Fast forward to 2010. In the midst of fulfilling a childhood dream, Bill developed throat cancer. It was devastating for Bill who was a popular and prolific radio broadcaster in a career spanning over 35 years. He worked for WVNA, STAR 94, WQLT, WZYP, WDRM, and WAAY in Alabama most of his broadcasting career. Bill also worked briefly for St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital where he did telethons and radiothons and taught volunteers about the research done at St Jude's. However, he returned to Alabama radio soon after.

Bill dreamed of one day helping every person in his small community of Fullerville, GA. It was a town made up of hardworking people who raised their families the best they could and expected their children to follow in their footsteps and work there too. However, Bill had his sights on bigger endeavors. His career took off after his start in broadcasting at our local college, where he learned the ways of radio.

Bill worked for some of the best radio stations across the South.

In the midst of his wonderful career and undergoing treatments for throat cancer, Bill formed a small, but loyal committee to pursue his personal promise of helping every man, woman and child in his small community. With fundraisers. donations. and special events, Bill able to bring was entire community into the twentieth century. In addition, his committee restored the old one room jail in the heart of Fullerville, where it was in an almost irreparable state. Funds were used to provide much needed plumbing to the entire community of Fullerville and Bill had sidewalks constructed along the streets of the city. To top it off, Bill, along with help from the mayor of Villa Rica, received a large grant to build and complete trails that will eventually connect to the network of other trails in the west Georgia and beyond.

Bill did all this while

fighting cancer and doing the best he could for his family. Today, Bill is cancer free after many months of taking the Jimmy Carter Immunotherapy from the University of Alabama. Is there any question why he was honored as Grand Marshall of his city's parade? And I had the privilege of being his chauffeur. Yes, I am very proud of my friend and wish him the best for the rest of his life.

And Bill, I forgive you for pulling my hair! I knew it was you all along!



Firemen, Police Officers & Teachers Who **Worry About Being Sued**

My wife, Lauren, is a teacher. Occasionally things will happen and she will ask me if someone could be sued.

She worries that she has some liability as a teacher. I reassure her that absent some intentional act by a state employee that state employees are protected by law. The short story is that when

kings allowed courts to decide disputes they did not allow themselves to be sued. This is known as sovereign immunity and the principles are applied by our court systems to this very day. As recently as September 23, 2017, the Alabama Supreme Court released a case holding (stating the law) that an employee of the state could not be sued if they were acting in the performance of their job as it was intended to be done.

If a fire truck is going to a fire with lights and siren and they are doing those things that they are supposed to do within the rules and regulations made for them, then they enjoy state immunity.

If on the other hand they are riding around in a fire truck and decide to stop at the grocery store and continue on non-emergency business and cause a wreck then state immunity does not apply. They are not acting as firemen are intended to act. A police officer on ordinary patrol with no emergency can't run stop signs for fun. If they do and they hurt someone they are just as responsible as anyone else. At some point, it isn't fair that some people are immune from the harm they cause but at the end of the day, we the people would have to pay for harm caused.



Medicare Minute

"Medicare Pre-AEP"

Each year anyone who is on Medicare and enrolled in a Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) or Prescription Drug Plan (PDP) has an open enrollment period to make changes in their plan if they wish. This open enrollment period is called the Annual Election Period (AEP). It extends from October 15th to December 7th. There is also a period from October 1st to October 14th that is commonly called Pre-AEP.

Pre-AEP is an important time for Medicare beneficiaries. Insurance companies who offer MAs or PDPs cannot release their plan information for 2018 until October 1st. You can use this time to review your current plan to see if there has been any significant changes in your premium or copays. It's also a good time to review the prescription drug coverage of your plan, especially if you have had changes in the drugs you are taking. If any new plans are coming into your county, this is the time they are announced so be on the lookout for those.

Pre-AEP can also be a confusing time. Although it's designed for you to gather information on any changes that are coming for 2018, you may get phone calls or letters from insurance companies or your local agent. Local agents, in particular, like to use Pre-AEP to reach out to their clients and do policy reviews for the next year. This is totally acceptable under Medicare rules. It is also acceptable for you to attend a meeting or seminar during Pre-AEP to hear the details of 2018 plans. The one thing you cannot do is officially sign up for a new plan until after October 15th.

The good news is if you're happy with the plan you are in you won't have to do a thing. You will automatically roll into the 2018 plan as long as it's still offered in your area. If you have any questions about Pre-AEP you can contact our office for more information.







When I got a hearing I told the lady in charge that something was wrong either with their machine or my card because I could not make a transaction after numerous attempts. She looked at my card, smiled sheepishly, and politely responded, "Mr. Dean, our machine will not accept your Visa card." Apologetically, I left the bank-not through the door, but under it!

Did I act foolishly? Oh, yeah. Was I embarrassed? Totally. But, I learned something from that experience. I learned to look closer at my own actions before I start finding fault in someone or something else.

I FRIEND OF MINE HAD slow internet issues recently. She was a bit frustrated at her internet provider and was afraid she'd utter bad words in front of the kids. So I offered to help her navigate the complexities of diagnosing

her issues--with her internet, not her bad words. She was ready to toss AT&T in favor of another provider. My friend wanted to arm herself before calling



AT&T to resolve the issue so here are the steps

The first step is to determine if you are getting what you are paying for and, for that, we need to do a speed test. To get an accurate reading, you need to perform this test on

a computer that is connected directly to your provider's modem using an ethernet cable. Using WiFi can sometimes give an accurate reading but we will cover that later.

