NATIONAL CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY WEEK • SEPTEMBER 17-23

"Know for Sure if Your Child is in the Right Car Seat?"

Cornell Cooperative Extension's Traffic Safety Education Program is collaborating with other Livingston County agencies to hold several events promoting National Child Passenger Safety Week. This week includes a Child Passenger Safety Seat Check, a Booster Seat Giveaway, and a Child Passenger Safety Educational Session. Additional safety-related material will be posted on the CCE Livingston County website and Facebook page.

The Booster Seat Giveaway will be held at Wentworth Motors (139 Franklin Street, Dansville) on **September 19th** from 4:30-7:30pm. There is no appointment necessary and a limited number of seats will be available.

A Child Passenger Safety Educational Session will be held on September 20th from 2-4pm at Noyes Memorial Hospital (111 Clara Barton Street, Dansville). Participants will learn the basics of child restraints, NYS Vehicle & Traffic Laws, seat choices, installation of restraints, and more. Information on becoming a certified technician will also be available. Interested parties are asked to RSVP by calling 585-991-5420 | 585-335-1752. All are welcome to attend!

The week-long celebration will come to a close with **National Child Passenger Safety Seat Check Day!** A check will be held on **September 23rd** from 10am-2pm at Noyes Hospital. Certified technicians will be on-hand to provide instruction on how to use car seats, booster seats, and seat belts for children. Furthermore, technicians will help educate consumers about choosing the right car seat for their child, the importance of registering car seats with the manufacturer, and what to expect if the seat is subject to a safety recall. No appointment necessary. A limited number of seats will be available.

According to the National Child Passenger Safety Board and Center for Disease Control, automobile accidents are the leading cause of death in children. One-third of the children who died in automobile accidents in 2011 were not properly restrained. Tragically, the majority of these deaths could have been prevented through the proper use of child seats, booster seats, and seat belts.

However, the good news is that child deaths in automobile accidents have dropped by 43% in the last decade due to national efforts to educate the public on the proper use of child passenger and booster seats. The Livingston County Traffic Safety Education Program, and others like it, continue to educate the public in an effort to further reduce accident rates.

Regardless of the size of the vehicle, the age of the child, or the length of the trip, children should always be properly restrained in a car seat, booster, or seat belt (NHTSA).

While it is recommended that children ride rear facing as long as possible, it is a requirement for children 2 years and younger. A rear-facing child safety seat, with a harness, does a better job of supporting the head, neck, and spine of infants and toddlers in a crash because it distributes the force of the collision over the entire body (AAP, 2011).

There are different types of rear-facing car seats. Infant-only seats can only be used rear-facing. Convertible and 3-in-1 car seats typically have higher height and weight limits for the rear-facing position, allowing the child to be rear-facing for a longer period of time. When the child exceeds the weight and height for the restraint, they may use a forward facing child safety seat with a harness.

When the child reaches at least 4 years old and weighs at least 40 lbs., a booster seat can be used. According to NYS law, all children must be restrained in an appropriate child restraint system (while riding in a motor vehicle) until they reach their 8th birthday or 57" tall.

According to the NYS Department of Health, child booster seat use through age eight has been shown to reduce the risk of injury or death during an automobile accident by 59%.

For a seat belt to fit properly, the lap belt must lie snugly across the upper thighs, not the stomach. The shoulder belt should lie snug across the shoulder and chest and not cross the neck or face. Children under 12 should always buckle up and ride in the back seat.

By following these guidelines, we lessen the risk of injury and fatalities. In 2012, 264 children's lives were saved by correctly used restraint devices (NHSTA, 2013).




