# **Medical Center Progress**

Despite recent rains construction crews are making progress at the site of the new North Alabama Medical Center just north of Singing River Bridge in Florence. Currently, there are about 145 workers on average at the site each week. The cooling towers arrived last week and concrete is being poured on all five floors.

Alabama. disabled under the rules. 3. Social Security recognizes by law through a set of rules or listings that recognize that some medical problems are so severe that a person who has those problems simply can not work. If you have one of those medical problems, you are considered disabled

and payment will begin. 4. Does the claimant have the functional capacity to return to any past work that they've learned to do in the 15 years prior to the claim? If they can, they are not disabled.

5. Social Security, through an Administrative Law Judge, must determine if the claimant is able to do any other work while taking into consideration that person's functional capacity, age, education and work experience. Social Security must demonstrate that those jobs actually exist in the national economy.

For example, during a hearing a vocational expert may testify that a person could go to work bagging groceries. A good attorney may be able to provide the judge with testimony that the claimant suffers from carpal tunnel syndrome or an arthritic condition of the hand(s). If the claimant is clumsy because of a medical problem, they aren't going to handle your eggs at the grocery store. That job would be out of consideration and both vocational expert and the judge would agree. But it's up to your attorney to bring the testimony of the claimant and the medical records supporting that testimony to their attention.

# Don't Overlook **These Items** When Making a Budget

Following a Budget is absolutely critical Managing Attorney to keeping your finances in check. But, if you keep going over each month, you need to ask yourself why? Here are several places that people spend throughout the year, but often do not realize it until too late. Make sure these items are in your budget on a monthly basis so you are not caught

overlooking them and allocating your money improperly. Subscriptions/Memberships: It's easy to remember monthly expenses like utilities, but things like magazine subscriptions or gym memberships that maybe paid on an annual basis should be divided by 12 and written down in your budget. Set aside that much each month to build

enough for when they are up for renewal. **Clothing:** Even if you are not a big shopper and don't buy clothes each month most people will buy some clothes at some point in the year, even if it's just a wardrobe refresh at the beginning of each season. So give yourself a certain amount each month or put a little aside each month towards your appual purchases towards your annual purchases.

**Property Taxes, Insurance, Quarterly Tax Payments:** Again, utilize the same divide by 12 if you pay annually (Property Taxes and some types of Insurance) or by 6 if it is bi-annual (other types of insurances) or by 4 if it is quarterly (Tax Payments for some business owners or retirees), but make sure it is in your monthly budget so you are not left borrowing from Peter to pay Paul and/or Uncle Sam.

Home Maintenance: A lot of home maintenance costs are unpredictable. The longer you own a home the more likely your HVAC or Vacuum or Washer or Dryer, etc. will break. Set aside an extra amount so you won't have to borrow money to repair or replace the item. Other home maintenance costs are predictable like cleaning supplies or light bulbs, but make sure an amount is allocated in your budget.

Travel: If you know you are going to travel to visit family for holidays or you know you will be taking an annual trip, allocate an amount each month and pay for it throughout the year. It will make your trip or family stay a lot more relaxing if you have it paid for on arrival instead of worrying about it when the credit card bill arrives once you get back.

Gifts/Special Occasions: Believe it or not but birthdays, Christmas and anniversaries will crop up every year, usually on the same date. Go figure. It is easy to budget for them collectively, so add up all your special occasions and divide them by 12. If it is your year to host instead of just getting to show up or if there is the possibility of someone close to you getting married make sure you add in a little extra instead of just factoring in the cost of presents.

Savings: I would be remiss if I left this one off, so be sure to include a line in your monthly budget for savings. You will thank me during your retirement years.

Fun Money: You need to treat yourself every now and then to keep your budget from feeling suffocating and to keep your sanity. A "treat" can be something as little as a magazine from the checkout aisle or book from the local used bookstore or a fancy latte from Starbucks, so allot yourself a certain amount of "fun money" each month that you can spend however you please, and you'll find it easier to stick to your budget in other categories.

**Eating Out/Entertainment:** Similarly, you should also allow yourself some money for things like eating out or seeing a movie with friends or family. When you budget for these things, you're able to splurge (within reason) without the guilt.

# **Medicare Minute** Medicare Part A & B Review

The past couple of weeks we have discussed Medicare Parts A & B in detail. These are the two parts of Medicare that are received through the federal government. This week let's review what we have discussed.

Although Medicare Part A and Part B are great programs that cover a lot of services there are some things Medicare does not cover. They include most dental care, eye exams related to prescribing glasses, dentures, acupuncture and hearing aids.

Medicare Part A is primarily used to cover your inpatient care. Part A has a \$1,316 deductible for each benefit period, meaning the deductible can be applied more than once in a calendar year. This deductible covers hospital services, including semi-private rooms, meals, general nursing, drugs as part of your inpatient treatment, and other hospital services and supplies. Part A is free to most Medicare beneficiaries.

