school Ethan enjoys rocket building, wood work, & babysitting his little sister.

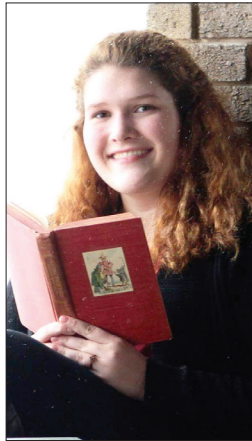
