Pill Swallowing Tips

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a retired engineer, and find that people solving problems. I find that people have difficulty swallowing medications because swallowing a gulp of water is an unnatural act when compared with everyday unnoticed swallowing, and that people are taking too small a sip of water, so they feel the pills, which can trigger a gag reflex.

The solution is to swallow a large sip of water without pills to prepare the mind and body for the relatively rare swallowing process that will follow. Then, take a large sip of water and swallow with pills. —R.E.

ANSWER: As someone who has studied physics, if not engineering, the small sip of water lubricates the esophagus, so pills are less likely to be stuck. I have always recommended a small sip followed by a large gulp, for a different reason from yours. As far as specific positions, some people seem to do better with chin up, others with chin down. Taking a pill with some food or applesauce (or something of similar texture) helps many people. Practicing with something (a breath mint or M&M) can help you find what works best for you. Tepid or even warm water helps some.

DEAR DR. ROACH: A dear friend has been diagnosed with spinal stenosis. She's 85. She tried a cortisone shot, with very short-lived relief, and physical therapy, to no avail. She's been prescribed pain pills, which cause her to sleep more than you'd expect for her age. Her doc-

tor seems to be out of options. I read about laser treatment for this area. Do you think this might help, or do you have other ideas? —M.R.

ANSWER: "Spinal stenosis" is the term we use to describe compression of the spinal cord or nerve roots by bony structures in the spine. This may be a result of arthritis, skeletal disease and many other conditions. One common finding is difficulty after walking, causing someone to want to sit or lie down. I often see people with spinal stenosis who lean over while walking, as though they are walking into a stiff wind. Many sufferers can walk for prolonged periods with a shopping cart, because the leaning-over position relieves the pressure on the nerves.

Surgery for spinal stenosis can be challenging, and in an 85-year-old, the risk of complications is higher. However, given her symptoms and lack of response to nonsurgical therapy, consulting with a surgeon may be appropriate. There may still be additional medical therapies she hasn't tried before doing so.

I am not a surgeon, and only a surgeon can appropriately choose the tools for a given surgery. However, having looked over the research in this area, there is no evidence that laser offers any advantage over traditional surgery.

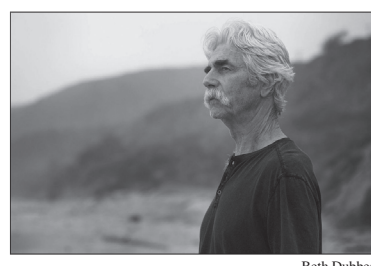

As is often the case, a shocking cancer diagnosis blows away the haze surrounding him, and he begins a sober search not for the glory days but for some kind of legacy — be it reconnecting with his estranged daughter Lucy (Krysten Ritter), attempting to find love in an unlikely place (Laura Prepon) or looking for that last great gig.

Certain Women (R) — Director Kelly Reichardt brings to the screen three female-centered vignettes based on the short stories of Maile Meloy. Earnest and understated, the film's central characters have a uniquely imperfect way of facing the sometimes hardscrabble road of the American woman, mirrored by the landscapes in which they develop, a cold backdrop of Montana. Laura Dern plays a lawyer

whose client develops boundary issues from the impotence of his situation, which sets her up to be his personal confessional and hostage negotiator. Michelle Williams, bemoaning the burdens of being the family boss, faces sexism and obstruction while building her dream home. Kristen Stewart is a young, impoverished lawyer whose lessons in educational law intrigue a lonely ranch hand with whom she forms a tenuous relationship.

The Devil's Candy (NR) — Director Sean Byrne revisits the hauntingly familiar theme of Satanic ritual killing with a twist — this voice implores its killer to target children, as they are

Garden-Fresh Spanish Rice

September is National Rice Month. Whether you enjoy long-grain rice or one of the many wild rice blends, rice is a nice change of pace in your daily diet.

2 1/2 cups peeled and chopped tomatoes
1/2 cup chopped green bell pepper
1/2 cup chopped onion
1 cup finely chopped cabbage
1 tablespoon Brown Sugar
Twin
1/8 teaspoon black pepper
2 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley or 2 teaspoons dried parsley flakes
2 cups cooked rice

1. In a large skillet sprayed with butter-flavored cooking spray, saute tomatoes, green pepper, onion and cabbage for 10 minutes, stirring often. Stir in Brown Sugar Twin, black pepper and parsley. Add rice. Mix well to combine.
2. Lower heat and simmer for 5 minutes, stirring occasionally. Makes 4 (3/4 cup) servings.

