I slipped and fell at work. When I did I hurt my hip. A co-worker advised me to fill out some forms and I did. Can I now go to my doctor?

Randall, Muscle Shoals, AL

No you may not go to your doctor. I am pleased that you took your co-workers advice and formally reported your

injury. Although Alabama has a two (2) year statute of limitations for on-the-job injuries, what a lot of people fail to appreciate is that if your accident is not reported in five (5) days you have not met the notice requirements of the Workers Compensation Act. This notice can be oral (possibly risky without a witness), written or "immediate actual" meaning the ambulance came and took the injured person out on a stretcher.

If you don't give notice you do not have a case. You may notify the employer for up to 90 days but after that your case could be over unless a good workers compensation lawyer, and they are few, can find a way to solve the notice issue.

Now, about your doctor, no you can't see your own, and they really have you here. Here's the catch. Your health insurance won't pay for an on-the-job injury. The employers workers compensation insurance will only pay for the doctor they choose, and don't forget that he who pays the piper calls the tune. You may only see the doctors they choose. If you want a second opinion you can get a panel of four doctors of their choice for you to choose one. Do not do this on your own.

Anyway, many websites now require that you use a combination of capital letters, small letters, at least one number, a special character, and dance in circles as you type them. Making it even worse, some websites force you to change your password every so often. So, Publication 800-63. Appendix

inevitably, we all end up having to remember a dozen different passwords and inevitably forget them and inevitably have to jump through hoops to regain access to our account. How the heck did we get into such a mess?

Turns out that the complicated password scheme all started with a guy named Bill Burr who was a mid-level employee at the National Institute of Standards and Technology in 2003. He was tasked with determining the best method of securing user accounts. He published his findings in "NIST Special

A." This publication was the go-to guide for federal agencies, universities, and large companies looking for a set of password rules to follow. Those standards eventually filtered down to us.

Recently, it was discovered that a skilled hacker can hack these types of passwords in about 3 days using brute-force techniques. Oops!

Thankfully, the standards were recently updated to a more secure yet much simpler password scheme: Four random

It was found that the same brute-force hacking techniques would take about 550 years to crack four random words such as "RollWarTideEagle." Ok, maybe that's not random and perhaps a bit scandalous, but the idea is to NOT make a sentence, but still have four easy-to-remember, random words. Just use your imagination.

Another part of the standards assert that periodic changes to your password is not necessary unless there is suspicion that the account has been compromised. So, yay, one password for all!

The websites that require the old style complicated passwords are going to have to do some retooling before all that makes it down to us little people but it will come. That's good news. The bad news is that you

still have to remember these pesky passwords until all that happens. I use a product called LastPass to remember all my passwords for me. Install it

on your computer and your phones/tablets, and you'll always have access to your stuff no matter what device you are using. Competing products include Dashlane and LogMeOnce. Each product has a free version but the paid version that gives you more options. If you're a Gmail user and use the Chrome browser, it has a handy password vault that syncs all your saved passwords among all your devices such as phones and tablets.

Regardless, we know the sky darkened almost completely for those of us in northwest Alabama.

Being the first solar eclipse of this magnitude I have experienced, I can't help but think about some of the crucifixion deniers who claim that the darkened skies referenced in Matthew 27, Mark 15, and Luke 23 were nothing more than a solar eclipse. There are at least a few problems with







Unfortunately, there are those who seek to politicize the Charlottesville homicide, and ignore the destruction of life that terrorizes many urban

neighborhoods.

President Trump has spoken out and his Department of Justice led by Attorney General Jeff Sessions is focused on trying to solve the homicides in Chicago and find justice for Charlottesville


President Trump hit the nail on the head the day after the Charlottesville tragedy saying, "We must rediscover the bonds of love and loyalty that bring us together as Americans. Racism is evil and those who cause violence in its name are criminals and thugs, including the KKK, neo-Nazis, white supremacists, and other hate groups that are repugnant to everything we hold dear as Americans. We are a nation founded on the truth that all of us are created equal. We are equal in the eyes of our creator. We are equal under the law and we are equal under our Constitution. 





in any of the references.
The Gospel of Matthew also mentions that the earth quaked, rocks were split, and tombs broke open. That doesn't sound like a simple solar eclipse.

In addition, the curtain (veil) of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. This was no modest room curtain like we sometimes see depicted in old movies. Historic documents indicate that the veil was 60 feet long, 30 feet wide, and was four inches thick. It was so massive and heavy that it supposedly took 300 priests to manipulate it.

The upheaval that marked Jesus' death was so great that even his most ardent critics knew they had made a grave mistake.

A full or nearly full solar eclipse is really impressive and demonstrates God's unfathomable power and handiwork.

However, it remotely begin to explain away that world-changing event that took place just outside Jerusalem's walls some 2,000 years ago.

Medicare Minute

Durable Medical Equipment

Durable Medical Equipment are items such as walkers, wheelchairs, and hospital beds that are used in the home. Medicare will cover certain durable medical equipment only if your physician prescribes it. To be prescribed the durable médical equipment must be: durable, or reusable, used for a medical purpose, and primarily used at home. Durable medical equipment is covered under Medicare Part B.

