the world - just as Helen

Keller did.

Keller overcame losing her vision and hearing as a toddler to become an author, lecturer, advocate for the disabled and inspiration to people around the world. During Camp Courage, the students learn about Keller and how she helped change the world.

Shoals students attending the camp included Karli Dickerson of Colbert Heights, Talitha Ellis of Muscle Shoals and Emori Hardin and Julie Anna Shirley of Tuscumbia.

The campers watched scenes from *The Miracle Worker* play, toured Ivy Green, created crafts, participated in self-esteem and team building activities, went fishing on Pickwick Lake, and toured Cypress Cove Farm in Red Bay. There were also activities for their parents.

for their parents.

Sue Pilkilton is executive director of the Helen Keller Birthplace in Tuscumbia and an organizer of Camp Courage. She said, "It's heartwarming to see how the children interact and help one another. The children start bonding as soon as they get here. The vision-impaired children will form bonds with the hearing-impaired and begin helping them, and the hearing-impaired children will start helping the vision-impaired. They do this on their own. We don't pair them up that way."

Pilkilton said the campers

form lifelong friendships. This is the fifth year for Camp Courage, a Helen Keller Experience. Many of the campers from previous years remain close friends with people they met at the camp.

There is no charge to the campers or their families who attend Camp Courage. Generous donations from sponsors make the camp possible.

Student teachers from the University of North Alabama serve as counselors for the camp. They are supervised by a team of Helen Keller Fellows who are highly-qualified teachers of the deaf-blind. The camp is very intense, but the smiles and laughter of the children are non-stop. Sometimes it's hard to tell who is having more fun, the campers or the staff.

The concept for Camp Courage originated with state Rep. Johnny Mack Morrow of Red Bay.

Morrow said almost every time he visits Ivy Green he meets parents of a child that is visually or hearing impaired. "I ask them why they brought their child to Ivy Green. They always say, 'There's magic here. This is where the miracle took place'."

Morrow said Camp Courage preserves the legacy of Helen Keller and the miracle that occurred at Ivy Green when she first communicated with her teacher Anne Sullivan. "I think Helen Keller would be proud of what we are doing with her legacy."

Some people make the decision to carry liability insurance only. That insurance is required by law to obtain a tag

and registration for an automobile. Liability insurance only protects another drive for injuries and property damage and then only when you are at fault. Liability coverage accomplishes the goal of protecting the other party to some degree but does nothing to pay your medical bills, lost wages, pain and suffering or repair your car.

All too often we see people declining uninsured motorist coverage usually designated by the insurance company as "UM coverage". This coverage is mandated to be offered as a matter of law and must be declined in writing. Occasionally we find a person who may not have bought UM coverage but didn't decline it in writing and we can make the insurance company provide the coverage. Usually insurance companies are pretty good about having the person sign

a waiver of UM and in those cases there is no coverage when an uninsured motorist causes you to be injured.

Uninsured motorist coverage is some of the least expensive and best coverage anyone can have. Always uninsured motorist coverage as part of your automobile insurance.

In your case, we would want to see a signed document where you declined uninsured motorist coverage but the practical reality of your case is that if the car was stolen, people who steal cars don't have the money to pay to repair yours. If the owner of the car was the driver and fled the scene due to alcohol or drugs, you would want to see the police report where the car was reported stolen and an insurance claim on the theft if the car was insured.

In this case, after the police report is reviewed and your automobile insurance coverage is checked to make sure that you absolutely declined uninsured motorist coverage in writing, there is really nothing else to be done. Don't let your car sit at the tow yard and accrue daily charges. If it is totaled, sell it for scrap and move on. Certainly, there are situations where choosing liability coverage only is necessitated by economics but it certainly, as you now know, can be a costly decision.

When my brother Greg and I were in Junior High we raised several varieties of bantam chickens. I remember we had an incubator to hatch off eggs we had purchased from other bantam enthusiasts. Once we placed the eggs

in the incubator we had to watch the temperature, roll the eggs once a day and I can remember we added water to a tray in the center to keep the air moist. There was a little glass window on top and we would peer in it to watch for any sign of hatching activity. It was a long 21 days until the eggs would hatch.

Our first experience with the incubator was my most memorable. We awoke one morning to see that most of the eggs had hatched. Only one chick remained still fighting to get out of its shell. Greg and I were so excited that we decided to help it. I remember how carefully we peeled back the shell to free the chick. boy, were we proud. However, instead of helping it, we hurt it. The poor chick had no strength in its legs. Later that day, while all the other chicks were running around, the chick we helped was unable to stand. It just sat there spraddled out as if it was doing the splits. The chick soon died.

