





Artist Creates Larger Than Life



Nunda International Airport? No, it's the latest full size replica airplane constructed by George Lucas, a retired Art Teacher.

Replicated in detail, the airplane is a Heinkel 178, the world's first jet aircraft, flown in 1939. No original HE-178 exists today. The airplane was later shipped to the Planes of Fame Museum in Chino, California.

Lucas has constructed six other aircraft which reside in museums in California and

New York. And his last two planes are housed in the National Warplane Museum in Geneseo, New York.

George Lucas grew up in Warsaw, New York and graduated in 1960. After attending RIT, he graduated in 1968, having earned both a Bachelor's and Master's Degree in Art Education. His first teaching job was with BOCES, teaching between Mount Morris and Keshequa. After that, he took a full time Art Teacher position at Mount Morris Central School from 1968-1996.

Since his retirement, he has built seven full size replica airplanes and donated them to museums. As a youngster he built many balsa and plastic models. His earliest airplane was a glass airplane that once contained candy. He was about four years old.

The spark to build full sized aircraft came after he read the book, "The Blonde Knight of Germany," by Raymond Toliver. The book was about Erich Hartmann, the highest ranking

fighter pilot of WWII.

George met and corresponded with both men and even named his youngest son after Hartmann. He decided to build a full sized model of Hartmann's ME-109 as his first replica. George also corresponded with Willie Messersmitt, who designed the plane. George met both Hartmann and Toliver in Saint Louis at a P-51 pilots reunion. He's even traveled to Germany twice to attend a Luftwaffe pilots reunion.



Each airplane takes five to six years to complete.
