Foxy Grandpa

Q. I have a bisque figure of "Foxy Grandpa," which has been in my family for more than a century. What can you tell me about this character? — Betty, Santa Fe, New Mexico

A. "Foxy Grandpa" was created by cartoonist C.E. Schultze. It was introduced in the New York Herald in 1900 and was an instant hit. The strip moved to the New York American in 1902 and eventually to the New York Press, where it remained until 1918. The cartoons triggered many products, including games, postcards, song sheets and bisque figurines. It even inspired a Broadway musical. Your figurine probably was issued in 1905 and is valued in the \$50 to \$200 range, depending on condition.

• I have a biscuit jar that an • appraiser identified as overshot glass. What is overshot glass? - Mary, Illinois

A • Overshot glass was developed • during the 19th century. Pieces generally appear to be frosted or iced, an effect made possible when a gather of molten glass is rolled over a marver covered with crushed glass. Early pieces that I've seen are clear, but examples in color also were made. A search on eBay found many overshot glass items, but no biscuit jars. For example, a number of overshot glass pitchers were listed in the \$40 to \$100 range, with a few much higher.

• My grandma collected thimbles throughout the 1940s and '50s. Her collection is unique, since all of her thimbles promoted various political candidates. Her thimbles include ones issued during the Harding, Coolidge, Hoover, Eisenhower and Nixon campaigns. Are they valuable? — Jon, Ohio

After the 19th Amendment expanded women's suffrage throughout the country, thimbles emerged as campaign tools directed toward the new voting constituents. Most of the political thimbles I've seen in shops sell in the \$10 to \$25 range.

• I have some 33-rpm LPs of • Dean Martin, Perry Como, Al Hirt and others from this era. Where can I sell them? — Jeane, New Mexico

A. Most LPs — such as the ones you mentioned — sell for about a dollar each, sometimes less, sometimes more, depending on rarity and condition.



VA Caregiver Program

The Department of Veterans Affairs caregiver program is back. That should be great news to people who were left in limbo after the VA pulled the plug on thousands of caregivers earlier this year while it considered how to revamp the program.

The Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers gives aid to eligible veterans who were severely injured on or after Sept. 11, 2001, and who need personal care for daily activities, such as bathing and dressing, or who need supervision or protection because of impairment. Care must be required for a minimum six months; tasks such as lifting, transportation and emotional support are not included. The stipend paid to the caregiver is based on how many hours of help per month the veteran needs, as determined by the tier level (high, medium or low) after a clinical evaluation.

Often it's a primary family member who is the caregiver. To meet the requirements, they need to be

the spouse, child or parent and live with the veteran. Another level, secondary family caregiver, has slightly different requirements and duties. These often serve as backup support. Both must fill out an application, VA Form 10-10CG. All caregivers have support coordinators to help them in giving the best care they can, accessing benefits and services, and learning more about assistance that's available.

For more information, go online to the redesigned caregiver website: www.caregiver.va.gov. You'll find links to determine eligibility and specifics about how the program works, as well as the application to download. Put your ZIP code in to find local caregiver advocates, or call the caregiver support line at 1-855-260-3274. If you ever need to file an appeal, contact the caregiver support coordinator or the patient advocate at the closest VA medical center.



He was born on September 6, 1930, in Coolwell, VA, to the late Benjamin Fred Dalton and Annie Earl Dalton.



She worked many hours, organizing raffles, bake sales, yard sales, etc. This fundraiser raised \$2500 to help my daughter with her medical expenses.

Even through all the stressful events she has faced and is still facing, Joan praises God daily. My prayer is that you will financially help Joan at this time.

Picture Calendar for Preschoolers

"When do we go to the zoo?" "When is Nate's birthday party?" "When, when, when" is the repetitive question of kids of all ages, but as a parent of preschoolers, it's especially challenging to answer the "when" questions if eager kids don't yet read, write or comprehend the days of the week.

