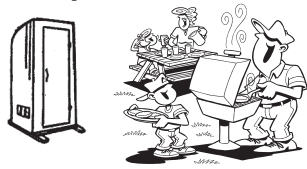

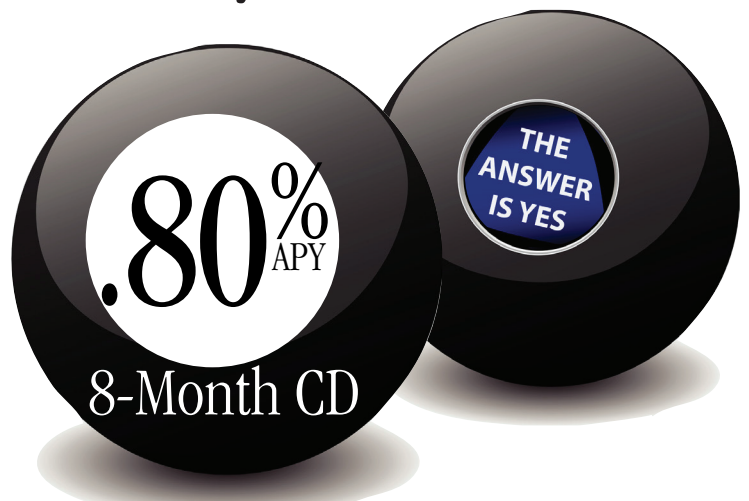

**Soldier's Transfer
May Strand Pets**

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My wife recently received orders to transfer to a new duty station in Germany. I'm excited to go with her, but the problem is that we can't take our two cats. I don't want to give them up to a shelter, and I've asked relatives nearby if they can take them, but they can't. What can I do? — *Proud Army Spouse in Maryland*

DEAR ARMY SPOUSE: Is there a health reason why you can't bring along the cats? From my research, pets are allowed to accompany military families to Germany when transferring to a new assignment, or what's known as a permanent change of station (PCS). The article "PCS and Your Pet" in military.com explains many of the details involved in moving to an overseas base with your pet.

If your cats are too sick or old to handle the trip, then you should look at finding them a new home. However, if they're healthy, several resources are available to help you plan and bring them along.

Get a certificate of health from your veterinarian as soon as possible to avoid any problems with bringing them to a new country.

Coordinate with the military offices that handle the details of PCS — you likely must contact several — to make travel arrangements for you, your wife and the cats. Find out if more documentation is needed for the cats. You may need to pay for the cats' transportation, and you'll have to buy airline-rated pet carriers.

Contact the agency helping you complete the move to Germany. Also contact the base veterinarian, who may have additional advice in helping you and your cats move smoothly overseas.