So, with your computer connected directly to your modem with a cable, go to www.Speedtest.net and click the obvious button. It will give you your download and upload speeds. Those speeds ought to come close to what your invoice says you are paying for. For example, 16 Mbps download speed is fairly typical (for our purposes, we

aren't concerned with the "upload" speed that is listed). If you are paying good money for 30Mbps or more, you are (generally speaking) wasting money. Most families will be perfectly fine with no more than 16Mbps. If your download speed is far lower than what you are paying for, then that's most of the information you need to call your provider and scream at them.

Once you've determined how fast you can download over a wired connection, do the same test using any of your wireless devices such as a

notebook, tablet or phone. Your one part of your home, and speeds ought to be pretty close to what you got over the wired connection. If they are way slower--as was the case with my friend--then it is probably time to upgrade your wireless

You get what you pay for with wireless routers. The ones that are provided by your internet provider are generally acceptable for most people. But if you do a lot of video streaming, and especially play advanced games against internet opponents, then cheap routers just won't do. You'll need to purchase a router with 3 antennas and plan to spend upwards of \$170 to get a router that meets the demands of data

Cheap routers also don't have the range capabilities of the more expensive routers. So if you get acceptable speeds in say bad words when you're at the other end of your house, again, a nice router stands a good chance of reducing your utterances.

My friend eventually convinced AT&T to provide her with a new modem. She also got them to increase the speed for the same price she had been paying for a slower speed. So it's worth the call.

Dear Dave,

I have a savings account for my two-year old that has \$5,000 in it, and about half of that is in gold. I'm going to save for his college separately, and give this to him to help start his life after school. İs there a better place to put this other than a traditional savings account?

Dear Laura,

First of all, you should not invest in gold. Gold is a very volatile, very dangerous investment. I don't have a dime invested in gold, and I would strongly suggest that you not invest in it, either. If you take a look at the life-long track record on gold it will scare you to death.

For the time being, you can leave it all in a traditional savings account. But if he's not going to use it for many, many years you could move it into a conservative mutual fund. In fact, you started when he was at such young age, a nice, conservative mutual fund might be a really good

When he gets a little older, he can start adding to it himself from the money he makes from odd jobs and chores and such. After 15 years or so, thanks to your foresight and his contributions, he'll probably wind up with a pretty nice chunk of cash.

DEBT SNOWBALL REASONING

Dear Dave.

Why do you recommend paying off debts from smallest to largest when doing the debt snowball?

Michael

Dear Michael,

Lots of people think paying off the debt with highest interest rate first is the best approach. This seems to make sense mathematically, but I realized a long time ago if those people could do math they wouldn't be drowning in debt.

Debt not mathematical problem, it's a behavior problem. Personal finance is 80 percent behavior, and only 20 percent head knowledge. The reason the debt snowball pays off debt from smallest to largest — even though it may be mathematically incorrect — is that modifying your behavior and inspiring you to get out of debt is more important than math. Your probability of becoming wealthy has a lot more to do with your behavior than any sort of financial sophistication or academic degree.

When you pay off a small debt you experience success, and that gives you hope. Then, you move on the next largest debt. When you pay that one off – and yoû've wiped out two debts — it energizes you. At that point, you really start to believe in yourself and the fact that you're on the road to becoming debt-free!

Miracle Comeback

years ago. One of the greatest comebacks in Coffee High School football history took place at Howard Chappell stadium in Tuscumbia. The Coffee-Deshler annual classic produced some of the area's greatest games. 1977 would be no different. On this September night, fans were not expecting to see what would develop.

After the game Coffee fans were delirious. Deshler fans were left in a state of shock. Deshler featured the area's most potent offensive attack, led by quarterback Tim Inman and running backs Emanuel Young and Bobby Moore. But on this night it would be the Tigers' defense that gave the Yellow Jackets fits.

with the opening kickoff in 13 plays to take a 7-0 lead on a 34-yard pass completion from Paron Dillard to Ronnie Lewey that set up Kevin Stanfield's 2-vard touchdown run. Then the Tigers' defense took control. Deshler's Joe Grimes blocked a Coffee punt and Mike Steenson recovered it in the end zone for a game at 7-7.

In the second quarter, Deshler's Emanuel Young intercepted a pass and touchdown to give the



September 16, 1977. 40 Tigers a 14-7 lead. With Coffee threatening at the Tigers 9-yard line, a botched handoff popped straight up in the air and defensive lineman Boo-Boo Scott grabbed it and ran 91 yards for a touchdown. The extra point was blocked and the Tigers were on top 20-7.

Then the miracle comeback began for the Yellow Jackets. With just four-and-a-half minutes left in the game, Coffee quickly moved 43 yards and cut the lead to 20-14 when Kevin Stanfield broke four tackles on his way to a 21-yard touchdown run. After forcing a Tigers punt, the Jackets were 67-yards away from the end zone with just two minutes left to play.

Paron Dillard completed Coffee marched 80 yards a 58-yard pass and run to Tim Melson to the Deshler 9-yard line. On the next play, Dillard hit Tommy Hale in the end zone to tie the game. Coffee place kicker Rod Robinson was true on the extra point to give the Yellow Jackets a 21-20 lead. Game Over? Not quite. Deshler's Emanuel Young broke a long run inside the Jackets' 20-yard touchdown that tied the line to set up a potential winning field goal. Amid the excitement of

the moment, the Tigers called a timeout to set returned it 31 yards for a up the field goal. Only problem, they didn't have a timeout left. That resulted in a 5-yard penalty. On the next play, the field goal attempt was right down the middle, but fell three-yards short. Deshler coach Jimmy Lockett said: "it was just a typical Deshler-Coffee game during those days." Coffee coach Buddy Moore said: "it was the greatest comeback I've ever seen in my lifetime."
