

ville, VA, where he began a solo practice in internal medicine and cardiology. In 1964 he was joined in the ciples of that "great era" of practice by Dr. Edwin Harvie, who remained a partner and dear colleague until he is remembered by so Dr. Gaddy's retirement in many in the Danville area. 1999. During that long career, he was a member of the American Society of Internal Medicine and served on the board of directors of the Virginia State Society of Internal Medicine. He was a fellow of the American College of Physicians and a member of the Virginia State Medical Society, the American Medical Association, and the American College of Cardiology. He also served as president of the Memorial Hospital Medical Staff of Danville and president of the Danville-Pittsvlvania County Medical Society.

He was a consummate physician. No interest in his life was older than his love for medicine. In the book he wrote in 1993, Triple Coronary Bypass: A Cardiologist Tells You about His and How to Prevent Yours-a book that combines a detailed account of his 1992 near-fatal heart attack with reflections on his life and career as a physician-he wrote: "I can't remember when I didn't want to become a doctor. I must have been in elementary school when I ordered from a magazine a copy of a book called The Modern Home Physician. I had answers to medical problems that other kids didn't know."

His original intention was to add a Ph.D. to his M.D. degree and then pursue a career in medical research and teaching. Luckily for the thousands of patients he farmer." But for him and would care for later, clinical his family, Westridge Farm medicine drew him away. was a very special place. an avid reader of the latest medical findings and himself contributed to the medical literature. He constantly tested himself by studying for board certification (even when not required), and he never missed an opportunity to teach others-whether other physicians or nurses or other personnel. But clinical medicine evoked a passion that exceeded that for the laboratory or classroom. His dedication to his patients was the hallmark of his career as a doctor. Long after anyone could count on a physician to do so, he continued to make house calls, driving late at night far into the counties surrounding Danville in all directions (often with one or more of his children in the back seat) to tend to patients who had no other access to care. He wrote, again in Triple Coronary Bypass: "The practice of medicine has had its long hours and stressful times for me. This was especially true in the days of my solo practice, my first twelve years of work in Danville." Still, he went on, making those house calls was satisfying: "Appreciation for my services was great. Sometimes the compensation was a bushel of apples just picked from the orchard, or a fresh tenderloin steak. In those days almost no one had medical insurance but no inquiry about compensation was made. For rural patients payment was often made when the season's crops were sold. I had no liability insurance and no thought of any form of litigation ever passed through my mind. It was a great era in which to practice medicine." Later, even when it was impossible to ignore the creeping legal and bureaucratic shackles

being placed on physicians, he continued for as long as he could to follow the prinmedical practice. It is for precisely that attitude that

He loved medicine, and one of the greatest sources of pride in his life was the fact that he had both a daughter and a granddaughter who chose to follow his footsteps to be trained as physicians at Wake Forest.

There is no doubt that some of that special fondness for his rural patients stemmed from his own background. Clifford Gaddy the physician was from birth a farm boy. He grew up on a modest farm that had belonged to his family since the time of the American Revolution. Everywhere one looked in the communities of South Carolina and North Carolina around his home, there were farms owned by Gaddys and Lupos. He reported that his special job on the farm from the earliest age was to feed the pigs and chickens and care for the ones that were sick. 

Exceptional attention was made to the details of each apartment, such as the trim work, cabinetry and sound proofing.

After the completion of the Hughes and Venable buildings, Barker will begin development at 518 Craghead St. This building was built in 1871 as Gibson's Dry Prizery and is Danville's oldest surviving tobacco prizery. Originally slated for demolition, Barker saw an opportunity to save this historic tobacco warehouse and acquired it in 2016.

"Three years ago, I described Craghead Street's 500 block historically as a brilliant smile, originally with 11 teeth (buildings). Over the years, several teeth were removed and the gleam gradually faded. Upon learning of 518's pending demolition, I realized that the smile, and the street's architectural integrity, would soon be changed forever," said Barker. "Then, a conversation evolved with the Office of Economic Development about restoring the smile. That is, saving the existing teeth and possibly replacing some that were removed, to eventually recreate the brilliance of the early twentieth century, here in the early twenty-first."

Plans to redevelop this building are underway and a first floor tenant has been secured. Barker will partner with DelGiorno to open Preservation Ale and Smokehouse in 2018. This brewpub will offer rotating taps of lagers, ales and specialty beers, with an emphasis on seasonality. The food menu will offer selections that combine traditional southern barbeque with a trendier, Korean-style twist. Barker added, "I was pleased with Steve's suggestion for the name of the new brewpub/BBQ concept, as 'Preservation Ale and Smokehouse.' Fitting, don't you think?"

