WILLIAM TELL NEVER MISS CAKE

Ingredients

- 8 ounces cream cheese, softened
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 large egg

CAKE:

- 1-3/4 cups sugar
- 1 cup canola oil
- 3 large eggs
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 cups chopped peeled tart apples
- 1 cup shredded carrots
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans, toasted

PRALINE ICING:

- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/4 cup butter, cubed
- 2 tablespoons milk
- 1/2 cup confectioners' sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/4 cup chopped pecans, toasted

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. Grease and flour a 10-in, fluted tube pan. In a small bowl, beat cream cheese and sugar until smooth; beat in
- 2. For cake, in a large bowl, beat sugar, oil and eggs until well blended. In another bowl, whisk flour, baking powder, cinnamon, salt and baking soda; gradually beat into sugar mixture. Stir in apples, carrots and pecans.
- 3. Transfer half of the batter to prepared pan; layer with cream cheese mixture, then remaining batter. Bake 50-60 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in cake portion comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes before removing to a wire rack to cool completely.
- **4. For icing,** in a large saucepan, combine brown sugar, butter and milk; bring to a boil. Cook and stir 1 minute. Remove from heat; whisk in confectioners' sugar and vanilla until smooth. Drizzle over cake. Sprinkle with pecans. Yield: 12 servings.

ALL-DAY APPLE BUTTER

Ingredients

- 5-1/2 pounds apples, peeled and finely chopped
- 4 cups sugar







- 2 to 3 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

Directions

- 1. Place apples in a 3-gt. slow cooker. Combine sugar, cinnamon, cloves and salt; pour over apples and mix well. Cover and cook on high for 1 hour.
- 2. Reduce heat to low; cover and cook for 9-11 hours or until thickened and dark brown, stirring occasionally (stir more frequently as it thickens to prevent sticking).
- 3. Uncover and cook on low 1 hour longer. If desired, stir with a wire whisk until smooth. Spoon into freezer containers, leaving 1/2-in. headspace. Cover and refrigerate or freeze. Yield: 4 pints.

CINNAMON APPLES

Ingredients

- 2 cups water
- 3/4 cup red-hot candies
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 6 medium tart apples, peeled and quartered

Directions

1. In a large saucepan, bring the water, candies and sugar to a boil over medium heat; boil and stir until candies and

sugar are dissolved.

2. Reduce heat; carefully add apples. Cook, uncovered, until apples are tender. Cool slightly.



APPLES

With a slotted spoon, transfer apples to a serving dish; pour sugar syrup over apples. Cool slightly. Cover and refrigerate for at least 3 hours. Yield: 6 servings.

CARAMEL APPLES CHEESECAKE

Ingredients

- 1-1/2 cups cinnamon graham cracker crumbs (about 8 whole crackers)
- 3/4 cup sugar, divided
- 1/4 cup butter, melted
- 1 package (14 ounces) caramels
- 2/3 cup evaporated milk
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans, divided
- 2 packages (8 ounces each) cream cheese, softened
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour, divided
- 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1-1/2 cups chopped peeled apples
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Directions

- 1. Place a greased 9-in. springform pan on a double thickness of heavy-duty foil (about 18 in. square). Securely wrap foil around pan.
- 2. In a small bowl, combine the cracker crumbs, 1/4 cup sugar and butter. Press onto the bottom and 1 in. up the sides of prepared pan. Place on a baking sheet. Bake at 350° for 10 minutes or until lightly browned. Cool on a wire rack.
- 3. In a heavy saucepan over medium-low heat, cook and stir caramels and milk until melted and smooth. Pour 1 cup over crust; sprinkle

- with 1/4 cup pecans. Set remaining caramel mixture aside.
- **4.** In a large bowl, beat the cream cheese, 1 tablespoon flour and remaining sugar until smooth. Add eggs; beat on low speed just until combined. Combine the apples, cinnamon and remaining flour; fold into cream cheese mixture. Pour into crust.
- **5.** Place springform pan in a large baking pan; add 1 in. of hot water to larger pan. Bake for 40 minutes. Reheat reserved caramel mixture if necessary; gently spoon over cheesecake. Sprinkle with remaining pecans.
- **6.** Bake 10-15 minutes longer or until center is just set. Remove pan from water bath. Cool on a wire rack for 10 minutes. Carefully run a knife around edge of pan to loosen; cool 1 hour longer. Refrigerate overnight. Remove sides of pan. Yield: 12 servings.

