





NYS STATE TROOPER HARMON VISITS BOCES TO TALK CAREERS WITH AT-RISK YOUTH

State York Trooper Corey Harmon recently spent some time with students who were participating in the Liberty Partnership Program. The program focuses on at-risk students and encourages them to stay in school and explore careers. Over the course of a week, the students spent some time at Orleans/Niagara BOCES' Orleans Career and

Technical Education Center learning about some of the career and technical ed courses offered there. Security and Law Enforcement teacher Steve Browning asked Trooper Harmon if he would talk to his class about what it takes to become a trooper and his experiences in that career. Trooper Harmon showed the students a video about the NYS Police Academy, where recruits learn the basics in law enforcement. He talked about the requirements to become a trooper and the evaluations and background checks that recruits go through. He stressed to them the importance of having a clean history and how anything you have done in the past can come back to haunt you in the interview. "I had a very clean history, but I made a joke in my yearbook write-up that I didn't like troopers and they grilled me on that. Why would I want to become a trooper if I didn't like them? While there was a perfectly acceptable explanation for the comment, I still had to explain my reasoning for making such a statement six years prior." Just keep it in the back of your mind anything you say on social media or elsewhere can be discovered and be brought up in an interview."

Trooper Harmon said the Academy is very important because it gets all the recruits on the same page when they receive the same kind of training. "You basically get two years of college in six months." He talked about being pepper sprayed and tazered as part of the training and showed video of the recruits going through that process. "The 19 years I have been on the force I have never pepper sprayed anyone, but I have been pepper sprayed three times for training purposes. You have to know what it does to the senses and how people will react to it. It is painful and you will have trouble breathing, so you don't want to freeze if it happens to you. The effects last 45 minutes and when you shower it reactivates it. It is not

He also talked to the students about the history of the NYS Troopers. "We are celebrating our 100year anniversary this year. The Troopers were started in 1917 after a murder that occurred in 1913 went unsolved. Two women were so outraged at the escape of the killers they petitioned the Governor to establish a police force to protect the rural areas of New York State. The New York State Legislature passed a bill to create the New York State Police. "

He also talked about how their gray uniforms are made out of equal parts of white thread and black thread to symbolize neutrality and went over other parts of their uniform and what they represent. He also explained that they don't wear badges on their uniform because when they used to ride horses it would get caught on the horses' tack and rip their uniforms. "They got tired of having to repair the uniforms, so we carry them in our pocket along with a card that states the Troopers' vision, mission and core values."

He also had students try on goggles that mimic the effects of alcohol on a person and warned of the dangers of driving while impaired. He concluded the visit with a tour of his patrol car and answering the students' questions about his job. "I just want them to know that there are good people in law enforcement who want to help people. It's the reason we got into this. We wholeheartedly want to do the right thing."

Today we have many people who just love wildlife and want to save it all and I'm afraid this way of thinking is being spread to our youth which down the road will influence the way our wildlife is managed or should I say mismanaged.

In fact, it is happening right now. "We must not harm the beautiful mute swans, trapping is cruel and is no longer needed as we have superior manmade fabrics for clothing now and hunting is barbaric and cruel." Many of the "new nature enthusiasts" want to save everything and can't understand why anyone would want to harm or destroy wildlife, but the truth of the matter is we need to "thin the herd" for its own welfare. You can only put so many people in a house before it become overcrowded, which leads to conflicts, plugged toilets, diseases and eventually destruction. It is the same with wildlife.

Recently I read a blog of a nature photographer where she condemned the hunting of Canada geese and oiling of their eggs to control the exploding population. She had been overwhelmed by her recent photographing of baby geese and how cute they were and felt oiling the eggs to kill the young before they hatched was uncalled for as is the hunting of geese. She didn't know they live a very long and productive life even without hunting or oiling of eggs. So where are we headed with all this influence from emotional and ill-informed knowledge about wildlife management? I'm afraid nature and the environment will end up paying the ultimate price and all those who wanted to save it will wonder what happened.





Engagement Photo Tips

- Find a photographer who fits your style. If you're a quirky couple, go with a quirky photographer. If you're reserved and a follow-the-book type of couple, then select a more traditional photographer. Some photographers out there forget that this is your moment and want to impart their idea of what you want. Make sure he or she takes your ideas into consideration.
 - Select one who is open to different shoot locations and brainstorming. Some of the best photos occur in natural settings, where things aren't entirely planned. If a photographer simply works out of a studio, you may want to select one who has more free reign with different locales.
 - Choose your location wisely. Certain locations will stand out in your minds because they are visually stunning or are special places where you have spent moments as a couple. Swabian **Stuffed Pasta**

Serves 4 to 6

- 1 to 2 leeks
- 7 1/2 ounces dry cured salami
- 1 bunch flat-leaf parsley 1 pound, 2 ounces uncooked
- sausage meat 1 pound, 2 ounces mixed
- ground meat (such as veal and beef)
- 2 large eggs Salt to taste
 - Pinch of black pepper
- 2.2 pounds fresh or frozen large pasta sheets, such as extra-large lasagna sheets

To make the filling, wash and trim the leek and slice it finely. Finely dice the salami. Wash the parsley and chop it finely. Put the uncooked sausage meat and mixed ground meat in a large bowl. Add the leek, parsley, smoked salami, and eggs and knead the mixture I thoroughly. Cook a bit of the mixture in a small frying pan to taste for seasoning. Season to taste with salt and pepper.

Separate the sheets of pasta and lay them out on parchment paper. If needed, the cut the sheets so the sheets are square and about 20 x 28 inches in size, or as large as possible. Using a spatula, evenly spread a generous 1/3-inch of filling on each sheet. Next, just as I though you were folding a piece of paper, starting at the narrowest edge of the pasta sheet, fold it over carefully to create a strip 23/4 inches wide. Fold this strip over about two more times until all the pasta dough and its filling is folded together flat. This flat method of folding pasta sheets is characteristic of traditional maultaschen -Swabian stuffed pasta is not

Using a cup, press down very firmly on the filled dough approximately every 4 inches. Then, using a knife, cut squares about 3 x 4 inches in size around the rings you have made. Firmly pinch the cut edges together with your fingers. Repeat until you have used up all the pasta sheets and filling. Bring a large pot of salted water to a rolling boil. Gently place the meat-filled pouches in the water and cook them for 10 to 15 minutes. When they are done, remove them with a slotted spoon and keep them

Tip: Serve Swabian stuffed pasta in a beef broth. You can also serve them as a main course, warmed in melted butter and topped with pan-fried onions along with potato salad and a green