That was a parenting challenge for neonatologist and mom of two, Dr. Anna Hedstrom. So, she recruited her mother-inlaw, retired fourth-grade teacher Judy Hedstrom, to help her and her husband develop a hands-on strategy for their 3-yearold son, Parker, to understand what's up on their weekly schedule.

To create an event calendar, Judy organized family photos of familiar faces

in Parker's life, and found images of day-to-day routines and outings from free online photos. She used them to make easy-to-handle, Velcro-backed activity cards Parker could attach to color-coded days of the week.

It works! "The Parker's Week calendar gets him involved in a playful way to understand when activities will take place," say the parents. On Sundays, they talk about the coming week as he attaches cards representing routine events like school, as well as special activities such as going to the zoo. Now, six months later, he has figured out how to do the "regulars" himself.

Enjoy making one adapted to your family lifestyle with your preschooler.

Here's the stuff you need:

- -1 22-by-28-inch poster board cut in half widthwise
- -cardstock sheets in different colors
- -copied photos and images of people

-magnets or art hooks for hanging Here's the fun:

1. For the header section of the activity calendar, print a title such as "EMI-LY'S WEEK" on a 12-by-4-inch strip of cardstock. Add a photo of the child next to it, and glue in place on the poster board.

2. On the short end of seven 3-by-11inch tall colored strips of cardstock, print the days of the week. Line up strips vertically in a row, and glue under the title strip.

3. Cut 3-by-3-inch cards for representing routine activities and special events. Print photos and images of outings and glue to cards. Label each activity. For example: School, Library. Soccer, Haircut, Doctor visit, Birthday party, Dad off work, Surprise!



4. Laminate cards and entire calendar at a copy store (optional, but recommended).

5. Attach one half of Velcro pieces in a vertical line under days of the week, and attach the matching pieces on the backs of cards. Hang the calendar with magnets or art hooks at child's height. Store cards not in use in a box or file near the calendar.





Tracking Osteoporosis Through Testing

DEAR DR. ROACH: I have mild osteoporosis in one area. I was on Fosamax for seven years. I have been off for two years. My doctor is suggesting I go back on Fosamax. Your thoughts on treatment in my case? -- A.B.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I have been advised that Medicare will cover the bone density test only every two years. If that's true, why? -- A.L.

ANSWER: Osteoporosis is loss of bone minerals and strength. There are at least two ways to measure changes in bones, whether as an age-related drop in bone density and strength or as an increase in response to treatment. One way is to measure the bone density via an X-ray (DEXA). The other is a urine test, N-telopeptide of collagen (abbreviated NTX), which looks at net bone loss.

DEXA correlates well to fracture risk, but it changes very slowly. In fact, it changes so slowly that a repeat test within two years usually reflects variability in the test itself rather than an actual change in the bone, which is why most insurance companies -- and, yes, Medicare -- will cover the test only every two years. Some experts believe that measuring NTX is a useful way of measuring the effectiveness of treatment, such as with a medication like Fosamax. Further, although the optimum duration of treatment for osteoporosis isn't clear, five years is commonly used (as it sounds like is the case for A.B.).

NTX can guide whether restarting treatment is necessary. There just isn't enough information to make this a general recommendation, although the theory makes sense to me. If I were treating someone in A.B.'s situation, I would restart treatment if the NTX level showed high bone resorption.

READERS: Nearly every woman, if she lives long enough, must come to grips with osteoporosis. DEAR DR. ROACH: What are your thoughts about the MiraDRY procedure to get rid of underarm sweat? Is it safe not to have sweat under the arms? -- S.J. ANSWER: MiraDRY is the brand name of a microwave device designed to treat hyperhidrosis (excessive sweating). This is a condition of abnormal, drenching sweat that greatly interferes with social activities, not normal underarm sweating. It is currently used only for underarms -- not hands, feet or face, the other most common places for localized hyperhidrosis. According to several published papers, the microwaves heat up the water in the sweat glands, destroying them, while the skin itself is cooled. The published success rates (at reducing sweating to "never noticeable" or "tolerable") are very high, as are patient satisfaction results. Side effects included swelling, redness and temporary numbness.


