Jones Among 53 at ABS

BankExec consists of sophisticated bank balance sheet and income statement software that allows the students to run a simulated bank.

Jason Windham, Senior Vice President of Sales Management at Bank Independent, is a longtime member of the Alabama Banking School faculty and currently serves as the school's director. Students attended three week-long sessions during a two-year period to complete the program. They must successfully complete two final exams at the end of each session. While not in session, students are required to complete extensive home study problems.

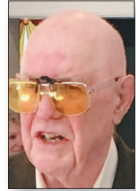

Handy Music Festival in 1982.

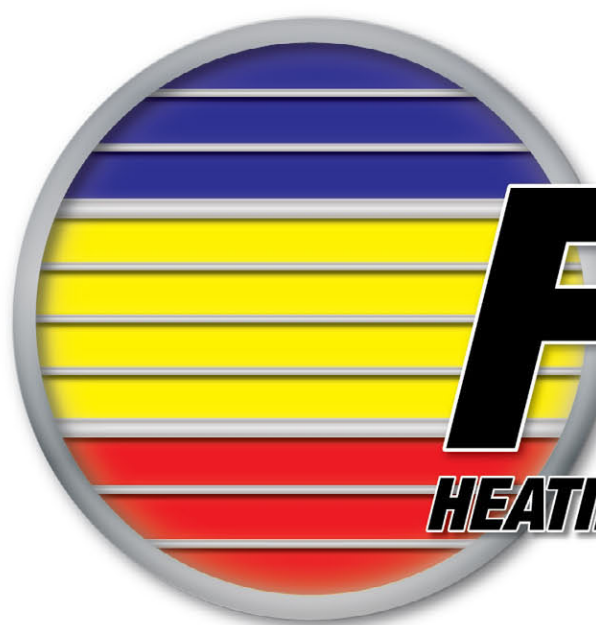

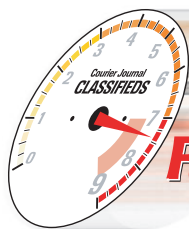

That said, we see mailbox wills that are not valid, and do not and can not accomplish the goals intended by the people trying to make their own wills. People try to do things that are just

not valid. We have a case in the office now where the will was not valid and the estate has to be administered without a will, at a much greater cost.

Third, mailbox corporation kits. The ads say "don't lose everything you have, get a corporation". We charge about \$1,000.00 for a corporation and that includes the corporate seal, the books and the stock. I will not create a corporation unless you have a CPA or a non-seasonal tax service. Corporations require that certain formalities be observed and if they are not observed, then the corporation is not valid and you are exactly as responsible for whatever debt is claimed as you would be without a corporation. We have a case right now where a man had a corporation but did not disclose it and just signed his name. He thought his corporate entity would protect his personal assets. He was wrong.

Medicare Minute
"Frequently Asked Questions"
 We began in the Medicare business in 2009. Since that time we have been asked some interesting and unique questions about Medicare. However, the majority of the questions we are asked we get on a regular basis. Over the next few weeks we are going to discuss some of our most frequently asked questions.
Do I have to sign up for Medicare Part B when I turn 65 if I'm still employed? This is one of the questions we get asked the most. In most cases the answer to this is "no". When you turn 65, if you are still working and on your employer's health insurance plan you probably will not need Medicare Part B. I say probably because most employer plans do not file on Medicare if you have a claim. Because you have to pay a premium for Part B, Medicare does not require a person to sign up for Part B as long as you are on your employer's plan. Once you retire the rules may change. The safest thing to do is check with the benefits coordinator at your place of employment for guidance or give us a call at our office.
I am on Medicare and Social Security Disability. I'm turning 65 soon. What are my options? Once you reach the age of 65 you have many more options than before. As you know if you go on Medicare and you are under the age of 65 your options for health plans are limited. When you turn 65 you will have another open enrollment period to sign up for any plan you wish to get. In other words, just because you are already on Medicare does not prohibit you from having all the options a person not on Medicare and turning 65 would have.

