoria, Va. with my beloved quilt in my lap. I just can’t believe it God always has a plan. The awesome lady who had my quilt is in desperate need of a new car. She told me “I’ve spent \$500 on my car in the last month trying to keep it going.” It’s obvious to me that God orchestrated all of this. I am so very glad that I was able to help this woman, because she gave me something back that is worth way more than any amount of money. Thank each and every one of you from the bottom of my heart. For every share, comment, message, and call. This has shown me that there are so, so many wonderful people in this world. Most of the people who shared my post have never even met me. It is truly humbling. I am so undeserving of all the kindness everyone has shown me. Much love to everyone and God Bless You.”

And the story doesn’t end there. Rachel was so touched by Sandra Knight’s willingness to come forward, and wanted to return the kindness that had been shown to her. So she started a GoFundMe page in order to help with some of the financial burden her car troubles had caused. In May, Rachel presented Sandra with a \$4800 check, as well as a quilt to replace the one she had returned-made out of kindness by Margaret Shelton.

The video of the presentation spread around Facebook, and was certainly a tear jerker. Sandra kept exclaiming: “The Lord knew I needed this!”

Rachel’s family heirloom is now safely at home where it belongs, and Sandra has the means to replace her vehicle. What seemed to start out as a mistake, turned into an answered prayer.

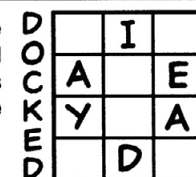

ROTISSERIE GYROS

- 1 medium onion, finely chopped or shredded
 - 2 pounds ground lamb
 - 1 tablespoon finely minced garlic
 - 2 tablespoons dried or ground poultry seasoning
 - 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
 - 2 teaspoons kosher salt
 - 2 teaspoons freshly ground black pepper
1. Process the onion in a food processor for 10 to 15 seconds and turn out into the center of a tea towel. Gather up the ends of the towel and squeeze until almost all of the juice is removed. Discard juice.
 2. Return onion to the food processor and add the lamb, garlic, poultry seasoning, Worcestershire sauce, salt and pepper, and process until it is a fine paste, approximately 1 minute. Stop the processor as needed to scrape down sides of bowl.
 3. To cook on a rotisserie, proceed as follows: Form the meat mixture into a loaf shape and place on top of 2 overlapping pieces of plastic wrap at least 18 inches long. Roll the mixture in the plastic wrap tightly, making sure to remove any air pockets. Once the meat is completely rolled in the wrap, twist the ends until the surface of the wrap is tight. Store in the refrigerator for at least 2 hours or up to overnight, to allow the mixture to firm up.
 4. Heat the grill to high. Place the meat onto the rotisserie skewer. Place a double-thick piece of aluminum foil folded into a tray directly under the meat to catch any drippings.
 5. Cook on high for 15 minutes. Decrease the heat to medium and continue to cook for another 20 to 30 minutes until the internal temperature of the meat reaches 165 F. Turn off the heat and allow to continue to spin for another 10 to 15 minutes or until the internal temperature reaches 175 degrees.
 6. Slice and serve on pita bread with tzatziki sauce (recipe follows), onions, diced tomatoes and feta cheese.

TZATZIKI SAUCE

- 16 ounces plain Greek yogurt
- 1 medium cucumber, peeled, seeded and finely chopped
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 4 cloves garlic, finely minced
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 teaspoons red wine vinegar
- 5 to 6 mint or basil leaves, finely minced

1. Place the yogurt in a tea towel or coffee filter. Gather up the edges, suspend over a bowl and drain for 2 hours in the refrigerator.
2. Place the chopped cucumber in a tea towel and squeeze to remove the liquid; discard liquid. In a medium mixing bowl, combine the drained yogurt, cucumber, salt and pepper, garlic, olive oil, vinegar and mint or basil.
3. Serve as a sauce for gyros. Store in the refrigerator in an airtight container for up to a week. Makes 1 1/2 cups.

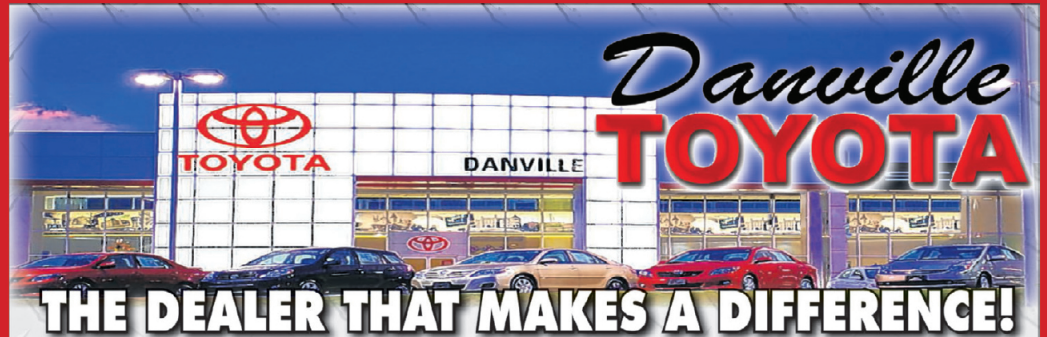

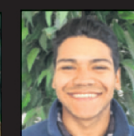
