Rabies Positive Fox Found in the Town of Livonia

Livingston County Public Health Director, Jennifer Rodriguez, announced today that the New York State Health Department laboratory has confirmed that a gray fox, killed in the Town of Livonia on September 6, 2017, has tested positive for rabies. The fox was killed after attacking a woman on her property.

Rabies is a deadly viral disease that attacks the central nervous system and is most often seen among wild animals such as bats, raccoons, skunks and foxes, but any mammal can be infected with rabies. Pets and livestock can get rabies if they are not vaccinated to protect them against infection. Reptiles (such as lizards and snakes), amphibians (like frogs), birds, fish and insects do not get or carry rabies.

The first sign of rabies is usually a change in an animal's behavior. It may become excited or irritable and attack anything in its path. Staggering, convulsions, choking, frothing at the mouth, unusual sounds and paralysis may also be seen. Animals usually die within one week after showing symptoms.

People are usually exposed to the rabies virus when an infected animal bites them, or if saliva from a rabid animal enters an open cut or mucous membrane (eyes, nose or mouth). Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director of the Livingston County Department of Health, states, "all potential rabies exposures should be reported to the Livingston County Department of Health as soon as possible". If a human becomes infected, flu like symptoms will appear and progress into delirium, abnormal behavior, hallucinations, and insomnia. Once clinical signs of rabies appear, the disease is nearly always fatal, and treatment is typically supportive. Fortunately, only a few human cases are reported each year in the United States because infection can be prevented if treatment is given immediately after exposure to a rabid animal.

Below are important steps to prevent rabies.

• Stay away from unfamiliar animals, either wild or domestic, even if they appear friendly.

• Thoroughly wash any wound from an animal with soap and water and seek immediate medical attention.

• Avoid wild animals, especially if the animal is showing any sign of rabies.

• Be a responsible pet owner by keeping your pet's vaccinations current. Getting your pets vaccinated can help stop the spread of rabies from wild animals to humans.

Information on bite reporting is available on our website at www.livingstoncounty.com/eh. New York State Law requires that all dogs, cats and ferrets have current rabies vaccinations, beginning at 4 months of age. An unvaccinated pet that comes into contact with a rabid animal must be kept in strict confinement for six months or be euthanized. Free rabies clinics are offered for dogs, cats, and ferrets every year in Livingston County. The next clinic is scheduled for Tuesday September 19, 2017 from 5pm to 7pm at Babcock Park in Dansville.
