Deaths by suicide result in tragic losses - psychological, social and economic each year. According to the New York State Department of Health, Livingston County has one of the highest suicide rates in the region. In 2013, Livingston County had an average of 15 suicides per 100,000 people while the state average was 8. Adding to these numbers are the numerous family members and close friends that are forever affected.

The theme of this year's World Suicide Prevention Day is 'Connect, communicate, care'. These three words are at the heart of suicide prevention. It has been said that humans need a sense of belonging and connectedness in order to survive. Social connectedness reduces the risk of suicide while Communication reduces the stigma that may allow individuals to seek out help without the risk of shame or judgment. Finally all the connecting and communicating will have no effect without the final ingredient – care – care for others AND care for ourselves.




