



THE ALPINE COWBOYS BASEBALL TEAM

Tumbleweed Smith



July 4th just wouldn't be the same without a baseball game. This year's holiday event in Alpine is between the Alpine Cowboys and the White Sands Pupfish from Alamogordo, New Mexico. It's being played in the historic Kokernot Field.

"Herbert Lee Kokernot was my great grandfather," says Kristin Cavness, General Manager of the Alpine Cowboys.

"He was a cattle rancher out here. He loved baseball and had a vision to build a baseball field. We're probably the smallest town in the United States that has an independent professional baseball team. We have a population of around six thousand." Kokernot Field was built in 1947 and cost a fortune. "I believe at least a million dollars. The lights cost 700,000 dollars."

Kokernot's 06 brand is on the outside wall of the stadium. "His father told him if you're going to put the 06 brand on anything you better do it right. So he decided to build this fabulous field. It was one of the early baseball venues to have lights. It was patterned after some major league baseball parks, including Wrigley Field in Chicago.

Players come from all over the country and earn an average of 65 dollars a week. "It's definitely not a money maker for these players. They just want to have an opportunity to get seen, build a resume and some stats so they can move up."

They stay with host families during the three-month season. "Host families get free season tickets to the games. These guys help out around the house. We have three players staying with us right now and it works out great."


The Cowboys play against teams in the Pecos league, which covers Texas, New Mexico, Arizona, California and Kansas. They travel to games in borrowed vans. "The opposing team pays for our hotels. When teams come here to Alpine we pay for their rooms."

Kristin expects the players to follow the rules of etiquette and decorum. "We want these boys who come here to leave as grown men with a sense of accomplishment and an appreciation of the town and its residents. At the beginning of the season they all stay at a Baptist camp nearby. They help clean up while they're getting familiar with each other and learning how to work together as a group and how to be a team player with the Cowboys. It's a very high honor to be a Cowboy."

Players take good care of their uniforms. "Each player has one set of uniforms because we can't afford to buy another set. We go through several bats and balls every season. Last year we used a hundred dozen baseballs and no telling how many bats. We couldn't operate with just out ticket sales. We depend heavily on our sponsors, concession sales and donations."

Although Kokernot Field is seventy years old, it certainly does not show its age. It was donated to the Alpine School District years ago and is used by all sorts of teams with players of all ages. It is an Alpine landmark that residents cherish.

Everywhere you are seeing the red, white and blue! Old Glory is gaily fluttering from flagpoles high up, strung horizontally across roadways, bracketed on homes and retail businesses, and displayed in apartment windows. I especially love the huge flags displayed by cities you pass on the Interstate...their movement is slow and mighty like waves on the ocean. You can get into the act, too! It may be a little bit of trouble to get your flag display ready, but it's worth it! See, there is a reward awaiting you, a grand feeling when you see your own Stars and Stripes lightly moving as breezes blow, showing off each star and stripe and announcing that here is the land of the free and the home of the brave! Display flags don't have to be expensive. A merchant in Sulphur Springs, Garry Hall of Northeast Texas Janitorial Supply, a USMC Veteran himself, proudly offers the 3x5 nylon flags at just \$7 each. That's affordable for just about anybody!

Our national anthem "The Star Spangled Banner" was originally a poem titled "Defense of Fort McHenry" by Francis Scott Key. It was later set to music then became our national anthem in 1931. The flag Key beheld boasted 15 stars and 15 stripes and was the garrison flag flying over Fort McHenry at the Battle of Baltimore during the War of 1812 (1812-1815) This fort was the defense of the city's harbor against the British. Fort commander Major George Armistead specified a flag large enough that British battleships would have no difficulty seeing it from a distance. The banner measured 30 feet by 42 feet, commissioned to a local flagmaker Mary Young Pickersgill who stitched it from a combination of cotton and English wool bunting. She

made each stripe over 2 feet wide and each star about 2 feet in diameter. The seamstress was assisted by female relatives and indentured servants. She was paid \$405.90. Since 2008, visitors can view the flag at the Smithsonian Museum in Washington D.C. in a special gallery called "The Star Spangled Banner:The Flag that Inspired the National Anthem".



Visitors to the D.C. area can travel about 40 miles to tour the Fort McHenry National Monument and Historic Shrine. Over it's 200 year history, the star-shaped coastal fort also served as a military prison in the Civil War, an enormous Army hospital during World War One, and as a Coast Guard base during World War Two. Today it enriches the capitol area as a center of recreation, tourism, living history and education. According to those who have been there, it is a visit that will inspire awe and pride in the heart of every American.





Closer to home, I hope you will take advantage of the Independence Concert coming to Celebration Plaza in downtown Sulphur Springs on Saturday, July 1, starting at 8pm. The world-class symphonic program will conclude in a huge fireworks display at dark. Everyone is invited and the cost is FREE! When in town, please notice the flags along sidewalks and streets, including in front of this publication's office at 115 Jefferson, in the shade of the courthouse, behind the red door.