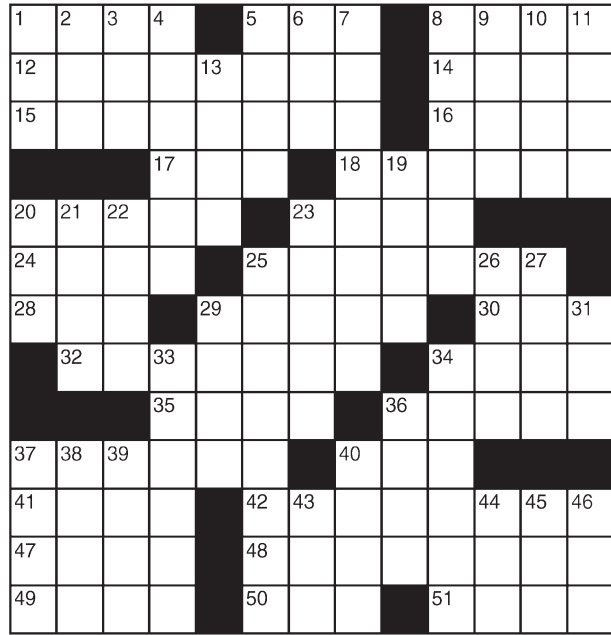

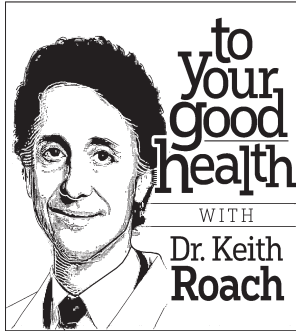

Treatment Not Fading Dark Patches on Face

DEAR DR. ROACH: A few years ago, despite regular use of sunscreen, I noticed a couple of small, dark patches on my face. I began using a product that contained 2 percent hydroquinone, which the package says is a "targeted skin lightener." The problem is, those dark patches haven't changed at all, except that they are a lot bigger. My questions are: Is this product really effective? Would my skin discoloration be even worse if I hadn't used it? Does the product perhaps make the problem worse? Finally, what is your recommendation for treating skin discolorations? — N.C.

ANSWER: Hydroquinone inhibits an enzyme necessary for making melanin, so if the darkening of the skin on your face is due to melanin (and most are), then hydroquinone ought to work. If it's not, it's possible that of the more than 50 conditions that can cause dark coloration of the skin listed in my textbook, you have one not due to melanin production.

It's also possible that the 2 percent strength of hydroquinone isn't strong enough for you. Concentrations over 2 percent (up to 4 percent) are available only by prescription. Also, sunlight can reverse the effect of hydroquinone, so you need to stay out of the sun. I'd recommend both sun-protective clothing (e.g., a hat) AND a sunscreen of level 35 or higher. Not only will sunlight reverse the lightening effect, but your skin is more sensitive to the harmful and potentially cancer-causing effects of the sun after using hydroquinone.

Hydroquinone can be very irritating

to some people. A rare complication is ochronosis, a blue-black discoloration of the skin. The safety of hydroquinone is argued: It has been banned in Europe, although ochronosis happens primarily in Africa, where large portions of the body often are treated and the purity of the product is, at best, questionable.

It's unlikely that hydroquinone has made the problem worse, but I can't answer if things would be worse if you hadn't used it. As far as my recommendation goes, think twice before lightening the skin at all, and consider other options, including covering makeup or laser surgery. If you decide to continue hydroquinone, I would first visit a dermatologist to diagnose the type of dark coloration, give you your personal options and then use prescription-grade hydroquinone, if appropriate.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I had tinnitus. I read a lot and found a research study at the Mayo Clinic that tests the effectiveness of magnesium 500 mg daily for moderate to severe tinnitus.

I took a 500-mg tablet of magnesium (over the counter) and got relief fairly rapidly from the tinnitus. I stayed on the magnesium for about a year. Occasionally, it returned, and I went back on that supplement. — Anon.

ANSWER: The results of the study you found are not yet available, but I think there has been enough published on the possible effectiveness and safety of magnesium supplementation that it is reasonable to give it a try. Magnesium deficiency is common, especially in people taking diuretics ("water pills") for high blood pressure. The major side effect of magnesium supplementation is diarrhea, which is unlikely at a low dose.

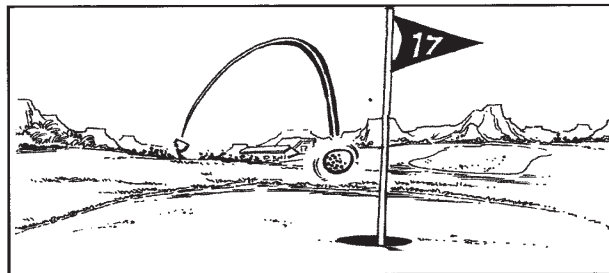

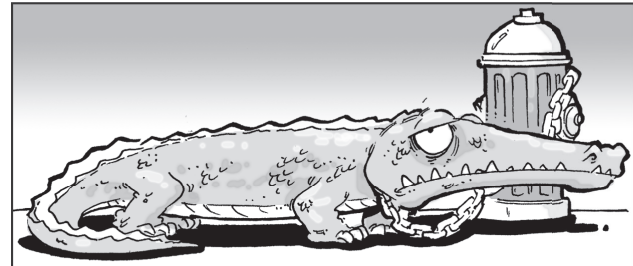

Safe Driving Pays: How One Teen Won \$5,000 For A Digital Short Against Distracted Driving

(NAPSA)—Americans are mobile-first, but when driving, your number one priority should be safety. While our phones are a source for information and entertainment, there is no reason for anyone to manually text while driving.



