





Notes from the NUNDA VILLAGE BOARD

A Note from the Code Enforcement Officer

Section 304.3F of the 2015 International Property Maintenance Code adopted by the State of New York, states that buildings shall have an approved address numbers placed in a position to be plainly legible and visible from the street or road fronting the property. These numbers shall contrast with their background. Address numbers shall be Arabic numerals or alphabet letter numbers and shall be NOT LESS than four inches in height with a minimum stroke width of 0.5 inches.

Why is this important? In working with Livingston County in trying to update property identification and the mapping system, properties not being easily identifiable are creating a concern. This system is used by fire, EMS, and police departments for community health and safety well being. Please be sure your property is marked properly.
