Hromatko Selected to Attend Olympic Training Camp

Kailie Hromatko, a former Okoboji graduate and Lakes Area Youth Trap Club shooter attending Grand View University has been selected to attend the ACUI USA Shooting B.J. McDaniel Olympic Training Camp at the certified Olympic training center in Tillar, Arkansas, August 16 - 19. Kailie competed in the ACUI Collegiate Clay Target Championships in San Antonio, TX this spring with her Shooting Sports Team from Grand View and shot an impressive 96 out of 100 clay targets in the American Trap discipline for women placing her 13th in the national women's open division. Her score qualified her to apply for this prestigious camp that only a limited number of shooters are accepted to attend and a few months after received her official invite. Shooters attending the camp will train and be directed by former Olympic medalist Dan Carlisle and four-time national champion Marc Weeks. Kailie had an impressive first season with the Grand View Shooting Sports team earning four 1st place individual finishes, a 9th place individual finish at the Upper Midwest Conference Championships, 7th place individual finish at the ACUI Eastern Super Shoot, an undefeated season for Grand View Shooting Sports and her team taking National Runner Up at the ACUI Collegiate Target Championships in American Trap. She was also the recipient of the Higgins Branchini Foundation Scholarship which provides funds and allows her to continue her shooting career in the off season.

Come to this one time chance to meet and listen to experiences from our own American Hero.

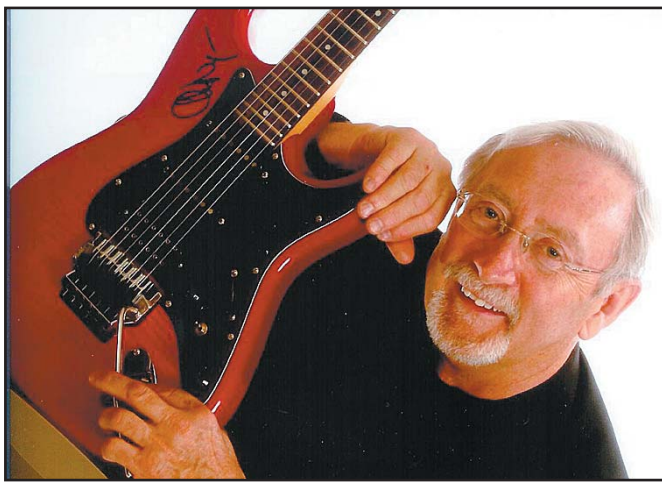


U of O Budweiser Men's Slow Pitch Softball Tournament

Spencer Hospital Nurse Named 'Hospital Hero'

The Iowa Hospital Association (IHA) has named Spencer Hospital nurse Margaret Molitor as a recipient of the 2017 Hospital Hero awards. As such, Molitor will be honored during IHA's annual meeting in October.

"Margaret is a hero - someone we all look up to admire - in how she lives her life. Each day that Margaret works, she strives to make that day special in some manner for her patients and often her co-workers too," expressed Brenda Tiefenthaler, vice president of patient care and informatics at Spencer Hospital.

More than 70,000 Iowans work at hospitals across the state, committed to helping patients and their families and to promote community wellness. Each year, approximately 10 people are selected from a pool of nominees to be recognized as Hospital Heroes. Tiefenthaler and Susan Zulk, VP of marketing and fund development, nominated Margaret for the honor, noting: "While some heroes are noted for super human strength or saving children from burning buildings, Margaret's heroism isn't found within a single event, yet rather in 365 events each year."

Molitor is known for connecting with each patient and striving to brighten their days, perhaps with a joke, a small token from her pocket such as a little duck or other toy, with a comical accessory to her uniform, or with a song. Those gifts bring a smile yet do so much more as the act of giving demonstrates that she cares for that individual as a person, beyond her role as a nurse providing exceptional patient care.

"Margaret has sung for patients many times, likely more times than we know, treating them to a favorite melody," Zulk said. "A few years ago, our medical/surgical team helped host an impromptu wedding, as one of our patients was the father of the bride, yet he was too ill to leave his hospital room. Margaret volunteered to sing, adding to the special ceremony. For another patient, she brightened her days with a hymn, and later graciously accepted the family's invitation to sing at the memorial service. Many people have been touched by Margaret's kindness and her heroic dedication."

