Celebrate Labor Day the 'Rosie' Way

Labor Day is a celebration held on the first Monday in September to recognize American workers, their contributions to the prosperity of our country, and the products that they produce. Labor Day has been celebrated nationwide since 1894.

One of the most recognizable icons of labor and the contributions made by women in the workforce is "Rosie the Riveter." She is the ultimate representation of the indefatigable World War II-era woman who rolled up her sleeves, flexed her muscles and said, "We Can Do It!" But this image isn't the original Rosie.

In 1942, as World War II raged in Europe and the Pacific, the song "Rosie the Riveter" filled radio waves across the home front. The "Rosie" image popular during the war was created by illustrator Norman Rockwell for the cover of the Saturday Evening Post on May 29, 1943 — the Memorial Day issue. Mary Doyle Keefe was the model for Norman Rockwell's famous "Rosie the Riveter" painting.

The Rockwell image depicts a muscular woman wearing overalls, goggles and pins of honor on her lapel. She sports a leather wristband and rolled-up sleeves. She sits with a riveting tool in her lap, eating a sandwich, and "Rosie" is inscribed on her lunch pail. And, she's stepping on a copy of Adolph Hitler's book "Mein Kampf!"

The magazine cover exemplified the American can-do spirit and illustrated the notion of women working in previously male-dominated manufacturing jobs, an ever-growing reality while the men fought overseas.

The cover was an enormous success, and soon stories about real-life "Rosies" began appearing in newspapers across the country. The government took advantage of the popularity of Rosie the Riveter and

embarked on a recruiting campaign of the same name, bringing millions of women out of the home and into the workforce. To this day, Rosie the Riveter is still considered the most successful government advertising campaign in history.

Manufacturing giant Westinghouse commissioned artist J. Howard Miller to make a series of posters to promote the war effort. One such poster featured the image of a woman with her hair wrapped up in a red polka-dot scarf, rolling up her sleeve and flexing her bicep with the words "We Can Do It!" printed in a blue caption bubble. To many people today, this image is "the" Rosie the Riveter.



The connection of Miller's image and "Rosie" is a recent phenomenon, mainly due to the reproduction of the image on merchandise and posters.

I discovered two wonderful cookbooks with recipes and oral histories by real-life "Rosie the Riveters." The "Rosie the Riveter Celebration Cookbook" is published by the American Rosie the Riveter Association. It contains photos, biographies and recipes from 56 women around the U.S. who did industrial work during WWII.

The "Rosie the Riveter Cookbook" by Girard and Sam Saggmiller is a loving tribute to their mother, Rachel Saggmiller, and her "can do" work ethic. A WWII version of this recipe for No-Bake Peanut Butter Pudding Bars can be found in the Saggmiller's cookbook. My version makes use of the microwave and a few modern products, but it's still a "can do" no-bake treat!

NO-BAKE PEANUT BUTTER PUDDING BARS

- 1 cup sugar or stevia
- 1 cup light corn syrup or 1/2 cup agave syrup
- 2 cups creamy peanut butter
- 3 cups Rice Krispies
- 3 cups Corn Flakes
- 3/4 cup unsalted butter
- 2 1/2 cups powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 (4-ounce) packages vanilla instant pudding
- 1 cup milk
- 1 (12-oz package) semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter

1. Line a rimmed baking sheet with parchment paper or aluminum foil, and set aside.

2. Using a large glass or microwaveable bowl, combine sugar or stevia, and the corn syrup or agave syrup. Cook on HIGH until bubbling at the edges, about 2-3 minutes, stirring after 1 minute. Alternately, place ingredients in a large pot and cook over medium-high heat on the stove until bubbling, stirring occasionally, until combined.

3. Stir in peanut butter until melted. Add rice and corn cereals until coated. Press mixture into lined baking sheet.

4. Melt 3/4 cup unsalted butter in the microwave on HIGH for about 1 minute. Remove from heat and stir in powdered sugar, vanilla extract, vanilla pudding mix and milk. Spread pudding mixture over the cereal layer in the pan.

5. In a microwaveable bowl, melt chocolate chips and 1/2 cup butter on HIGH for 30-seconds, stir to combine, and continue to microwave for another 15 to 30 seconds, as needed, stirring each time, until melted and creamy. Spread over pudding mixture in pan. Refrigerate for one hour to set. Lift bars out with foil or parchment and cut into squares or triangles.

Moments in time

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

On Sept. 13, 1814, Francis Scott Key pens a poem that is later set to music and in 1931 becomes America's national anthem, "The Star-Spangled Banner." The poem, originally titled "The Defence of Fort McHenry," was written after Key witnessed the Maryland fort being bombarded by the British during the War of 1812.

On Sept. 15, 1858, the new Overland Mail Company sends out its first two stages, inaugurating government mail service to the western U.S. In 1857, Congress had authorized a \$600,000 yearly subsidy for whatever company could transport the mail twice a week from St. Louis to San Francisco in less than 25 days.

