

DIFFERENT KINDS **OF BUCKS**

We've been doing the deal since 1932!

Deer season, with the bow, starts the first of October; what kind of buck will you be looking for?

into three classes. The kind of buck we all would like to get is in the first class, the trophy deer. Actually there are two types of animals in this class.

The first type is the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ year old buck. He has survived a few hunting seasons and has wised up to the ways of the deer hunter. He probably has 8 or more points on his antlers and though not fully mature he is considered a trophy to many.

The second type in this class has reached an age of 4 ½ years and up. These bucks are truly mature animals and their antlers also carry 8 or more points but they are much thicker, have a wider spread between antlers and the points are generally longer. Their bodies have also reached their basic potential. They are the REAL trophy bucks!

These mature bucks did not survive to this age by being stupid. They have probably had a number of bad experiences with deer hunters in their earlier years and learned not to make those mistakes again. Their eyes, ears and noses are fine-tuned to the dangers of hunters and enable them to avoid trouble.

In the second class of bucks we find the yearlings. These young fellows are "teenagers" who have made it to their second fall. They are 1 1/2 years old and sport small antlers that have two spikes, four points or six points. In some cases, with good genes and food, they may have small 8-point racks.

This group of bucks are not too "bright" yet and make a lot of mistakes, which is why they may consist of 70 to 80 percent of the total buck kill each year. They also travel a great deal looking for a "territory" in the fall to establish as their own and thus make up a high percent of the road kills.

There's a third class of "bucks," but not really bucks. These little guys are actually the current year's fawns. They don't have spots anymore and they are slightly smaller than the other deer. When a hunter shoots one he calls it a "button buck" because he has two small knobs on his head where his antlers will grow from the next year when he is a yearling.

This little guy travels with his mother and maybe a sister and when the group runs into a hunter it is usually the "button buck" that gets shot because he is curious and hangs around too long. He is not full grown yet but sometimes appears to be. Good deer hunters try to avoid shooting these little guys but it takes restrain to do so because they are not easy to tell from a doe fawn. About the only way to do this is by close observation with optics when they are close and standing. If a good hunter can't be sure he doesn't shoot. It is too bad more hunters don't make the effort before shooting because these little guys are our future bucks and they may be the ones with the good genes for growing those trophy racks that we all would like to see or get. In recent years the NYS DEC has been pushing for hunters to let smaller bucks pass to enable them to grow bigger. In some states, such as Pennsylvania, hunters are required by law to only shoot bucks with three and in some cases four points on one side of the rack. I have mixed feelings about this being mandatory as it still allows a young buck, that has real potential to be come a trophy (a 1 1/2 year old that is an 8-point), to be taken. Also many hunters, especially beginners, would just like to get any kind of buck and this law prevents that.

FINAL PHASE OF CAPITAL PROJECT NEARS COMPLETION AT HOLLEY CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

Holley students are reaping the benefits as final touches are being made to the campus during the last phase of the Capital Project this fall. The elementary playground was redone and a new Pre-K playground added to the Elementary School (ES) campus. Students will enjoy using brand-new equipment on both playgrounds this fall. New tennis courts were installed at the Middle School/High School (MS/HS) while the existing courts were repurposed as tennis, pickleball and basketball courts. This transformation adds outdoor physical education stations for students. When school is not in session, all of these areas are available for community use.

A new bus loop was created in front of the ES, near the District Office entrance, to separate car traffic from school bus traffic. This helps keep students safe as they get on and off the bus at this entrance.

Structural changes have been made to both schools, too. Heating, ventilating and air conditioning (HVAC) units were replaced in both buildings. The ES also had windows and doors replaced. The new windows allow

more light into classrooms. These upgrades allow the district to use their energy more efficiently and save money on utility costs.

By the end of this project, over \$30 million of improvements will have been made to the district facilities, at zero impact to taxpayers. "The entire project has provided the district with one of the finest facilities in western New York," said District Superintendent Robert D'Angelo. "I'm pleased to be able to bring these benefits to our students and community. Our long-term goal for the campus is to maintain it as a state-of-the-art school facility and learning environment. We thank the community for their patience and continued support of this project as we've completed each phase."





LOST STREAM MAP

The STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW YORK resembles another map-known to Pennsylvania anglers as the "Lost Stream Map."

It was completed in 1965 after a 30 year effort by Howard Higbee,


a former Penn State Professor. Professor Higbee painstakingly plotted by hand, the location of 45,000 miles of streams onto the map. It sold extremely well - until the printer declared bankruptcy and hauled Higbee's work to the landfill.

But reprints were impossible because the maps were printed in non-photographic blue. Higbee was even offered \$400 for one of his last maps. And state agencies were forced to keep their copies under lock and key.

Then, at the age of 91, Howard









Signs of a Stroke

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

- 1) Ask the person to SMILE.
- 2) Ask the person to TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE. i.e. It is sunny out today.
- 3) Ask the person to RAISE BOTH ARMS.
- 4) Ask the person to STICK OUT HIS TONGUE. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

- Sudden confusion, trouble speaking or understanding

How to Get a Handle on Work-Related Stress

Work-related stress is an all too common problem in workplaces across the globe. According to the American Institute of Stress, 80 percent of workers report feeling stress on the job. Perhaps most troubling, nearly half of those people admit they need help in learning how to manage their stress.


