# Preservation of historic homes in Greater Gardner area may become reality

The Greater Gardner neighborhood consists of single-family homes, originally built in the 1920s and 1930s, may be soon designated a conservation area.

San Jose Historic Landmarks Commission met recently to consider nominating the neighborhood for the "conservation" designation. Three neighborhoods make up the Greater Gardner Coalition – Gardner, North Willow Glen and Gregory Plaza.

In the past few years, there has been many improvements in the

Gardner neighborhood, including street and sidewalk repairs, improved lighting in key areas. The Greater Gardner community center has also been built.

For more than 15 years, Gardner residents have tried to get a designation of "historical neighborhood." The neighborhood is bounded by Willow Street, Bird Avenue, and the 280 and 87 freeways.

If the preservation designation is approved, properties in the Garner area will be preserved rather than being remodeled which will provide constancy to the character of the neighborhood.




#### **Beautification past and present**