It wasn't long before we learned that opening that egg was the worst thing we could have done. You see the struggle to free itself from the shell was the way in which the chick gained the strength and stamina needed to survive. To rob the chick of this period of

its life was to cheat it out

Can you see the life lesson in this story? We live in a world where everyone is trying to avoid the struggles that make them stronger. I often hear older adults talk about the value

of the chores they did as children. They praise the work ethic of their generation. Yet I see many parents and grandparents trying to shield their children and grandchildren from these strength building – maybe even character building - tasks. A generation of

Did I just diagnose some of what is wrong with the world? We live in a world where everyone wears their feelings and offenses on their sleeve. They don't understand that life is full of adjustments. There is strength in struggle.







HELP PARENTS OR PAY STUDENT LOANS?

Dear Dave,

I graduated from college two years ago, and I have a good job making \$60,000. I have about \$10,000 in student loan debt, but my mom and dad have a real issue with their roof. It's leaking in places to the point they have to set buckets around to catch the water, and I've gotten repair estimates of \$3,000 to \$5,000. They're good, hard-working, blue collar folks, but they're less fortunate financially and have more debt than I do. What should I do first — help them fix the roof or pay off my student loan débt?

Dear Jordan,

You've got a great spirit, man. If I woke up in your shoes, I'd probably help them fix the roof first. The only way I would do that, though, is if they agree to let you help them address the reasons they don't have any money. If you have the cash, go ahead and pay for the roof. But let them know they must pay you back by getting some financial counseling.

I know you love your mom and dad, and they work too hard to be broke. We're not talking about you shaming or condemning them in any way. Talk to them in a loving, caring way, but you have to address the situation. If they've worked all their lives and can't come up with \$3,000, something's wrong. The fact they don't have any money is the symptom. The problém is they've mishandled the dollars they earned. Even if you don't make a lot, you can have cash set aside for emergencies if you manage it well.

You're a young guy making good money, so there's no reason you can't do both folks with the roof, then turn student loan debt. It won't sey.

be a huge burden to you. But remember, you fixing their lives without them fixing their lives will be a burden – to all of you!

We're debt-free except for our house. I've been talking to a friend about how much money to allow for fun in your budget. The other day we bought a \$100 bottle of wine, and she thought that was unreasonable. What's your opinion? Beth

Dear Beth,

Something like that depends entirely on your overall financial situation. Buying a \$100 bottle of wine is pretty stupid if you only make \$20,000 a year. It's not unreasonable, though, if you make \$200,000 a year. Having a great income-to-asset ratio and living debt-free gives you the opportunity to relax and enjoy a few things.

You've got to take the whole picture into account. I know a guy who makes well over \$15 million a year, and he bought a \$200,000 car. As a ratio, that's a very small percentage of his income. So, it's kind of silly to say an item is too expensive, or an irresponsible purchase, based on price alone.



ON YOUR DEBT

Who is Eligible for Social Security Benefits?

In this article I thought I would discuss generally who is eligible for Social Security retirement and work-related disability benefits. There are other forms of Social Security benefits out there by way of the Social Security Act and its subsequent amendments. Today, I'll focus on just these two types, which are codified in "42 USC Ch. 7: Social Security" for those interested in specific details.

Currently, there are about 170 million people out of a total population of roughly 320 million in the United States that qualify for one program or the other. According to Social Security, of the adults drawing some sort of Social Security benefit. If a non-disabled individual has paid enough into the system to be eligible to draw retirement, he or she may file for it when they reach the age of 62. For what it's worth, the longer an individual can hold out in applying for it – up to the age of 70 – the more he or she will be able to draw each month. This is an important point because, as of 2015, some 62% of these individuals counted on their Social Security retirement for more than half their income.

To qualify for retirement benefits, with some jobrelated exceptions, one must have earned sufficient quarterly net income for at least ten years over their lifetime, which equates to 40 total quarterly credits. Citizenship is not a requirement under certain circumstances. Currently, individuals earn a quarterly credit for \$1300 in net income for each three-month time period.

For work-related disability benefits, with some age-related exceptions, the claimant must have made sufficient quarterly net income 20 of the past 40 quarters to qualify. As there is a hard time limit on eligibility for these sort of benefits, filing a timely work-related disability claim is of the utmost importance. If a person waits too long to apply, the claimant is out of luck no matter how much they've paid into the system over their lifetime. In 2016, the average age of these individuals drawing work-related disability benefits was about 54.



Medicare Minute

"Frequently Asked Questions 5"

Some of the most frequently asked questions we get from people under the age of 65 concerns the relationship between the Marketplace (Obamacare) and Medicare. There seems to be a great deal of confusion about how these two insurance programs work. Here are this week's questions:

Will my Marketplace insurance end automatically when I become eligible at age 65 for Medicare? The short answer to this question is "no". You must go to healthcare.gov or contact your Marketplace insurance carrier to cancel your plan.

Can I keep my Marketplace plan after I become eligible for Medicare? Yes, you can keep your Marketplace plan after becoming eligible for Medicare. This will not, however, exempt you from enrolling into Medicare Part A and Part B during your initial enrollment period. If you delay your enrollment into Part B, or Part A if you must pay a premium for it, you may be assessed a late enrollment penalty if you decide to sign up after the initial enrollment period.