In most cases Part B is used to cover your outpatient services. These include visits to your primary care physician and/or specialist. It also may cover transportation by ambulance, durable medical equipment, preventive services and mental health treatment. Part B also entitles you to an annual "Wellness" visit to a qualified provider. Most Médicare beneficiaries joining Medicare Part B for the first time in 2017 pay a monthly premium to Medicare of \$134. Part B has an annual deductible of \$183 and a coinsurance the beneficiary pays of 20%, after the deductible is met.

To cover the deductibles and coinsurance that Part A and Part B have you would need to look at some type of supplemental policy sold through private insurance companies. These include Medicare supplement plans or Medicare Advantage Plans. life a little more comfortable or a little less awkward? There are a number of "Friend" settings that you should be aware of that can dramatically improve your blood pressure while on Facebook.

When you befriend someone on Facebook, Facebook assumes you are actually friends with that person and will automatically show you everything they post. If that friend is not really a friend, but more of an acquaintance, you can label them as such. When you do so, Facebook will

### How Is Medicine Used To Treat **Panic Disorder?**

There are times when medication can also be helpful for this condition. Before I discuss medication therapy, I wanted to briefly review what panic disorder entails. Recalling from last weeks' article, for someone to have panic disorder they must first have experienced a panic attack. This involves anxiety with at least 4 of the accompanying of symptoms sweating, shakiness, palpitations, chest pain, shortness of breath, feeling out of body, nausea or abdominal pain, dizziness, fear of dying, fear of losing control, chills or hot flashes and the sensations of numbness and tingling. Unfortunately, these panic attacks cause a person to develop a fear of getting any future panic attacks and will often avoid situations that they feel may trigger an attack. Techniques such cognitive

behavioral therapy and mindfulness training, which can be taught by a psychologist or trained therapist can be very helpful in retraining the way your mind thinks in response to anxiety triggers. However, there are certainly cases where medication therapy can be a useful adjunct to improving panic disorder, especially in cases of more severe anxiety. There are a couple of different approaches to managing panic disorder with medication; sometimes severe panic disorder requires that both approaches be used. One approach is to use medication that helps to reduce the number of panic attacks and relieve daily generalized anxiety that can trigger panic attacks. The medicines we most commonly use for this belong to the family of medications called selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors (or SSRIs for short) which are also used to treat clinical depression. These medicines, which include, but are not limited to, fluoxetine, escitalopram, citalopram, paroxetine and sertraline are often used in higher doses than what would normally be required to control someone's depression. They are taken on

In last weeks' article, I a daily basis and usually require use before a positive effect require a trial of different SSRIs and dosages, but once the appropriate medication is found, a patient may notice vast improvement in their anxiety.

The other approach to treating panic disorder is to use medication on demand for situations in which a panic attack may be coming. These are medications that are used "as needed" instead of on a scheduled basis. The most common family of medications for this are the benzodiazepines. These are medications like lorazepam, clonazepam, diazepam and alprazolam. While these medications have the advantage of "as needed" usage, this particular family of medications has inherent disadvantages. First, they are controlled substances. As such, they all have the potential to become habit-forming. While all of the benzodiazepines have the potential for addiction, this is especially a problem with alprazolam (also known as Xanax), which has a shorter half-life in ones' system compared to the others. Second, these medications can cause side effects such as sedation, decreased breathing, slowed reaction time and balance disturbance. It is more likely to cause side effects in certain populations, such as the elderly, and may not be appropriate for many patients. Taking more of these medicines than prescribed or obtaining them through illegal means has resulted in many cases of overdose in this state. Therefore, consultation with your primary care provider is crucial in deciding an appropriate medication regimen to help you manage panic disorder.





# China Sees US Disorganized

Dear Sir:

Some of us may remember from our school days something called The Monroe Doctrine. It essentially informed the world that the Caribbean was our own backyard and that we did not appreciate foreign powers playing around in it. In the last few years, however, Russia has returned to the Caribbean basin, a region it had all but abandoned after the Cold War. Moscow is building a satellite-tracking station in Managua, considering reopening Soviet-era military bases in the region, expanding economic ties, and doling out aid in countries across Central America and the Caribbean.

China also has been building up its presence in the Caribbean. Chinese and companies the government have poured \$6 billion into the area since 2012, according to the American Enterprise Institute. In April U.S. Navy Admiral Kurt Tidd, head of Southern Command, told Congress he was concerned about China's exercise of soft power in the region as well as the growing involvement of Russia's military.

In a bygone era, such incursions might have drawn a quick, even hostile U.S. response. Today China sees a disorganized inward-looking and United States, and they see themselves as able to establish a long-term vision through gradually building influence. It is surely enticing for Russia to have this chance to establish itself as a regional power.

Perhaps Americans should look beyond our current divisions and consider what we would like the world to look like in twenty years.