Safety is no accident: Never manually text and drive.

That's the message that 17-year-old high school senior Claire Offenberger conveyed in her digital short public service announcement that won the CTIA Wireless Foundation 2016 Drive Smart contest. Ms. Offenberger's national award winning video asked, "You wouldn't drive blindfolded, why text?"

In addition to winning the \$5,000 grand prize scholarship, Ms. Offenberger visited Washington, D.C. and was presented with the award by U.S. Secretary of Transportation (DOT) Anthony Foxx, CTIA Wireless Foundation President and CTIA President and CEO Meredith Attwell Baker, and National Highway Traffic Safety Administrator Mark Rosekind. She also met with U.S. Rep. Mimi Walters (R-CA).

In its second year, the Drive Smart contest provides educators with materials to help remind students (and adults) to not text while driving. With hundreds of students across the country developing creative anti-texting-while-driving ads, CTIA Wireless Foundation is helping educate Americans about the dangers of distracted driving.

Together with CTIA and its members, America's wireless companies support a three-sided approach to combat distracted driving—education, technology and legislation. Through industry-wide campaigns like Drive Smart and individual company initiatives, Americans know they should not text while driving. Technology developments from device manufacturers, wireless providers and apps and content providers include auto-replies to texts while driving and hands-free options. CTIA worked with the DOT, AAA, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, International Association of Chiefs of Police, National Conference of State Legislatures and other organizations by drafting model legis-

lation for states that bans manual texting while driving. CTIA continues to encourage states across the country to pass this important legislation.

While one should never text while driving, it's important to remember that wireless devices are fundamentally public safety tools so you can reach first responders and emergency personnel when needed. In fact, almost 300 wireless 911 calls are made every minute in the U.S.

Driver distractions come in many forms, from passengers to eating to music. To combat distracted driving, follow these six rules:

1. Never manually text and drive.
2. Know and obey state and local laws on wireless device usage wherever you may drive.
3. Learn your wireless device's and automobile's features, such as voice activation and hands-free options.
4. Let the person you are speaking with know you're driving; if necessary, suspend the call in heavy traffic or hazardous weather conditions.
5. Don't take notes or look up phone numbers while driving.
6. Don't engage in stressful or emotional conversations that might divert your attention from the road.

When you're behind the wheel, safety must be your number one priority. CTIA and its member companies remind you to never text while driving.

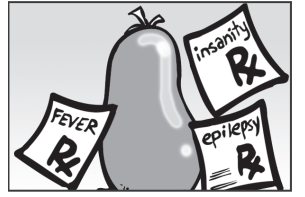

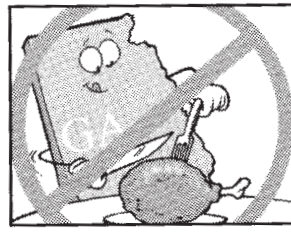

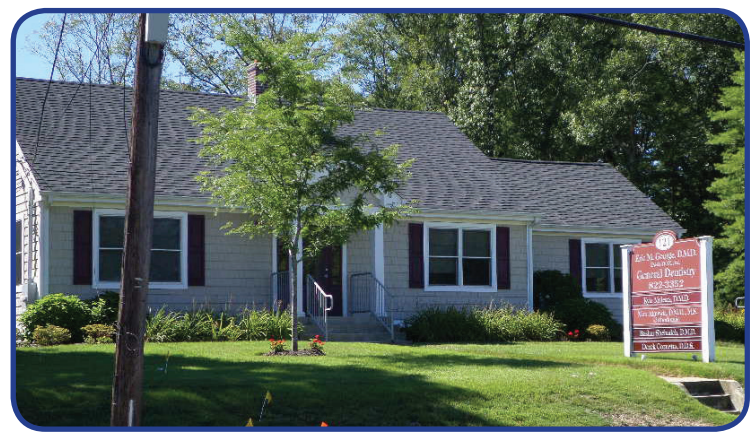

 - 4 racks pork baby back ribs (about 1 pound each)

The Kitchen Diva!