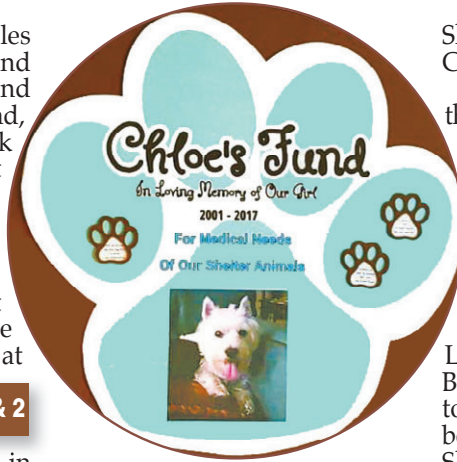

How We Got Here

Editor:

The First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution guarantees the citizens of this country the right to free speech and assembly. The First Amendment has never granted the right to hinder, suppress, or impose upon the free speech and assembly rights of citizens.

Group A applies for a parade and demonstration permit. A local authority grants the permit. At that moment, Group A has the full power and authority of the U.S. Constitution and First Amendment rights on its side. Group B opposes Group A's message. Group B assembles and demonstrates against Group A's message. Group B is exercising its First Amendment rights of free speech and assembly.

However, when Group B interferes with, attempts to hinder, or tries to suppress Group A's free speech and assembly rights, Group B is in violation

of the U.S. Constitution and the First Amendment. Every law enforcement officer at the local and state level, the State's National Guard, and the U.S. Military is obligated by oath and duty to remove Group B from the area around Group A, and if necessary use force to protect and defend the Constitution of the United States and the First Amendment. Every member of Group B that physically attempts to hinder, suppress, or impose upon the First Amendment Rights of Group A should be arrested and charged in Federal Court.

So how did we get here? The Federal Government, specifically the

Executive Branch, has been selective in its enforcement of the Constitution and Bill of Rights. Local and State law enforcement has been selective in its enforcement of Constitution and Bill of Rights out of fear of retaliation from the Federal Government. The Federal Government has stopped protecting and defending the Constitution and Bill of Rights. The Federal Government has failed in its most important duty.

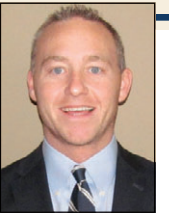

ON YOUR DEBT

What Types of Income Count When Filing Bankruptcy?

It is no surprise that the amount of income you have effects your ability to file a bankruptcy case. However, there are many different types of income. Wages, tips, Social Security, and VA Disability income are just a few. Be aware that just because you may not have to file income taxes on all or a part of your income, doesn't mean you can leave it out when filing bankruptcy.

When it comes to calculating your monthly budget for the Court, all forms of income must be counted. If it is income that is used by the household to pay the regular monthly bills, then it must be included. Even if the income comes from Social Security or VA benefits (sources that may be exempt from income calculations when filing tax returns), it must still be balanced into the budget. The Court will use your budget to calculate how much of a payment, if any, you could afford in a bankruptcy case.

The Means Test is different. The Means Test is used to determine whether a person qualifies for a Chapter 7 bankruptcy case or for what length of time they must remain in a Chapter 13 reorganization bankruptcy. When calculating your income under the Means Test, only Social Security income is exempt. It is also possible to be exempt from taking the Means Test entirely if you are a disabled veteran.

However, in order to qualify for this exemption, you must

- (1) be a disabled veteran as defined by 38 U.S.C §371(1) and
 - (2) incurred most of your debts while on active duty or performing a homeland defense activity, as defined by 10 U.S.C §101(d)(1) and 32 U.S.C. §901(1).
- 38 U.S.C §374(1) defines a disabled veteran as:
- (A) A veteran who is entitled to compensation for a disability rated at 30 percent or more, or
 - (B) A veteran whose discharge or release from active duty was for a disability incurred or aggravated in line of duty.

10 U.S.C. §101(d)(1) defines active duty as full-time duty in the active military service of the United States, and 32 U.S.C. §901(1) defines homeland defense as an activity undertaken for the military protection of the territory or domestic population of the United States, or of infrastructure or other assets of the United States determined by the Secretary of Defense as being critical to national security, from a threat or aggression against the United States.

So, simply being a disabled veteran isn't enough to exempt the Means Test. You must meet both requirements. Keep in mind, that even if you are exempt from the Means Test, you still may not qualify to file a Chapter 7 case. If the Court believes you could afford to make payments on a Chapter 13 payment plan, then an attempt to file for Chapter 7 could be viewed as an act of bad faith and cause your case to be denied. 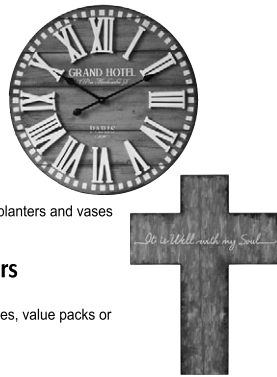