HOLLYWOOD by Tony Rizzo

HOLLYWOOD — We told you that Daniel Craig, who said, "I'd rather slash my wrists than do another Bond film," was sure to sign for the next Bond movie, tentatively titled "Bond 25." 





In a large saucepan, gently heat the milk until hot but not bubbling. Whisk in the sugar mixture in three batches, then whisk in the egg yolks. Cook over moderate heat, stirring frequently, until the custard is thickened and pudding-like, 5 to 8 minutes. Whisk in the butter and vanilla. Pour the hot custard over the wafers and let stand at room temperature for 20 minutes.

Step 3 make the meringue

In the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with the whisk, combine the egg whites, vanilla and cream of tartar. Beat at high speed until soft peaks form, 1 to 2 minutes. With the machine on, add the sugar 1 tablespoon at a time; beat until smooth, glossy, justfirm peaks form, about 2 minutes. (Do not overbeat or the meringue will become grainy.) Spread the meringue evenly over the banana pudding, swirling it decoratively. If you have a kitchen torch, you can brûlée the meringue if desired, or bake it in the oven until brown.

Welcome Back to School

How to help children make new friends

Students learn lessons each day. While many of these lessons pertain to their coursework, kids pick up much more than book smarts from school, where kids first learn to cultivate friendships and build lasting relationships.

In addition to a new curriculum, new teachers and new schedules, kids also might make new friends once a school year begins. While some familiar faces carry through from grade to grade, chances are youngsters will meet new students who will soon become good friends. While many kids find it easy to make new friends, others might need some assistance so they can make the most of opportunities to socialize and form friendships that might last a lifetime.

* Offer opportunities for socialization. Children should be given the opportunity to explore friendships outside of the classroom where peer pressure might not be so prevalent. Establish a carpool or invite a classmate over for a play date. Unstructured time to play or get to know each other is a great way to establish friendships. Invite new children over each time to see which friendships are the strongest, but make sure you are not pushing a friendship on your child.

* Discover common interests. One of the quickest ways to build friendships is through common interests, says Kirk Martin, a behavioral therapist and author. Encourage your child to join a club or sports group where he or she can meet other kids with similar interests. Sometimes finding reasons to talk other children is the most difficult step to making new friends. Sharing a common interest removes this barrier.

* Teach proper manners. Children who are polite, well-mannered and know how to follow direction are better equipped to attract friends. Children who misbehave may be shunned by other kids and their parents who do not want the hassle of an unruly youngster coming over to play. Respectful children who are honest, trustworthy and capable



of sustaining eye contact and making small talk may find it easy to make friends.

* Take the friendship lead. As parents, you can improve your child's chances of making friends by getting friendly with their classmates' parents. You do not have to become bosom buddies with everyone, but making connections with fellow parents can reinforce the value of friendship to your children. Socializing as families also presents other opportunities to get together and solidify relationships.

* Boost confidence levels. As a parent you can talk to your children about their strengths and positive attributes. Emphasizing kids' best traits will increase their self-esteem, and that sense of self-worth can make it easier for them to make friends. A child who is shy and insecure may retreat when meeting new people, but a child who can proudly stand behind his or her accomplishments may attract friends easily.

School is about more than just hitting the books. It's also a prime opportunity for kids to develop their personal skills and make new friends.



7 ways to make mornings less hectic

• Have quick breakfast foods available. Smoothies, cereal bars, oatmeal, and whole-grain cereals are fast and nutritious ways to start the day.

• Carpool whenever possible. Busy families can save themselves extra work by proposing a neighborhood carpool. Sharing school dropoff detail frees time up for parents once or twice a week, and kids may enjoy traveling to school with their friends. Mornings can be tricky when family members are getting ready for school and work at the same time. By practicing a few daily rituals, it's possible to curb the rush and start the day happier and more relaxed.


