
- **USE A KEY WORD.** This immediately tells the reader exactly what you have to sell.
- Make your description CLEAR AND FACTUAL. State the year, make, model, color & size and tell what condition the item is in. Also, state the special features.
- STATE THE PRICE. Successful classified advertisers have learned that the price in an ad helps increase the chances for results.
- IF THERE IS A GENUINE SENSE OF URGENCY, say so. The words "We're moving," or "Must sell fast," suggest that readers respond immediately.
- **INCLUDE YOUR PHONE NUMBER.** Classifieds get results fast and often generate immediate sales. If you cannot be available to answer the phone at all times, be sure to specify special calling times such as "after 9pm" or before 11am."

Stream & Lake Map of New York

STREAM MAP

The STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW YORK resembles another map-known to Pennsylvania anglers as the "Lost Stream Map."

It was completed in 1965 after a 30 year effort by Howard Higbee, a former Penn State Professor.

Professor Higbee painstakingly plotted by hand, the location of 45,000 miles of streams onto the map. It sold extremely well - until the printer declared bankruptcy and hauled Higbee's work to the landfill.

But reprints were impossible because the maps were printed in non-photographic blue. Higbee was even offered \$400 for one of his last maps. And state agencies were forced to keep their copies under lock and key.

Then, at the age of 91, Howard Higbee's dream came true. Computers made it possible to reprint the map.

Then the STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW YORK was created.





Eagles make me happy.

requirement has long been obsolete and in reality was mistakenly thought to be safer than rifles. None of the counties across the state has seen any increase of problems with rifle use. Genesee County is also now permanently rifle.

As you who follow my column know, I spend a great deal of time around the two local state wildlife management areas (the Tonawanda and Oak Orchard) and the Federal Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge with my camera. So what do I see as my camera is taken on these adventures?

To start, bald eagles are seen almost on a daily basis. Each time there is a build up of excitement and the challenge of improving on the hundreds of bald eagle images already in my PC.

I'm always moved by the sight of these majestic birds whether it be adults or immatures either perched in a tree or soaring across the sky. Let's just say they make me happy.

On these almost daily adventures I see a lot of trash thrown out along our roads and that concerns me, especially when it is on the refuge areas. Lately a lot of trash is ending up on the various overlooks such as the Ringneck, Mallard and School House Overlooks on the Iroquois NWR. Sometimes it is not just a casual fast food bag or beer cans, but what took a pickup truck to deliver. Of course all this trash doesn't make me happy.

Guys running beagles on the INWR this time of the year, especially when it is highly illegal, is not only disturbing to those trying to view nature, but it is very disruptive of wildlife. That does not make me happy either.

Ospreys are another bird I get excited about especially when watching them building their nests or diving into the water to catch a fish. They make me happy.

Having a place to fish, especially to introduce young folks to the sport, is great, but I often see regulations being ignored by folks kayaking or canoeing in Ringneck Marsh when it is posted that no boating is allowed. Or like last weekend I saw some individuals actually drive down on the big dike in front of the overlook and spend the day fishing when that is a really big no, no. That doesn't make anyone happy when they have to hike down there only to see someone illegally drive down there.

Occasionally something special shows up such as the Glossy Ibis I saw summer. It is really a southern bird and very rare in this area. Or the Peregrine Falcon who popped up on a dead tree not too far from me. That made me happy as he hung around long enough to give me some nice shots and even one that allowed the leg band he wore to be read.

There is a nice place for the public to fish right off Route 63 by the bridge that goes over Oak Orchard Creek and has a nice paved walkway down to the creek. I stopped by the other day to check it out and discovered that you have to wade through a jungle of poison ivy (both on the ground and hanging down from the trees) to get to the water. I can't imagine what the results could be for some parents taking their kids down there to fish. I would think the INWR would make that area more user friendly by getting rid of that stuff. That sight didn't make me happy.

Great egrets are pretty common around here now even though that wasn't always so a decade or so ago. They are beautiful birds both in the air and wading around in the marsh looking for lunch. I'm sure I'm not the only one who is happy by the sight of these birds.

So there are a lot of things out there on these refuge areas for the public to enjoy. What I don't see much of in all the hours I spent in these areas is any law enforcement. Maybe if there was some of that out there some of the unhappy things would go away.







How to Invest in Gold and Silver

Gold, silver and other precious metals have been used as currency throughout history. Paper money is a relatively recent method of payment, one that requires a certain level of faith among consumers. But that faith in paper currency has waned in recent years, and there are many people who are once again investing in gold and silver.

Gold and silver still have a position of great financial importance in today's market. With the value of a dollar fluctuating, precious metals may make a more stable investment. But investors who plan to investigate gold and silver should consider a few things before making their decision.

- Look into bullion. Gold and silver bullion are made from 99 percent of the total metal. This helps stabilize the cost and is not dependent on some of the fees or price fluctuations resulting from coins issued by various government institutions. Keep in mind that investing in bullion can be expensive and will require a high initial investment outlay. Also, you will have to find a secure method of storing and protecting the metal. - Purchase coins. One of the easiest and safest ways to invest in gold and silver is to buy coins. These will be minted from pure metals and are often issued through government-backed mints. Although gold coins aren't widely circulated, silver coins contain enough whole silver mixed with other alloys to make them valuable.
- Consider mutual funds. Rather than purchasing gold or silver outright, you can invest in mutual funds that then allocate a bulk of the fund's investment into the purchase of gold or silver. This requires less knowledge of metal markets and also less work. However, it still enables you to invest in gold and silver.
- Sell scrap jewelry. While you may not get the full value of the jewelry, you can take advantage of the rising rates of gold and silver by selling off items you may not use. Selling extra jewelry requires little work on the part of the seller.





Did You Know?

According to the United States Department of Labor, single men and women are having an easier time finding work in the slow economy than their married counterparts. A survey conducted by the Labor Department found that single men and women had lost roughly 5 million jobs during the financial crisis. However, the same survey revealed that single men and women, in spite of the slow job recovery across the country, regained about 90 percent of those jobs. Married people have not fared nearly as well. Since the onset of the financial crisis, married people lost more jobs (6 million) than single people and have not been nearly as successful regaining those jobs, recouping only about 22 percent. The disparity could be due to a host of factors, but economists feel married people, many of whom live in dual income households, have had the freedom to be more selective when choosing their next jobs, a freedom not afforded to single men and women.