DelGiorno added, "We are energized by the substantial investments being made in the River District and across Danville as a whole. We are truly excited to bring this concept to Danville and hope our contributions help enhance the region."

Corrie Teague Bobe, assistant director for the Office of Economic Development, said there is a sense of excitement about the development taking place along Craghead Street bubbling within our community.

"The 500 block is transforming before our very eyes," Bobe said. "Rick and his team are taking a vacant and blighted block and turning it into a lively, inviting place for residents and visitors. He has found great partners in Stephan Parry and Steve DelGiorno to help fill these beautiful buildings with unique and trendy businesses. From the creativity of these concepts to the quality of the design and construction, this block is becoming a showpiece in the River District. We thank all involved for their investment in our community." In addition to these projects, the City of Danville is making streetscape improvements along Craghead Street from Newton Street to The Crossing at the Dan. To meet the demands of commercial and residential development, the Industrial Development Authority of Danville is constructing a 96-space parking lot along the 500 block of Craghead Street.

"We always imagined that in this previously dingy block, we could apply a superior design standard that would attract others to create very special places and show Danville's River District at its finest," said Barker. "First, last year with BB&T's Scott & Stringfellow, and now with these various food concepts, I am excited to see the 500 block strategy realized. With our new partnerships with Steve Parry and Steve DelGiorno, along with the new parking lot and streetscape, the 500 block has established a momentum that will undoubtedly attract additional investment. The current projects will be locally tailored concepts, unique to the Dan River region and offer amenities not currently available in the River District. Reimagine that!"

Too Old for Back Surgery?

DEAR DR. ROACH: An MRI shows that I have spinal stenosis. I have not improved with chiropractic care, electrical stimulation, medication (including hydrocodone, tramadol and a pain patch), physical therapy or three spinal injections. After the third injection did not help, I told the surgeon I would need back surgery, but he said I am too old. I am 76. Am I too old? -- H.S.

ANSWER: Spinal stenosis is a back condition in which the spinal cord or nerve roots are compressed due to bony abnormalities. The pressure on the nerves can cause pain, loss of reflexes and numbness. Spinal stenosis is most common in the lower back, but it can happen in the neck and mid-back as well. It is seen more often in people over 60 and is the most prevalent reason for back surgery in people over 65.

The MRI usually shows the compression on the spinal cord or nerve roots; however, the decision for treatment is made based on the symptoms, not necessarily how the back looks by MRI. You have had the recommended nonsurgical treatments, including several medications, physical therapy and injections. Consideration of surgical treatment is reasonable.

When considering any therapy, the physician must consider the potential benefits and risks. The benefit of surgery is that it is more likely to relieve pain and improve function. There is a small risk of a serious bad outcome (death, worsening of pain or weakness). In general, the older a person is, the more risky the procedure. However, there is no absolute age cutoff of who can and can't get the surgery. The overall health of the person is more important than age. Younger people may be a bit more likely to see better improvements in walking after surgery.

Back surgery shouldn't be undertaken lightly at any age. Get a surgical opinion -- and probably a second opinion -- before making a decision. Only the surgeon, with access to your MRI results and having completed a careful history and exam, can make an informed recommendation about your personal situation.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Has the use of white powder, monatomic gold nutritional supplement been verified by the medical profession? Are the claims of mental clarity, long life span, disease cures, etc., accurate? -- D.S.C.

ANSWER: I thought I knew supplements pretty well, but hadn't heard of monatomic gold. Monatomic gold is supposed to be an "orbitally rearranged monoatomic element." In fact, these don't exist chemically, and anyone selling a product like this and claiming health benefits is deliberately scamming you or is confused. Metallic gold is inert and has no effect in the body, as opposed to gold salts, which are powerful and potentially dangerous medications, now seldom used for rheumatic diseases. Avoid "monatomic gold" supplements.







Bring a large pot of water to a boil. When boiling, add one tablespoon sugar and one tablespoon vinegar. Add the cobs of corn to the pot of water and bring to a rolling boil. Cover the pot, remove from the heat and let the corn sit for 10 minutes. Remove the corn from the pot. When the corn is cool, cut the kernels off the cob, cutting close to the cob.

Toss the kernels in a medium bowl with the red onions, tomatoes, vinegar, olive oil, salt, and pepper. Just before serving, toss in the fresh basil. Add additional salt and pepper to taste, if desired. Serve cold or at room temperature.

To julienne the fresh basil, stack 4-5 basil leaves on top of each other and roll them up to make a long