APPLE TOPPED CAKE

Ingredients

- 3 tablespoons butter, softened
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1 large egg
- 1 large egg white
- 1 cup vanilla yogurt
- 1/3 cup unsweetened applesauce
- 2 tablespoons canola oil
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1-1/2 cups chopped peeled apples
- 2 tablespoons chopped walnuts
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/8 teaspoon ground allspice

Directions

- 1. In a large bowl, beat butter and sugar until crumbly, about 2 minutes. Add the egg, egg white, yogurt, applesauce, oil and vanilla; beat until smooth. Combine the dry ingredients; add to butter mixture, beating just until moistened.
- 2. Pour into a 9-in. springform pan coated with cooking spray. Sprinkle with apples and walnuts. Combine the brown sugar, cinnamon and allspice; sprinkle over top.
- 3. Bake at 375° for 47-52 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool on a wire rack. Run a knife around edge of pan to loosen. Remove sides of pan. Refrigerate leftovers. Yield: 10 servings.

Place the contents of your wallet on a photocopy machine. Do both sides of each license, credit card, etc., so you will know what you had in your wallet and all of the account numbers and phone numbers to call to cancel. Keep the photocopy in a safe place. We've all heard horror stories about fraud that's committed using your name, address, SS#, credit, etc. To limit the damage in case this happens to you or someone you know. As everyone always advises, cancel your credit cards immediately, but the key is having the toll free numbers and your card numbers handy so you know whom to call. Keep those where you can find them easily. File a police report immediately in the jurisdiction where it was stolen, this proves to credit providers you were diligent, and is a first step toward an investigation (if there ever is one). But here's what is perhaps most important: (I never ever thought to do this) - Call the three national credit reporting organizations immediately to place a fraud alert on your name and SS#. The alert means any company that checks your credit knows your information was stolen and they have to contact you by phone to authorize new credit. The numbers are: Social Security Administration (fraud



As of this writing, Hurricane Irma has anointed with luscious rain the dry landscape in the Claybank Master Gardener areas. It was a happy 3-4", deeply watering the trees, shrubs and gardens already dried out after Hurricane Harvey's 7" of rain two weeks before. Ah the joys of gardening in the Wiregrass!

If you are not too burned out after the trials of this summer's heat and humidity, and still think about planting for the fall, here are a few suggestions:


*save the root ends of your green veggies and plant them in a pot or in your garden. You can start them in a small jar with just the bottom part covered in water. Boston

and Bibb lettuce, romaine, celery, leeks, green onions, carrots are a few of the winter loving veggies that will give you free salad fixings.

*according to the free mobile phone app SOW (pronounce like "sew"), from the AL Extension Service, now you can plant carrots, collards, kale, mustard, radishes and turnips. The app also gives links from various extension services to more information on how to grow veggies in our 8A planting zone.

*the extension service recommends at least once or every two years that you get a soil test done by the Auburn University Soil Testing Lab at AU. Bring about a pint mix of soil samples from your garden to the Extension Office in your county. Bring your garden or field sample in a quart zip type bag, fill out the form provided by the extension service, and they'll send it up to AU for only \$7. If you took the Master Gardner class,

the first sample test is free. Looking for homegrown and fair-priced plants for your fall garden? The Claybank Master Gardeners and the Ozark-Dale County Library will be holding a joint plant sale and book sale on Saturday October 14th in front of the library at 416 James Street in Ozark.