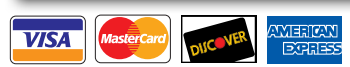

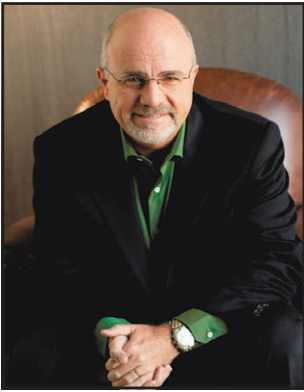

based and other factors. With this in mind, how should I approach Baby Step 3?
Brad

Dear Brad,
For Baby Step 3, I tell folks to have three to six months of expenses set aside in an emergency fund. You have incredibly stable employment, so you would probably be okay on the three-month side of that equation. And you wouldn't need quite as much emergency fund money as if you were a straight commission salesman.

However, my guess is you'll still have emergencies that will be your responsibility to cover. Everyone needs an emergency fund, Brad. But in your situation, you'll probably be okay with one that's closer to three months of expenses rather than six months of expenses.

Dear Dave,
My husband opened his own commercial painting business in May. He knows he will have about three months in the year where he's making little to no income. We've gotten \$1,000 set aside for our Baby Step 1 beginner's emergency fund, but because of that down period he would like to skip paying off all our debt except for the house, which is Baby Step 2, and move to Baby Step 3 and put an emergency fund aside. I can understand his thinking, but I wanted your thoughts on the idea.
Melody

Dear Melody,
Baby Step 3 is not a fill-in-the-gap measure for income you already know won't be there. Baby Step 3 is an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses, and the scenario he's talking about is not an emergency. He knows it's coming, so it is not an emergency.

I think he needs to re-work his business model. This guy needs something

to do during those three months, so he doesn't drop off to no income. Also, if you're going to set some money aside for a down time, that would not be Baby Step 3. It would be a line in the budget where you're setting some money aside, because you know a problem's coming.

If something happens around the same time every year it becomes predictable, and it's not an emergency. So, it's not really a matter of the order of the Baby Steps. You budget for this down time, or even smarter, figure out a plan for his time during these months, based on his skill set, that will earn some money!

The Missing Piece

I imagine that all of us have put together jigsaw puzzles at one time or another. Through the years they have cycled in and out at our house. We will get on a kick and do several in a row and then our interest wanes. They can be a lot of fun and some can be rather challenging. In fact, we have worked on some puzzles (on and off) for days before they were completed.

But have you ever had the experience of working diligently to finish a puzzle only to discover at the end that a piece is missing? How frustrating!!! You get the feeling that all that time and work were in vain. After all, a puzzle is never complete until all the pieces are in place.

That has happened to us a couple of times. I usually imagine a janitor down at the puzzle factory sweeping one night and finding our missing piece and saying to himself, "Uh oh! Somebody is going to be unhappy!" If he did, he was right!

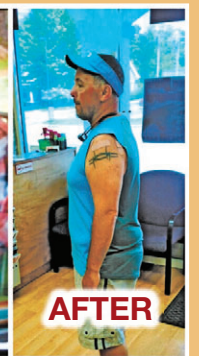

I have no respect for individuals defending or states protecting the confederate statues and monuments because they memorialize white southerner's racist heritage, although I too am undoubtedly a descendant of white slave owners and Confederate Rebels that legally engaged in forced miscegenation of African slaves and their descendants.

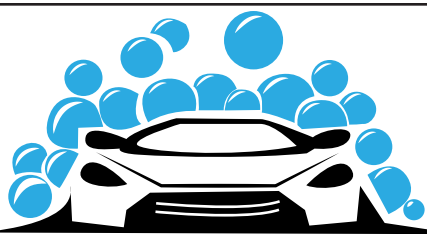

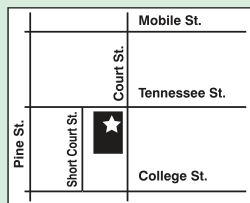

Pet Odor

One of the fastest ways to lose a potential buyer who's looking at your home is for the home to have a strong pet or smoking odor.

Your home will have a really strong smoke odor, and you must get rid of it. You may not notice an odor because you've become accustomed to it. I have shown property that was priced effectively and an otherwise nice home in a nice location, but the buyers didn't even give it a chance because of the odor alone. They just turned around and walked right out the door. It's critical to address pet and smoke odors. However, you cannot mask them with room deodorizers. Your home will just smell like smoky flowers, or pet urine with a top note of berries.