Some examples of items that qualify as durable medical equipment are, but not limited to: Oxygen equipment and supplies, walkers, wheelchairs, hospital beds, infusion supplies, and patient lifts. Remember, these items should be used primarily at home. If you are residing in a nursing home or hospital, and that facility is providing you with Medicare covered care, it may not be considered your home. If you are staying in a skilled nursing facility, that facility will usually provide the durable medical equipment you need.

If you need durable medical equipment, make sure your doctor and durable medical equipment supplier are enrolled in Medicare. If you doctor or supplier is not enrolled, Medicare will not pay the claims they submit. Without any type of supplemental insurance, you typically will be responsible for 20% of the Medicare approved amount. Also, if you are on a Medicare Advantage Plan you may have copays or coinsurance.

One last thing. There are companies out there that will place outbound calls to Medicare beneficiaries offering to send you durable medical equipment or other items for free. A lady told us just last week this happened to her. The company offered to send her a knee brace at no cost. She didn't need the knee brace but they wanted to send it anyway. These companies will send you the item, then bill Medicare. Remember, nothing is free!! Someone is always paying.

Greenhouse to Cafeteria Keeps Young Familiar

Editor:

In the last 20 years, small schools facing budget cuts often removed elective classes. This left skills like cooking and growing fruits

and vegetables unlearned.
Center for Rural Affairs'
Greenhouse to Cafeteria
program has been a
solution for schools that have faced those decisions in the past. Not only does it fill a hole left in the curriculum, it also means healthier foods are served at lunch.

The program allows students to grow fruits and vegetables in school greenhouses. After harvesting, students deliver the produce to the cafeteria. Cafeteria staff then have an opportunity to buy and use the fresh food in the lunch program.

Growing food is an experience both students educators benefit from. Hands-on activities turn pulling weeds and snapping beans into math and science lessons.

Exploring the food system teaches insights that may go untaught. Students have shared with us they feel empowered to know they are taking care of the healthy menu items.

In some schools, the summer months are being

summer months are being used to teach skills needed to run a market stand. These programs are helping build entrepreneurs, farmers, and experts - both culinary and in the food system.

Greenhouse to Cafeteria pilot schools are investing in serving healthier options to rural students' bodies and minds. These schools are providing experiences in careers youth may want to explore. Schools are also serving up a new dialogue about the community and rural America; one where students can envision their future self inside of, rather than leaving.



How Do I Know If I Have Lupus?

I will occasionally have lungs (also called pleuritis) a patient who suffers from fatigue and joint pains ask as to whether they might have lupus. For those not familiar with this disease, lupus is one of numerous autoimmune diseases that can affect people. Autoimmune diseases are a family of illnesses where our immune system, which normally exists to fight germs, goes haywire and in turn attacks different parts of the body. Systemic lupus can be particularly serious and debilitating because of the many organ systems that can be involved. In fact, diagnosing somebody with lupus requires having several symptoms involving different body parts.

The American College of Rheumatology established criteria for diagnosing lupus back in 1982 and revised them in 1997. There are a total of 11 criteria and a patient should fulfill at least four of them to be considered to have lupus. Three of the criteria involve distinct skin conditions. One skin condition is the classic "butterfly" or malar rash that can appear on the face while another is a thick scaly rash called a discoid rash. The other skin condition is one called photosensitivity, where a skin rash forms in reaction to sunlight exposure. Another criterion involves the presence of internal ulcers found in the mouth and/or the nose. Arthritis is also a feature of lupus. Unlike autoimmune diseases like rheumatoid arthritis, where the joint inflammation causes pieces of the bone to wear away, bone destruction is usually not seen with lupus. However, this doesn't mean that arthritis pain in lupus isn't significant nor that it can't be deforming. Arthritis pain in lupus, as in other autoimmune disease, is often worse earlier in the day. Not only can inflammation in lupus occur in the joints to cause arthritis, but it can also occur in the lining of the

or the sac lining the heart (also called pericarditis). Inflammation in these organs not only leads to chest pain, but can lead to complications that cause difficulty with heart and lung function. Besides the heart and lungs, lupus can also affect the kidneys and lead to kidney failure if untreated with strong medicines. One underappreciated of lupus is its effect on the brain and mind. Problems from seizures to psychotic behavior to paralysis have been seen in lupus. Lupus can also go on to affect the function of the bone marrow and many patients will suffer low white blood cell counts, red blood cell counts and platelets. The last two criteria relate to the presence of positive antibodies that can be found in the blood of lupus sufferers. The tricky part of these criteria is that some are very common in lupus but are not specific for lupus. That is, somebody can have a positive antibody test and not necessarily have lupus. On the other hand, not having any positive antibody blood tests doesn't mean that one doesn't have lupus. This is where paying attention to the other criteria is important. Systemic lupus can indeed be tricky to diagnose in a patient, often requiring referral to a specialist in order to help clear up whether they truly have the disease or not. If you suspect having a condition like this, I encourage you to have a dialogue with your primary care provider regarding your concerns. Dr. Roy Barco welcomes your