On Sept. 17, 1923, a fire threatening the University of California at Berkeley kills two people and destroys nearly 1,000 houses, including half of the fraternity and sorority houses. The National Guard was quickly called in to stop the looting.

On Sept. 16, 1943, James Alan McPherson, the first black man to win a Pulitzer Prize for fiction, is born in Savannah, Georgia. His Pulitzer-winning short story collection, "Elbow Room," was published in 1977.

On Sept. 12, 1953, Sen. John Fitzgerald Kennedy of Massachusetts marries Jacqueline Lee Bouvier, a photographer for the Washington Times-Herald, in Rhode Island. Kennedy was elected the 35th president of the United States seven years later.

On Sept. 14, 1964, writer John Steinbeck is presented the U.S. Medal of Freedom. His first novel, "Tortilla Flat," about the comic antics of several rootless drifters who share a house in California, was published in 1935.

On Sept. 11, 1985, Cincinnati Reds player-manager Pete Rose gets the 4,192nd hit of his career, breaking Ty Cobb's major-league record. Rose retired in 1986, but remained in his position as manager until 1989, when he was banned from baseball for gambling on Reds games.

Vehicle Checklist For Car Pool Season

(NAPSA)—If any of the nearly 56 million children in the country getting ready to go back to school via car pools are yours, you can help make sure all the vehicles involved are kid safe and road ready with a five-point checklist:

- Check lights and wipers for visibility.** With shorter days and inclement weather ahead, make sure lights and wipers function properly so that you can see and be seen. 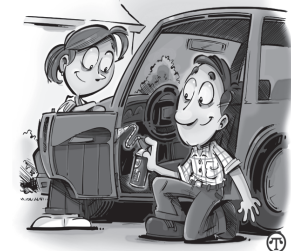

Dos And Don'ts To Help You Keep On Truckin'

(NAPS)—Picture this: You're at the wheel of a real truck, driving down the highway, with everything you own in the back.

That's not just some escapist fantasy. It's a great way to save time and money the next time you move. It can also be a grand adventure. Take the scenic route; fit a little "me time" in along the way. Become a tourist for a few days; experience national landmarks or visit long-lost relatives; let your relocation be a bit of a vacation. If you make your move an adventure, you can arrive at your destination more refreshed and less stressed.

To further reduce stress, follow these dos and don'ts:

Do plan ahead. When planning your trip, take into account the time of day you intend to travel and likely traffic patterns. Always leave lots of extra time and be aware of possible bottlenecks along the way.

Don't pack problems. Most truck rental agreements say something like the language from the U.S. Department of Transportation that prohibits the "carrying or hauling of explosives and other dangerous articles." That means you can't pack paint, chemicals and cleaning materials, flammable solvents, propane, gasoline and the like. Check with your rental agent if you're not sure about a particular item.

Do know about the "NO" zone. Trucks also have big blind spots, what the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration calls the "No-Zone." You should know where these areas are, especially

when changing lanes or coming to a stop.

Don't load the truck until you know how to drive it. Take a practice ride first. Make sure you can find and understand the use of all the truck's switches and gauges. Adjust the seat and side mirrors so they match your height and comfort zone.

Do be extra vigilant. "Trucks are taller, wider and may weigh up to 10 times more than the average car," explained Don Mikes, senior vice president—rental, Penske.

Don't neglect to get insurance. "Most insurance and credit card companies won't cover truck rentals under existing policies," Mikes added. If your insurance company is among them, consider signing up for additional coverage options to protect yourself and your belongings. You may feel more confident knowing that his company offers free 24/7 emergency roadside assistance.

• "Put a family calendar inside your kitchen cabinet to keep everyone on track. You can list important dates/obligations/appointments there. We color code ours by using different highlighters for each person, and we keep it inside the cabinet by the coffee maker, so Mom always looks at it." — W.S. in Ohio

• "If you fill a small spray bottle with alcohol, you can use it to clean your glasses. Use a soft cloth, not a paper towel, as those leave lots of lint behind." — D.P. in Texas

• Combine a few drops of essential oils with a cup of either baking soda or cornstarch. Sprinkle liberally on bare mattresses. Let sit 10-15 minutes, then vacuum up. It's particularly nice to use lavender.

• If you don't regularly clean out your dryer vents, now's the time to put it on your cleaning schedule. Every six months at a minimum, but every three is better. Remove the dryer vent hose and shake out to remove sand or dirt, then run a vent brush to loosen stuck-on lint. Use the wand attachment or a shop vac to clean the dryer itself, and don't forget to wipe down the inside drum with a damp cloth. Don't risk a dryer fire!

• "Need to chop nuts? Place them in a bag, and crush them with a cookie sheet. Just rock back and forth over the sealed bag. This really works, and it's kind of fun, too." — Y.L. in Florida

• Use aluminum foil to line a small metal tray (like the kind that goes in a toaster oven), which can then be used on the grill. If I simmer onions in broth to go with my steak, this works really well because it doesn't burn. The little pans are just the right size! — C.C. in Oregon