Get an honest opinion from someone who can tell you the truth about any bad odor in your home and who does not have to worry about hurting your feelings or causing you to become defensive or offended. Do what it takes even if this means making some temporary arrangements that may be a little inconvenient. It will definitely pay off. -mr

That's where I come in every now and then. This afternoon I got a text from my daughter (she had tried to call), "I AM FREAKING OUT, LOOK WHAT YOU DID TO MY KITCHEN!!!! (Bunch of laughing, kissing, smiling, upside down emojis) THANK YOU!!!!!!!" I shot back, "Welcome." Mission accomplished. I prefer cleaning over casseroles. I got that from my mom. Try it sometime. The love that explodes as you clean a sick friend's toilet will bring more pleasure than ever expected. Love is always strengthened when we get outside of ourselves.

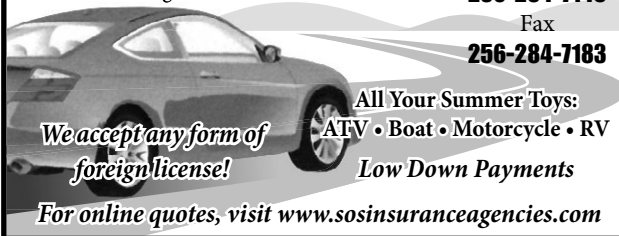

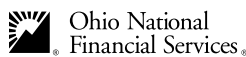

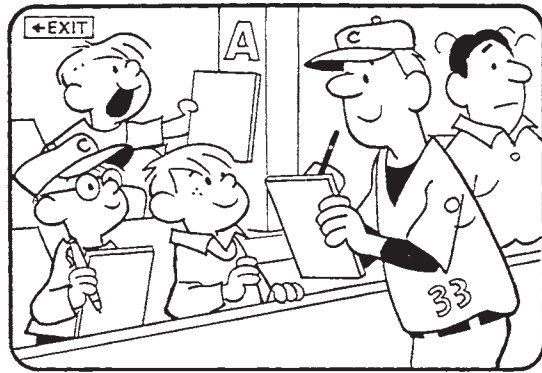
What And Where Do You Worship?

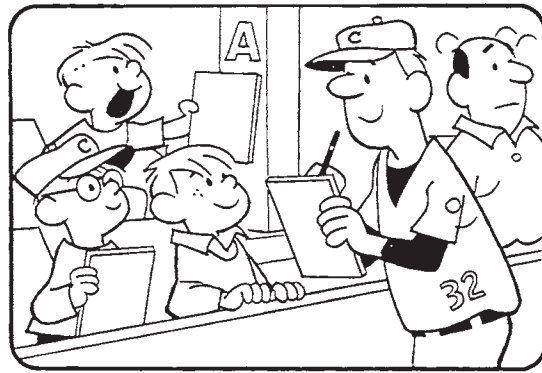

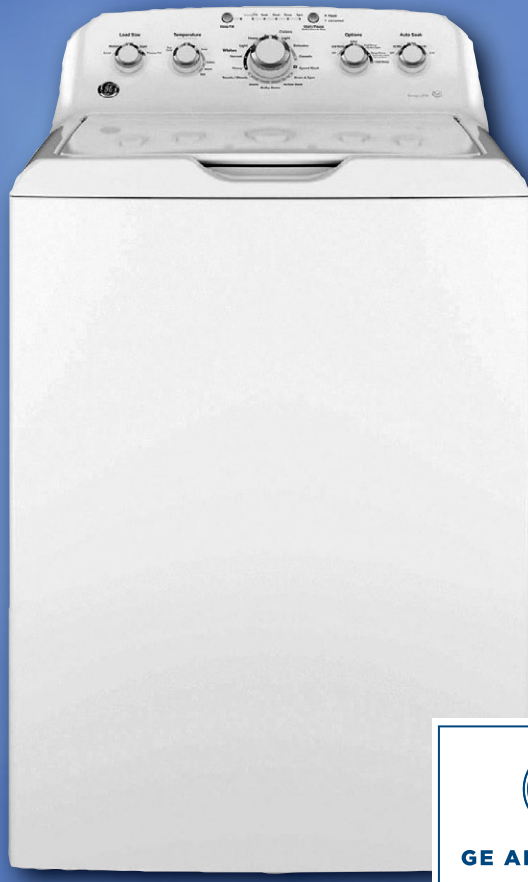