I am receiving a tax credit to help pay for my Marketplace plan. Will I continue to receive this tax credit once I become Medicare eligible? This is a tricky one. Once your Medicare Part A coverage starts, you won't be eligible for a premium tax credit for a Marketplace plan. If you kept your Marketplace plan, you'd have to pay full price.

Can you give me an example of losing my tax credit? Let's say you are on a Marketplace plan that has a premium of \$1,100 per month. You have a tax credit of \$1,000 per month which means you would pay a monthly premium of \$100 per month for your plan. Once your Medicare Part A begins the \$1,000 tax credit goes away and you would have to pay the full premium of \$1,100 per month.



Did you hear about the young couple, George and Sally, sitting out on the front porch swing? George was a man of few words, but Sally... well, she had no trouble saying what was on her mind. On this particular night Sally asked romantically, "George, do you think I have beautiful eyes?" After a little pause George responded, "Yep." A few moments later Sally asked, "George, do you like my hair the way I fix it?" Another pause occurred and George answered,

"Yep." Sally then inquired, "George, do you think I have a nice, attractive figure?" Again in a slow and deliberate matter George replied, "Yep." At that, Sally grabbed George around the neck, kissed him on the cheek and excitedly declared, "George, you say the

It seems that Sally was happy to get whatever response she could, but clueless George could do a little better, don't you think? We can laugh at a little anecdote like this, but in real life it is truly not funny. I remember counseling with a wife some years ago who was troubled by the fact that her husband would never tell her that he loved her. Improvements

How do you increase the value of your property? The biggest factor outside of a homeowner's control is market conditions. But other issues including the condition of the property, specific home improvements and neighborhood stability and safety -- can influence property values.

Specific home improvements can increase the value of a home. Some of the improvements can actually increase the value of the home above the cost of the improvements. According to Remodeling magazine, which publishes an annual "Cost vs. Value" remodeling report, a remodeled bathroom returns 81 percent to the owner, a bathroom addition, 89 percent and a master bedroom suite, 82 percent.

Remember, quality pays. Well-planned and well-executed remodeling jobs are a good investment while bad work seldom enhances value or livability.

Kitchens and bathrooms still sell homes today. Buyers love nice kitchens and glamour bathrooms with those big nice tile showers.

Stability and safety can also affect property value. If you live in a high-crime area, an organized community watch program not only will lower the crime rate but also have been known to enhance property values.

What kind of return is there on remodeling jobs? Most recently, the highest remodeling paybacks have come from updating kitchens and baths, homeoffice additions and extra amenities in older homes. While home offices are a relatively new remodeling trend, for example, you could expect to recoup 58 percent of the cost of adding a home office,

according to the survey. What about a pool?

I've been asked several times about the value that a pool will add to a property. This is not as simple to answer as it depends on several factors that you might not think of right away. For example, how many pools are there in your neighborhood? Let's say that you live in a neighborhood where the homes are relatively similar, the average home value is 100,000., and you spend \$25,000 installing a new swimming pool. If you have the only pool in the neighborhood it will not be worth as much as if there are other comparable homes with a pool. It could mean the difference in recouping 30-50 of your investment vs. 60-70%. Price range of the neighborhood would be another major factor.

Determining what types of improvements to make to your home vs. the value it will add can be difficult. Before starting an overhaul of your home, talk to a REALTOR or an Appraiser about what your home will be worth with the improvements you want to make. - mr



Ann Cooper, Sarah Damsgard Haggstrom, Anne Norvell, Jane Frith, Glenda Lovelace, Carol Howdyshell, Jackie Zickler, and Prudy Thomas who will greet visitors at the October opening. More than 50 hooked pieces will be on display at the museum. Subject matter includes early American life, botanicals, geometric patterns, some sculptural work.

Artist Anne Norvell said rug hooking began as a craft of necessity.

"It is an art that has been around for a very long time," she said. "Rug hooking has a rich history. It was originally utilitarian as the rugs made both floors and beds warmer in New England homes. During the Victorian era, rug hooking became a fine craft people made for enjoyment, not just something to serve a purpose."

In the 1850's burlap was introduced in the U.S., providing a material readily available. Many rugs from that era are backed with burlap. Today many artists use linen, although burlap is still used occasionally. Other components such as wool, sari silk, and yarn are used for the main body of the rug.

Patterns are the basis of rug hooking. The pattern of one piece included in the exhibition was designed by Edward Sands Frost — a notable early pattern creator whose work has been exhibited in museums across the nation. Another piece was adapted from artwork by Shoals artist Martha Beadle and Southern visionary artist Chris Clark.

Tennéssee Valley Art Association assistant director Kathryn Balch said while rug hooking has its roots in early American history, the art form is very much alive in the South.

Being able to exhibit the works of twelve local fiber artists is a testament to the relevance of fiber art today. Fiber & Folk focuses on the art of rug hooking in its many forms and on the artists who continue this American tradition of sharing their stories through wool.'