Free Sports Injury Clinics

Fall sports are an exciting time for the entire community, and local sports specialists want to ensure it's a safe one for the athletes themselves. Local medical professionals collectively comprising Sports Medicine Northwest are providing care for area athletes in various ways. Orthopedic surgeons from Northwest Iowa Bone, Joint & Sports Surgeons, a Certified Athletic Trainer, and Physical Therapists from Lakes Regional Healthcare (LRH) are offering a free Sports Injury Clinic and game coverage.

The free Sports Medicine Clinic will be held every Saturday at 9:00am or by appointment August 26 through October 21. Located within LRH's Physical Therapy department, just inside LRH's south entrance, the clinic is offered free of charge to area middle and high school athletes. Appointments and physician referrals are not necessary to utilize the clinic. However, a parent or guardian must accompany athletes under age 18. Therapists will review the injury and orthopedic surgeons will be available to provide further evaluation and specify treatment if needed. A free screening x-ray is also provided if warranted. Any follow-up appointments, further radiology tests such as CT scans or MRIs, or supplies such as casts, braces, or splints are charged to health insurance. Those interested in an injury evaluation other than Saturday mornings are encouraged to call LRH's Physical Therapy department at 712-336-8651 to schedule an appointment.

I Wish I Could Support the President

As President and Commander in Chief, Donald Trump's primary responsibility is to keep us safe - domestically and internationally. On the world front, his statements to North Korea that they face the possibility of "fire and fury like the world has never seen" would indicate the United States is "locked and loaded" ie: prepared to start a nuclear war. Who knows what action this would bring from China and Russia? Does this make anyone feel safe?

Here at home we see the riots at Charlottesville, Virginia. After pressure from citizens of Charlottesville and civil rights groups, the city council voted in February 2017 to remove the statue of General Robert Lee from Lee Park. Opponents of the move sued in March saying the city council did not have the authority to remove the statue under state law. The court case is continuing. In June the city council voted to change the name of the Lee Park to Emancipation Park.

Even though the permit for the "Unite the Right" rally was cancelled by city officials, KKK and white supremacist protesters of the statue removal descended on the campus of the University of Virginia armed with long guns, bats, brass knuckles, torches and Nazi symbols. A large group of anti-supremacists arrived and the conflict ensued. At one point, one of the protesters drove a car into a crowd of local residents, killing one and injuring thirty five.

Former Grand Wizard of the KKK, David Duke commented on the event. "This represents a turning point for the people of this country. We are determined to take back our country to fulfill the promise of Donald Trump. That's what we believed in, that's why we voted for him." Though many state and federal officials termed it an act of domestic terrorism, President Trump responded to the event by saying he condemned the violence by "MANY SIDES", but stopped short of explicitly condemning the white supremacist actions. It would appear that he felt the anti-supremacist arrival was not justified. A statement of moral clarity should have been made. After critical remarks by Republicans and Democrats, white house spokes people tried to say he was misinterpreted, but no comment from Trump yet. Does this make you feel safe?

We should not - cannot return to the days when segregation was seen as acceptable by large numbers of people. I would like to be able to support the elected head of state, but his words and actions make it impossible.

Throughout the day, youth will create their own eclipse viewer with mirrors; detect Ultraviolet (UV) rays; harness the sun's energy to make s'mores; and learn from NASA scientists.

Participants do not need to be 4-H members to attend; however, the camp space is limited, so individuals are encouraged to register early to guarantee a spot.

Bee and Butterfly Festival

The live monarch tagging is always a hit at the annual Bee and Butterfly Festival at the Dickinson County Nature Center, and this year's festival will feature live animals as well.

The Great Plains Zoomobile from Sioux Falls, South Dakota, will bring four live animals for a featured presentation during the Friday, September 1, festival.

"Adapted to the Habitat is a program when we discuss four different habitats and the adaptations animals have to survive in that habitat," said Leigh Spencer, education services manager for the Great Plains Zoo.

