NEW REALMS OF DISCOVERY

In the interest of ensuring that neither side in a lawsuit be subjected to a surprise, the process of "discovery" is undertaken before a trial. At this time, all relevant facts and documents relating to the case are shared by both sides, so that they may oppose each other on a "level playing field." Recently, the Supreme Court expanded the rules of discovery when it began to require companies and other entities involved in federal litigation to produce "electronically stored information" as part of the discovery process. According to the new federal rules, as of December 1, 2006, U.S. companies must keep track of all the e-mails, instant messages, and other electronic documents generated by their employees.



Carpet: Some materials in carpet emit volatile organic compounds, or VOCs, which are emitted as gases and can have both shortand long-term adverse health effects. The concentration of many VOCs is as much as 10 times higher indoors than outdoors. When purchasing new carpet, homeowners can choose low-VOC adhesives that do not contain formaldehyde. BUT HE IS SO CUTE AND ADORABLE!

I'll get right to the point; Bambi at Point Breeze did not come from Disney World! Maybe you have heard about the yearling buck that has been thrilling folks at Point



This button buck can be dangerous!

Breeze. He allows people to pet him, he takes treats from them, poses with folks for pictures and even walks out on the cement east pier to visit fishermen and see if they have any treats. He even has a video of himself on Facebook walking out on the pier with a foolish photographer walking next to him who is allowing his small kids to pet him.

Bambi is a year-old buck that someone illegally raised from a fawn either because he thought he had been abandoned by his mother and they thought they were "saving" him, or because they thought it was a neat thing to do. Most baby wild animals are cute and they can be easily "tamed" when they are small, however they all eventually revert back to being wild and this can happen suddenly and unexpectedly. In the case of Point Breeze Bambi, he seems pretty docile and neat now, but sooner or later something is going to set him off and someone could get seriously hurt. Right now he has just small velvet "buttons" on his head, but they will get longer and around September they turn into spikes that will be as hard as bone and sharply pointed. Those little spikes can then be dangerous if he jabs someone (intentionally or not), but the real danger comes from those pointed hooves. This year's fawn can even give you a terrific blow, but an adult could break an arm or leg or give a person a concussion. By fall his male hormones will kick in and then the real danger starts. Point Breeze Bambi is conditioned to people and has no fear of them so when this happens he becomes an extra-serious danger.

I have known several people over the years who have raised and imprinted fawns, and in both cases those folks got clobbered by them before they were a year old. I have handled wild two-week-old fawns, and I can tell you better be strong and know what you are doing!

However there is another serious side effect with this "tame" deer. Right now Lyme disease has become a serious problem on the east coast with Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Massachusetts and NEW YORK having almost 60 percent of the reported cases in 2015 and it has been increasing at a fast pace.

So what is Lyme disease? It is a bacteria that can be carried in the deer tick (a very small and hard tick to detect) and can be transferred to humans and pets through their bites. If this disease is not diagnosed and treated early the bacteria can spread and may go months or even years before developing problems with the nervous system, muscles, joints, heart, circulation and digestion. The classic sign is the reddish bullseye target where the tick attached to the skin, but this is not always the case. In fact, it can be hard to diagnose later when problems arise. The best bet is to see the doctor. For pets there is now a vaccine.

Now you don't have to pet or be near Point Breeze Bambi to pick up a deer tick. They can be fall from a deer and then wait on vegetation to ambush another

If you are a birder, hiker, bank fisherman, farmer, nature photographer, hunter, etc., you need to be aware of this problem and take prevention measures. If deer frequent your backyard in the evening there is a possibility there could be a problem with ticks. The best prevention is to use a tick repellent on your pants and blouse. Next it is a good idea to check your body out for possible ticks after your "adventure" in the outdoors. Not all deer ticks have the bacteria, but you can't tell, so why take the chance?

If you do get a tick attached on you it is important to remove him carefully without pulling off his head and leaving it in your skin which will still infect you. This can be done with a pair of tweezers by grabbing the tick just above the neck (not the body) and gently pulling. I have also heard that liquid soap on a cotton ball held on the tick and skin for 30 seconds will cause him to release. A visit with the tick (it can be tested for the bacteria) to the doctor would be advisable.