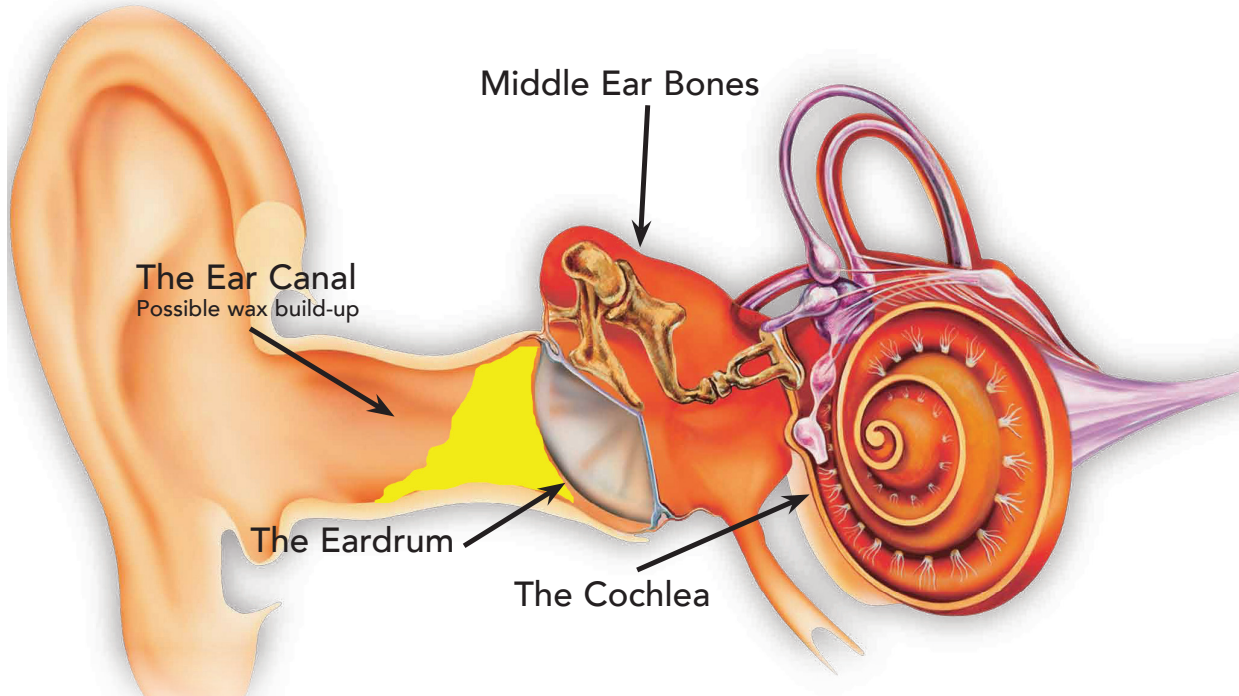

Five Handy Pointers On Painting Your Home

(NAPSA)—A fresh coat of paint can be one of the easiest and most inexpensive ways to update a home's decor and value. With the right tools and tips, even first-time painters can learn to paint like a pro.

Prep the Area
 Remove furniture, wall hangings, and light switch and outlet covers. Protect floors from drips and spills with canvas sheeting. Apply painter's tape along trim, molding and windows. Use a putty knife to ensure that tape is securely adhered around edges.

Clean Slate
 For a truly professional look, start with a smooth, clean surface. Fill in nail holes and cracks with Spackle. Remove dust, dirt, grease, and glossy finishes with a nontoxic, trisodium phosphate (TSP) substitute such as Mötensböcker's Lift Off All Surface Paint Prep. The Right Tools

Consider Siding That Better Protects A Home From Weather

(NAPSA)—Your home is probably the biggest monetary investment you'll ever make, so it's a good idea to carefully discuss your home's siding choices with your home builder or remodeler.

- **Impact:** Fiber cement siding resists impact from objects blown

by a storm's high winds much better than vinyl siding.

- **Flood:** Fiber cement siding is a Class 5 flood-resistant material according to the Federal Emergency Management Agency. This differs from wood-based siding, which is not moisture resistant and prone to rotting.

Certain types of fiber cement siding go even further to protect your home. For example, James Hardie siding is engineered for the home's specific climate. That means for homes in cooler, wetter areas, proprietary additives are included in the formulation to decrease the water absorption rate and protect it from wet or freezing conditions. For those in hotter, dryer places, the formulation is tailored to protect the house from wind and dry heat.

The Garden Bug Succulents

Succulents prefer the bright light of a south-facing window, but the leaves will turn brown or white if the light is too intense. Ideal temperatures would be from 70-85° F during the day to as low as 50-55° F at night. Water regularly but lightly, as keeping the roots soaking wet will kill the plant. Succulents should be potted in a fast-draining soil mixture that's designed for cacti; or make your own, using regular potting soil mixed with perlite to increase aeration and drainage.