An education specialist with the zoo will bring four animals from four different habitats --- whether that be desert, wetland, forest, ocean, prairie or urban --- and will discuss how those animals survive. Then the audience will have the opportunity to come forward to touch one of the featured animals.

"They will get an idea of the habitats in our world and how each animal survives," Spencer said.

The Farm to Fork food truck will be on site for those who want to purchase dinner, and cotton candy will also be for sale with proceeds going to the Pollinator Paradise addition at the Dickinson County Nature Center.

Plus, Sweetie the Bee will take pictures with kids and adults throughout the event, and anyone who meets her will get a free honeystick.

The Bee and Butterfly Festival will culminate with a honey extraction demonstration by Boensen Bees of Ocheyedan at 7:15pm in the lower level of the Dickinson County Nature Center. Seating will be limited and will be allowed on first come, first served basis.

Regional Financial Aid Presentation at SAMI Center

Iowa College Access Network will be delivering their Regional Financial Aid Presentation at SAMI Bedell Center for Performing Arts on Thursday, August 24, at 5:30pm. This event is free and open to all.

Regional presentations are an opportunity to gain knowledge and resources for career and college planning, as well as the financial aid process.

The financial aid process can be daunting. From completing the application to understanding award letters, developing a plan to pay for college is one of the most important steps in the college process. This program covers: financial aid process, FAFSA application review, understanding the results of the application, understanding costs - college comparisons, aid options, scholarship process and where to go for help.

Mosquitoes Carrying West Nile Virus Found in Lakes Area

Awareness of West Nile virus has increased in recent years. A cooperative grant between Dickinson County Public Health and Iowa State University to collect mosquitos and test them for the virus has allowed them to monitor the presence of and manage the spread of the virus to residents and visitors in the Lakes Area.

Four traps were placed in Templar Park, Lakeview Cemetery, and near McDonalds during June and July. Three of the traps gathered live mosquitos, which were then tested for West Nile virus as well as their species. The last trap collected and killed mosquitos to test for population and species. Mosquitos carrying the West Nile virus have recently been collected in Templar Park. The mosquito found was Culex tarsalis, which is known to carry vector-borne diseases. This is cause for recognition, but not alarm. The Culex mosquitos are most active in the evening and in warmer temperatures. Otherwise, the data has shown a high amount of Coquillettia perturbans, also known as the sawtail mosquito, which do not carry any viruses that are infectious to humans. They do, however, pose a biting nuisance.

Dickinson County Public Health Director of Population and Public Health Brandon Rohrig said, "There were many mosquitos trapped this summer. In Dickinson County specifically, there are mosquitos that are known to carry vector-borne diseases. This means we need to stay safe at times where mosquitos are most active and we need to use insect repellent."

West Nile virus is spread by being bitten by mosquitos and other insects that are infected with the virus. Although most people bitten by an infected mosquito will develop no symptoms at all, a mild disease, termed "West Nile fever," occurs in 20 percent of those affected and is characterized as an illness of sudden onset with symptoms that may include rash, nausea, vomiting, eye pain, and headache. Less than one percent of those infected will develop a severe neurological form of the disease such as West Nile encephalitis or meningitis.

Two simple tips to prevent mosquito bites include:

1. Use insect repellent with DEET, picaridin, IR3535 or oil of lemon eucalyptus when outside, especially in the evening. Always read the repellent label and consult with a health care provider if you have questions when using these types of products for children. DEET should not be used on infants less than 2 months old. Oil of lemon eucalyptus should not be used on children under 3 years old.

2. Eliminate standing water around the home. Mosquitos love to breed in standing water, so if you want fewer mosquitos around, eliminate their breeding grounds.

Data will continue to be released for the next couple of weeks regarding the trapped mosquitos. For more information about mosquitos, visit https://mosquito.ent.iastate.edu/browse_county.php. The design phase was completed earlier this summer and this past month LRH received and approved construction bids. Badging Construction will be the general contractor for the renovation, Midwestern Mechanical will be the mechanical contractor, and Drees Co. will be the electrical contractor. Construction is slated to begin this month and complete in spring/summer 2018. Construction will be staged, beginning with remodeling space in the old surgery department to allow for a new CT scanner. Thanks to a \$400,000 grant from The Leona M. and Harry B. Helmsley Charitable Trust's Rural Healthcare Program, LRH will have a new 64-slice CT scanner. The new CT will allow for faster scans, higher quality images, and improved patient safety due to decreased radiation exposure.