Another problem that could exist is rabies; it doesn't always show up as a crazy, foaming-mouth, jaw-snapping animal. It can exist in the babies from a mother who has it and it can also just make an animal docile and seeming harmless.

The sad thing about the Point Breeze Bambi situation is he will have to be removed. Whoever imprinted the deer did nothing to help him and will probably be eventually responsible for his death, because no matter where he is, he is no longer "wild" and is a danger to humans and himself.

Wild animals, tame or not, are wild and can turn nasty at a drop of a hat and people need to realize it is not Disney World out there.



Six Facts About Watermelon

Watermelons provide cooling, juicy refreshment during the warm days of summer. But while they're most associated with summer, watermelons can typically be found in grocery stores year-round. Watermelons are members TROLLS. Fri., July 28. Vets Park, of the cucurbitaceae family, which includes other gourds, such as pumpkin, squash and cucumber. Watermelons can be considered a fruit or a vegetable. In some areas of the world, watermelons considered a used primarily in snacks and desserts. In Russia, watermelon rind is pickled, while some Asian countries stir-fry or stew watermelons. To quench one's curiosity watermelons, following are six facts about this beloved food, courtesy of The Watermelon Board.

- 1. Washing watermelons before cutting into them will help prevent the transfer of any dirt or bacteria into the fleshy center.
- 2. An average 15- to 20-pound watermelon offers 90 6-ounce servings.
- 3. Watermelons grow warm climates and are harvested from Florida to Guatemala. Residents of the United States who want to enjoy domestically grown watermelons should look for them in June, July and August.
- Seedless watermelons contain small, white "seeds." These are actually seed coats that didn't fully form. Crossing watermelons that are a diploid plant (having two sets of chromosomes) with a tetraploid plant (having four sets of chromosomes) will form a fruit with a triploid seed three sets of chromosomes). It's the triploid that produces seedless watermelons.
- 5. Whole watermelons do not necessarily need to be refrigerated. But once cut, any remaining pieces should be refrigerated.
- 6. Watermelons are 92 percent water, and they're the perfect carrying case for beverages. Early explorers even used watermelons as canteens.



Pan-Fried Kidneys with Bacon and Mustard

Serves 4

3/4 ounce dried porcini 14 ounces lamb's or calf's kidneys

1 3/4 ounces smoked bacon 1 tablespoon chopped thyme or rosemary leaves

1 garlic clove 2 tablespoons butter 1 tablespoon olive oil

2 tablespoons brandy 4 tablespoons heavy cream

2 teaspoons good-quality whole grain mustard Sea salt and freshly ground black pepper

1 tablespoon coarsely chopped flatleaf parsley to garnish


Immerse the porcini in just enough hot water to cover them (too much water results in overcooking later) and set aside to soften. Halve the kidneys lengthwise, remove the thin membrane on the outside if necessary and cut out the white fatty core. Cut into 1/2-inch cubes and set aside. Dice the bacon or cut into strips. Chop the thyme and garlic and set aside.

Select a large skillet and heat up the oil and butter. When hot, add the kidneys, cooking one side until just brown, then turning to brown the other side. Season with salt and pepper and remove carefully with a slotted spoon, keeping the butter and oil in the pan. Add the bacon and cook briefly.

Squeeze out the porcini, reserving the soaking liquid, and add to the pan along with the garlic and thyme. Cook, stirring frequently, until the bacon is just lightly browned. Return the kidneys to the pan along with the reserved porcini liquid, discarding any sediment at the bottom of the bowl. Then add the brandy. Cook for a few minutes to reduce the liquid until it makes a thick sauce. Add the cream and mustard, bring to a boil, and when the sauce just coats the kidneys, remove from the heat.

Taste to check the seasoning and serve immediately with a scattering of the parsley, either on thin crispy toast with a small warm brioche, or with boiled rice.
