

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

This Tuesday some Americans will pause to remember those who fought for freedom and founded our nation in the 18th Century. After 241 years it is only natural that our national memories of what they did begin to fade. July 4, 1776 was the beginning of the United States and American freedom.

The people of that day were the first of a long line of patriots who have made great sacrifices in the cause of liberty for more than two centuries. Myths and legends often outlive the facts of history. Many people remember the cherry tree story about George Washington long after forgetting the history making events of his life. We misplace in memory details of Benjamin Franklin's statesmanship. But many remember his flying a kite! Joyce Kilmer was a World War One military hero but most of us remember only his poem about trees.

Many Americans cannot quote any part of the Declaration of Independence but the signers wrote that they pledged their lives, their fortunes and their sacred honor. And they all did pay that price! Many lost their homes, their property and their fortunes. One signer had to move 5 times in 5 months. As all did, they served without pay and died in poverty. The British burned the homes of the signers Kean, Elery, Clymer, Hall, Gwinnett Walton and Middleton. Lewis' wife was imprisoned in a cold cell where she died in Stockton and five others were tortured to death. Similar was the fate of our local pioneers, Lewis Livingston and Robert Morris.

It is important to remember next Tuesday these men and others, not only in the Revolution, but at the Alamo, Gettysburg, Normandy, Argonne Forest, the Pacific, Korea, and the Near East today. As the Bible says: "They paid the price, they suffered for it, but they had God's approval." On Independence Day let us remember all American veterans of all wars and cherish our freedom.

200 Year Anniversary Celebration



The Presbyterian Church in Leicester is celebrating 200 years as a Presbyterian Church in their community.

This church was founded in 1817, under the name of the Presbyterian Church of Moscow Society. The congregation met in the Female Academy, located on the village green in what was then Village of Moscow. The church building, which was erected in 1832, remains on its original location although additional property, bequeathed to the church, is now the location of Starr Park.


The park is leased to the York-Leicester Kiwanis Club who developed and maintain the park for the community.

The church name was changed to the Union Presbyterian Church of Leicester around 1917, at about the same time the village name was changed from Moscow to Leicester. The church became part of the Presbytery of the Alleghenies of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church on September 27, 2014, and soon afterwards, it re-incorporated as the Leicester Evangelical Presbyterian Church.

The church remains Presbyterian in how it is organized and governed. It is Reformed in its roots. This historical and theological heritage is often expressed in the *solas* of the Reformatio; God's grace alone is the only way to be reconciled to Him; our faith alone is the only means of receiving God's grace; Christ alone is the only ground of God's saving grace; Scripture alone is the only infallible authority for belief; and God's glory alone as the ultimate purpose for our lives...

Leicester EPF is Evangelical in that the good news of God's love needs to be shared (ideally in relationships) with those who are alienated from God. This salvation is found in no one else. As Jesus said, *"I am the Way, the Truth and the Life, no one comes to the Father but by Me."* (John 14.6). In addition, the church is **Mission Minded** in that God has a mission for us: the creation of a community of men, women, boys and girls saved through His Son Jesus Christ.