As the CT is being moved, the chiller, currently located outdoors by the Imaging department, will move to the facility's south side. The next stage will involve remodeling the current CT space to allow for a new fluoroscopy unit. The new \$450,000 piece of equipment will provide increased speed and accuracy, better image quality, and decreased radiation exposure. As this part of the construction project occurs, a "private" patient/staff hallway to the Surgery Center will be constructed, which will provide increased patient privacy and comfort. The "private" hallway will greatly reduce the need for patients to be transported via the public hallway from ER, Imaging, and others to Surgery. The last stage will be the relocation of mammography to the existing fluoroscopy room. By this time, LRH hopes to have enough money raised through LRH Foundation to purchase 3D mammography.

"Imaging studies continue to evolve and provide a less-invasive way to diagnose and treat patients. It had been our plan to replace the fluoroscopy equipment this fiscal year and the Helmsley grant provided us the opportunity to move up the replacement of the CT scanner. As we evaluated this, it became clear that some of the existing spaces were no longer viable for the new equipment. This also provided an opportunity to evaluate the feasibility of constructing a hallway between Imaging and Surgery that had been originally planned when the construction of the new Surgery Center and Birth Center was completed. This was pulled out of that project due to cost, but since work will be done in that area and the chiller having been replaced, makes way for us to consider this. Further, we knew that the Foundation was actively raising funds for a future 3D mammography unit and all of the pieces fell into place. Once completed, we will have improved patient access and privacy, reduced patient exposure to radiation, and improved the quality of our imaging studies that will only positively benefit our patients and community," said LRH President and CEO Jason Harrington.

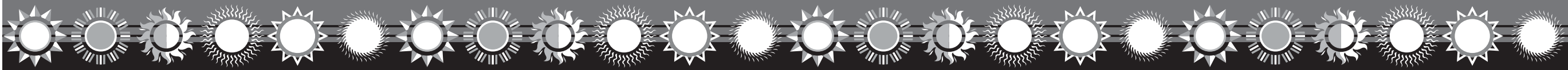

PRINT MARKETING vs DIGITAL MARKETING

CONSUMER BEHAVIOR & NEUROMARKETING PRINCIPLES

One of the most common questions that I get from new clients is "should I focus on digital ads or print ads?" There is no easy answer to this question, but my general answer to that question is both. And, for the clients that want to move completely digital, there is new data out that suggests you should put the brakes on that thought and rethink.

Why? Simply put, it's about how our brain works. In a recent study, based on brain scans, a print ad appeals more to the part of the brain that has the highest correlation with advertising effectiveness than a digital ad. Brand recall is up to 70% higher in print advertising than in digital media. In a study that measured 1,400 campaigns using a variety of ad venues, print advertising resulted in the highest return on ad spending. Consumers are 70% more likely to remember a company name from a print ad than a digital ad. There is also a 75% print ad recall, (meaning they remember the ad) in comparison to a 44% digital ad recall.

Generally speaking, consumers tend to be more relaxed and focused when they read print magazines or newspapers. As a result, they are less likely to be distracted by other options and they therefore make decisions more quickly and are generally more likely to feel satisfied with purchases they make in this mindset.

Researchers are just starting to understand the neurological pros and cons of online versus print advertising. But, it may come as no surprise that print and digital media excel in different areas. One of the most notable benefits of print ads is that they are better at stimulating emotions and desires. Engaging with a physical ad can also improve recognition and recall because paper stimulates more senses and is therefore more real to the brain. And for those of us trying to build a brand that connects emotionally with our customers, to create brand loyalty, it builds a case for continued print ad spending.

So, you may still be thinking, who reads print anymore? It comes as no surprise to me that based on this study, magazine readers are wealthy and well educated. However, they also found that the Millennial did not get lost, as data shows 95% of Americans under the age of 25 still read print magazines. And that's the real story.