A Cool Way to Celebrate the Red, White and Blue

Independence Day will be celebrated a little differently this year at our house. Instead of thinking about recipes for meat, heat and firing up the grill, I've been reading about how this historic celebration was created and how I can incorporate a little "red, white and blue" into my menu.

Americans often celebrate on July 4th without knowing the fascinating history about how this special day came to be.

"No taxation without representation!" That was the battle cry of the 13 American colonies that were forced to pay taxes to England's King George III with no representation in Parliament. As dissatisfaction grew, British troops were sent in to quell any signs of rebellion, and repeated attempts by the colonists to resolve the crisis without war proved fruitless.

On June 11, 1776, the colonies' Second Continental Congress meeting in Philadelphia formed a committee to draft a document that would formally sever ties with Great Britain. The group included Thomas Jefferson, Benjamin Franklin and John Adams. Jefferson, who was considered the strongest and most eloquent writer, crafted the document. (Nevertheless, a total of 86 changes were made to his draft!) The Continental Congress officially adopted the final version on July 4.

Copies of the Declaration of Independence were distributed and, on July 6, The Pennsylvania Evening Post became the first newspaper to print the extraordinary document. On July 8, 1776, the first public readings of the Declaration were held in Philadelphia's Independence Square to the ringing of bells and band music.

The Declaration of Independence would go on to become our nation's most cherished symbol of liberty.

One year later, on July 4, 1777, Philadelphia marked Independence Day by adjourning Congress and celebrating with bonfires, bells and fireworks. The custom eventually spread to other cities and towns, where the day was marked with processions, oratory, picnics, contests, games, military displays and fireworks. Observations throughout the nation became even more common following the War of 1812 with Great Britain.

Congress established Independence Day as a holiday in 1870, and in 1938, Congress reaffirmed it as a holiday, but with full pay for federal employees. Today, communities across the nation mark this major midsummer holiday with parades, firework displays, picnics and the playing of the "The Star-Spangled Banner" and marches by John Philip Sousa. The most important part of this classic celebration is recognizing the blessing of being an American!

After the fireworks, cool off your hot Independence Day celebration with this deliciously patriotic dessert!

RED, WHITE AND BLUE ICE CREAM SHAKES

- 1 half-gallon vanilla ice cream
- 2-3 drops red food coloring

1. Soften ice cream to a soft serve/ yogurt texture by leaving it on the counter until it reaches the desired texture or by placing it in the microwave for 30 to 45 seconds. Evenly divide ice cream into three bowls.

2. Place red food coloring in one bowl and blue food coloring in the other, using a whisk beat each bowl until color is well-blended.

3. Layer bottom of glass with red ice cream, then plain vanilla and blue ice cream, using long spoon or knife drag it from the bottom to the top, stirring in between to mix the color (do not overmix). Top with whipped cream and pieces of Red, White and Blue Candy Bark.

RED, WHITE AND BLUE CANDY BARK

- 1 cup white candy melts, melted
- 1 cup blue candy melts, melted
- 1 cup red candy melts, melted
- 1/3 cup red, white and blue sprinkles
- 2 tablespoons edible gold stars (available at craft stores)
- 2 tablespoons blue edible glitter (available at craft stores)

1. On a baking sheet, add spoonfuls of melted white, blue and red candy melts, adding twice as many white spoonfuls as red and blue.
2. Using an offset spatula or knife, swirl colors together, creating a tie-dye effect. Top with sprinkles and edible gold stars and glitter.
3. Freeze 20 minutes and break into pieces and place it on top of the Red, White and Blue Ice Cream Shake.

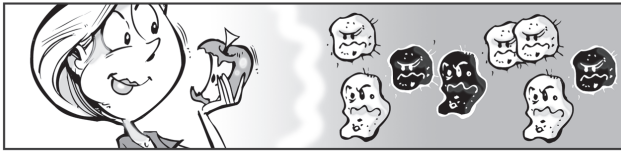

Hints For The Handy

Tips And Tools To Make Chores Easier

(NAPSA)—Whether your "to-do" list is getting you down or gearing you up for do-it-yourself fun, you want to be sure you have the right equipment to minimize the time, money and elbow grease you have to expend.

