I experienced a "Mountain of Love" at the God Bless America Jamboree this weekend at Reilly Springs, Texas. Organizers and audience alike were blessed for the talent onstage was as good as a Branson show. Dion Pride is a vibrant young man, well known in country music as a kind of 'tribute artist" of Charlie Pride, performing his dad's golden country hits while introducing his own original music to the fans. Dion is a high-energy performer who keeps the audience clapping in rhythm as well as laughing to his onstage antics with the band. Dion's live performances of this song definitely call for audience participation, with lots of drum beat rhythm perfect for the simple joy of clapping and and swaying. Then he develops the story, holding the notes an unbelievably long time and adding lots of coyote yips in the chorus.It really took me back to when I first remembered hearing the song! Dion got up close and personal with us, as he was wired to roam the auditorium and sing to individuals. He made Charley Pride's songs spring to life again for many of us there. He added a few of his own original works which speak of love and good will and hope. This second-generation performer is obviously a happy man, content with who he is and proud of where he comes from, taking the expected to an unexpected level and delighting us time after time! He worked wonderfully with the Jamboree's Sunshine Band, even getting Roger Reed worked into a jammin' session with him!








Another very talented performer who brought his own share of the audience was Larry V. Davis of Cumby as Mark Twain. After a 50 year career, he continues to share the wisdom and wit of the America's favorite storyteller. Mr. Davis got his start as a student of Boles Home when he performed as a singer on Boles fundraising tours. Starting at age 26, he began to portray Mark Twain professionally across the nation while also working as a writer and journalist. Davis commented that at one time he wore a white wig when costuming for Twain, but he has mow aged into a natural resemblance to photos of American humorist. You probably have favorite Mark Twain quotes but one of the perennial best is "Patriotism is supporting your country all the time, and your government when it deserves it".

### **BRENHAM'S ANT STREET INN**

The Ant Street Inn is a 15-room boutique hotel in a historic downtown building in Brenham. "It was built in 1899," says Suzy Hankins, who owns the hotel with her husband Keith. "It had retail stores downstairs and offices and warehouses upstairs. In 1990, the founder of the inn bought the building, renovated it and turned it into the Ant Street Inn."

Suzy and Keith refer to their property as a bed and breakfast. Guests have a complimentary breakfast in the downstairs restaurant. Free coffee and Bluebell ice cream are available upstairs. Many of the upstairs rooms have doors from the state capitol building, which were acquired during the capitol's updating in the 1980's. Among other amenities each room has a folding lawn chair that guests can take to outdoor events in

"Every Saturday night in July a different band will come and play on the square," says Keith. "They close off a downtown street and some guests come specifically to hear the band that might be playing that night." Suzy says some people come for the weekend and don't know about the concerts. "There's just not that many steps to sit on around the courthouse. Also with all the parades and festivals that happen in this area, guests seem to really appreciate those chairs."

The hotel is in the Ant Street Historic District. The lore is that early workers in the factory-type jobs in this area came and left together like a bunch of ants. Actually the hotel is on Commerce Street. Two blocks over is Baylor Street, which was once Ant Street.

Keith had been in the medical insurance business for 20 years. He and Suzy had always wanted to have their own business and six years ago they decided on the Ant Street Inn. "I was working in St. Louis at the time," says Keith. "When we were shopping for a property I had two criteria: it had to be in Texas and it had to support both of us. We didn't want to enter into a situation where one of us had to get a job to support the bed and breakfast. We looked at hundreds of properties and the Ant Street Inn fulfilled those requirements. A 4, 5 or if you're lucky a 7-room bed and breakfast wasn't going to generate the kind of revenue we knew we would need."

The Inn has a 4,000 square feet ballroom that is used for all kinds of events. "It can seat up to 250 people comfortably," says Suzy. "We do wedding receptions, banquets, anniversary parties, pretty much anything the mind can imagine. We can also move the walls around to accommodate small business meetings."

Since Brenham is between Austin and Houston, it gets travelers from those cities as well as visitors from other countries. "They're traveling from big city to big city," says Suzy, "and they stop in Brenham because they want an authentic Texas experience."

"The phrase we have coined is elegant sanctuary," says Keith.
