





We charge about \$1,000.00 for a corporation and that includes the corporate seal, the books and the stock. I will not create a corporation unless you have a CPA or a nonseasonal tax service. Corporations require that certain formalities be observed and if they are not observed, then the corporation is not valid and you are exactly as responsible for whatever debt is claimed as you would be without a corporation. We have a case right now where a man had a corporation but did not disclose it and just signed his name. He thought his corporate entity would protect his personal assets. He was wrong.

Medicare Minute "Frequently Asked Questions"

We began in the Medicare business in 2009. Since that time we have been asked some interesting and unique questions about Medicare. However, the majority of the questions we are asked we get on a regular basis. Over the next few weeks we are going to discuss some of our most frequently asked questions.

Do I have to sign up for Medicare Part B when I turn 65 *if I'm still employed?* This is one of the questions we get asked the most. In most cases the answer to this is "no". When you turn 65, if you are still working and on your employer's health insurance plan you probably will not need Medicare Part B. I say probably because most employer plans do not file on Medicare if you have a claim. Because you have to pay a premium for Part B, Medicare does not require a person to sign up for Part B as long as you are on your employer's plan. Once you retire the rules may change. The safest thing to do is check with the benefits coordinator at your place of employment for guidance or give us a call at our office.

I am on Medicare and Social Security Disability. I'm turning 65 soon. What are my options? Once you reach the age of 65 you have many more options than before. As you know if you go on Medicare and you are under the age of 65 your options for health plans are limited. When you turn 65 you will have another open enrollment period to sign up for any plan you wish to get. In other words, just because you are already on Medicare does not prohibit you from having all the options a person not on Medicare and turning 65 would have.

of the U.S. Constitution and the First Amendment. Every law enforcement officer at the local and state level, the State's National Guard, and the U.S. Military is obligated by oath and duty to remove Group B from the area around Group A, and if necessary use force to protect and defend the Constitution of the United States and the First Amendment. Every member of Group B that physically attempts to hinder, suppress, or impose upon the First Amendment Rights of Group A should be arrested and charged in Federal Court.



ON YOUR DEBT

What Types of **Income Count** When Filing **Bankruptcy?**

It is no surprise that the amount of income you have effects your ability to file a bankruptcy case. However, there are many different types of income. Wages, tips, Social Security, and VA Disability income are just a few. Be aware that just because you may not have to file income taxes on all or a part of your income, doesn't mean you can leave it out when filing bankruptcy.

When it comes to calculating your monthly budget for the Court, all forms of income must be counted. If it is income that is used by the household to pay the regular monthly bills, then it must be included. Even if the income comes from Social Security or VA benefits (sources that may be exempt from income calculations when filing tax returns), it must still be balanced into the budget. The Court will use your budget to calculate how much of a payment, if any, you could afford in a bankruptcy case.

The Means Test is different. The Means Test is used to determine whether a person qualifies for a Chapter 7 bankruptcy case or for what length of time they must remain in a Chapter 13 reorganization bankruptcy. When calculating your income under the Means Test, only Social Security income is exempt. It is also possible to be exempt from taking the Means Test entirely if you are a disabled veteran.

However, in order to qualify for this exemption, you must

(1) be a disabled veteran as defined by 38 U.S.C §371(1) and

(2) incurred most of your debts while on active duty or performing a homeland defense activity, as defined by 10 U.S.C §101(d)(1) and 32 U.S.C. §901(1).

38 U.S.Ć §374(1) defines a disabled veteran as: (A) A veteran who is entitled to compensation for a disability rated at 30 percent or more, or

(B) A veteran whose discharge or release from active duty was for a disability incurred or

aggravated in line of duty. 10 U.S.C. §101(d)(1) defines active duty as fulltime duty in the active military service of the United States, and 32 U.S.C. §901(1) defines homeland defense as an activity undertaken for the military protection of the territory or domestic population of the United States, or of infrastructure or other assets of the United States determined by the Secretary of Defense as being critical to national security, from a

threat or aggression against the United States. So, simply being a disabled veteran isn't enough to exempt the Means Test. You must meet both requirements. Keep in mind, that even if you are exempt from the Means Test, you still may not qualify to file a Chapter 7 case. If the Court believes you could afford to make payments on a Chapter 13 payment plan, then an attempt to file for Chapter ל could be viewed as an act of bad faith and cause your case to be denied. Pet Odor

One of the fastest ways to lose a potential buyer who's looking at your home is for the home to have a strong pet or smoking odor.

It should be a surprise to prospective buyers that you have a dog or a cat. They should be able to walk through your home and not know by the odor that you have an inside pet. If the house has a pet odor, it is critical to get that taken care of, even if it means replacing the pad and the carpet. You must get rid of the pet odor. It is incredibly important. An unpleasant odor will send buyers running, especially if they or family members have allergies. People with allergies often walk into a home, and the odor alone will make them turn around and w lk out the door. Also, be very careful about pet hair. While your home is on the market, vacuum the floor frequently, vacuum any furniture on which the pet spends time, and check curtains and rugs often. 