Polaroid Camera
Q. I have a Polaroid Speedliner Land Camera, Model 95A. It was originally purchased in the 1950s and is complete with leather case and all the accessories. I would like to know its value. — *Kathleen, New York*

A. Most Polaroid cameras have little or no value, due to the fact that film for them is impossible to find. According to several price guides I consulted, Polaroid cameras seem to be selling in the \$10 to \$20 range. As with most collectibles, there are always exceptions. For example, collectors generally focus on the 110 series, the 180 and 195. The SX-70 foldable cameras are selling for less than \$20 in my region. ***

Q. My cousin had a large collection of Mayfair Depression Glass. I have two questions: When and where was this set made? — *Wanda, Flagstaff, Arizona*

A. Many of the people I mention in this column are nationally and internationally known experts who receive piles of mail. Many have told me that they only answer letters that contain a self-addressed, stamped envelope. First of all, did you enclose a SASE? If so, be prepared to wait a reasonable time. What is reasonable? That depends on the expert. I once received an answer from an art appraiser almost a year after I had sent my original letter to him. Keep in mind, the advice you're requesting is free — except for your postage costs — so be patient.

A. The Mayfair pattern was manufactured by the Federal Glass Company in 1934. The plant was located in Columbus, Ohio. Incidentally, the set came in three colors: amber, crystal and green. ***

Q. We have a 1939 Philco console radio. It is in a walnut cabinet and is the 39-116 model. I have been offered \$600 for it. — *Ken, Kentucky*

A. Take the money and run. According to the Collector's Guide to Antique Radios by John Slusser (Collector Books, \$19.95), your radio is worth in the \$220 to \$250 range. ***



Power Rangers (PG-13) — Five outcast teens — played by Dacre Montgomery, Naomi Scott, RJ Cyler, Ludi Lin and the singer Becky G — find each other in a small-town high school. They stumble upon some magical coins and develop extraordinary powers. Afterward, their destiny is revealed, and the kids, now sort of superheros, train under the direction of the disembodied Zordon (voiced by Bryan Cranston), where they unite to defend against the extreme evil of Rita Repulsa (played delightfully by Elizabeth Banks). All the while, they are cracking one-liners in all directions. If you're a Mighty Morphin Power Ranger fan, you're familiar with the concept. The 2017 reboot doesn't take itself or the series nostalgia too seriously, and the end result is purely freshened-up fun. Go, go Power Rangers!

Autopsy of Jane Doe (R) — In a small town, an investigation into a brutal and perplexing murder uncovers a corpse half-buried in a basement — dead but apparently untouched by the carnage suffered by the other victims. "Jane Doe," as she is called, is brought to a father and son team of coroners, played by Brian Cox and Emile Hirsch. They begin to piece together the peculiar particulars of the hair-raising mystery — wounds, broken bones, damage inside that defies explanation. Each cut of the scalpel reveals paranormal evidence that becomes increasingly hard to ignore until they are trapped in a situation in which logic and perception are masterfully skewed. The film is smartly done, keeping you on the edge of your chair until the very, very end.

Palmer plays Clare, a young Australian photographer on holiday in Germany. She unexpectedly meets Andi, steaming-hot local, played by Max Riemelt. The attraction is immediate, and it leads to a passionate night together. Clare wakes up and Andi has gone, but after a bit of innocent snooping, she uncovers clues to a terrible realization: She's locked in and not going anywhere. We follow her inescapable journey in deep, stomach-turning terror. It's a suspenseful, cautionary tale on indulging in a one-night stand, and fans of psychological thrillers won't be disappointed.

Money (R) — Mark (Kellan Lutz) and Sean (Jesse Williams) are friends and co-workers who indulge in a little industrial espionage, netting them \$5 million from selling their company's secrets. After bringing home their loot and settling in for some celebration with their wives, a charming neighbor shows up and he's invited it (he brought wine!). The new guest (Jamie Bamber) draws a gun, takes everyone hostage and demands the money. So begins the violent game of cross, double-cross. The action is tight and slick, but the film feels like a gritty old-school crime caper.
