The famed traveler and then-Governor of the Upper Louisiana Territory, was traveling the old Natchez Trace on his way to Washington, DC from St. Louis. He died on October 11, 1809 at Grinder's Stand, an inn located on the old Natchez Trace, and was buried a few hundred yards away.





I was driving on a four lane road when a pickup truck from the other direction began swerving. This truck was hauling firewood on a small trailer behind it and some of the logs came off and hit my car, flattened my tire, bent my rim, and damaged the underside of my car. The estimate for my repair is over \$3000 but I let the guy go without calling the police because I just thought I had a flat tire. I did get his name and insurance information but the insurance company says that he doesn't have insurance on that truck and they won't pay without a police report. What can I do?

Peggy, Tuscumbia, AL

As you now know, a police report would help you resolve this matter. I hope everyone who reads my column understands that insurance companies are not helpful. Mayhem may be funny and talking

geckos are great but insurance companies do not pay claims they do not absolutely have to pay. They dispute every claim they can and when liability is clear they claim that the damages were caused some other way or are less than claimed.

There is no reason why the insurance company will take your word for the fact that your car was damaged by their insured. Without a police report, they will simply dispute your account of the facts unless their insured admits to what happened. They will not make much of an effort for that to happen. They

will drag it out and never pay you unless you make them. I don't think you will ever be paid voluntarily by the insurance company in this case. A trailer being towed is generally covered by the insurance on the vehicle towing it. If the vehicle was borrowed, insurance will follow the vehicle.

My advice is to get a thorough estimate of the damage by an experienced and licensed repair facility and then file a complaint in small claims court in the county in which the accident happened. Small Claims Court goes up to \$3000. District Court goes up to \$10,000 and any suit for damages above \$10,000 must be filed in Circuit Court.

If the person has insurance, the suit will get the insurance company's attention and you may get paid or you may have to have your repair person present in court to testify about how much it will cost to repair your vehicle. That is an easy four questions: What do you do? How long have you done it? Did you examine my car? How much will it cost to fix?

Just because an insurance company refuses to accept responsibility in no way means that the judge who listens to the evidence and the parties won't find in your favor. People are supposed to drive safely and secure their loads properly. Failure to do so is negligence. Remember that the Small Claims system is set up for people to use without the expense of an attorney.

Dear Ashley,



Open enrollment season for Medicare beneficiaries begins on October 15th and extends through December 7th. This is also known as the Annual Enrollment Period (AEP). AEP is an important time for anyone who is already on Medicare. These dates are very specific. You cannot enroll in a plan prior to October 15th or after December 7th unless you have a special circumstance.

AEP is specifically designed to give you an opportunity to enroll into a Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) or prescription drug plan (PDP) for 2018. If you are already on a MA or PDP it is the time for you to review your plan and determine if you want to make any changes for the next year. Either way there are some things that you'll want to consider.

If you are currently on or are considering a MA or PDP you want to look at the premium, copays, deductibles, coinsurance and the providers that take the plan. You will also want to look at the plan's drug formulary to be sure the prescription drugs you are taking are covered. Plan details can change from year to year so don't assume the 2018 plans will be exactly like the 2017 plans. Also, companies may introduce a new plan in your area for 2018 that may fit your needs better than the plan you are currently on.

A confusing thing about AEP is how Medicare supplements are treated. If you are on a Medicare supplement you do not have to wait until AEP to change plans. If you want to change to another supplement you can do that at any time during the year if you meet the new plan's guidelines. But if you are enrolled in a stand-alone PDP with your supplement the only time you can change the PDP is during AEP.





What are **Bankruptcy Exemptions?**



protection for a certain amount of real or personal property owned by its citizens against the claims of creditors.

Real Property (Homestead) Exemption

The Real Property exemption is also known as the Homestead exemption. The homestead exemption protects a specified amount of the value of the personal residence owned by an individual. Presently in Alabama, the homestead exemption is \$15,000 for each individual who is an owner of the personal residence. Therefore, married couples who are both on the deed can exempt up to \$30,000.

Personal Property Exemptions

The other type of exemption is the Personal Property exemption. Any property owned by a person that is not real estate constitutes personal property. The personal property exemption will protect property as varied as household goods and furnishings, automobiles, computers, jewelry, lawn mowers and lawn tools, personal tools, bank accounts or proceeds from a lawsuit for personal injury. Presently, the personal property exemption in Alabama is \$7,500 per person. Therefore, married couples can exempt up to \$15,000.

There are some categories of both real and personal property that are entitled to complete protection no matter what the total value may be. Worker's compensation benefits and social security benefits including both monthly benefits and any lump sum awards are both protected. Likewise, IRS qualified retirement accounts, which includes 401Ks and IRAs from your employment are 100% exempt from your creditors. Other lesser known, but equally untouchable are Burial plots, a church pew, books, pictures and portraits, wearing apparel and tools of trade (tools used specifically in your business).

The State of Alabama increased the limits of the exemptions listed above (Personal Property -\$7,500/\$15,000) and (Real Property - \$15,000/\$30,000) on June 11, 2015. This was the first time they had been increased since 1982. Fortunately, a part of that same bill signed into law on June 11, 2015, was that the exemptions would be automatically adjusted by the State Treasurer every 3 years beginning July 1, 2017. This adjustment would reflect cumulative changes in the consumer price index for the 3 year period ending on the December 31 preceding the adjustment date. The new figures will go into effect the following April 1. So beginning April 1, 2018, the new Personal Property Exemption will increase to \$7,750/\$15,500 and Homestead Exemption will increase to \$15,500/\$31,000. These figures will then change again on April 1, 2021, April, 1, 2024, etc.

Can we get some closure here?

Up. Down. Inside out.

Just a few ways someone's emotions might be described when they get the opportunity to be the

"seller" in a real estate transaction. If I had a dollar for every time I "thought" a buyer was going to make an offer on one of my listings, I would retire today. You know what I'm talking about, right? The buyer looks at the home three times, brings every relative in a 50 mile radius then asks for utility bills, who built the house or when the last time the central unit has been serviced.

They ask all the right questions. How old is this? How old is that? You get excited and start considering your options. You call your friends and say "someone is interested in the house!" Your emotions are at an all time high... and then, as if from an episode from The Twilight Zone, the buyer vanishes. They completely disappear from the face of the earth, leaving no trace, and worse, no feedback to the seller.

What happened to that buyer? I hear it weekly. An agent will call and say "Your listing on Anystreet is at the top of the list, they've asked for such and such, get it to me and I'll let you know". So, we get busy. We get the seller busy. The seller gets excited. We get excited.

And then, nothing.

Not a word, and to no fault of the agents involved. Sometimes the buyers just stop communicating. Sometimes you compile a whole packet of information for a buyer to pick up, and then they never even pick it up and never return your call.

As emotional as it is for the buyer in the process, it has to be 10X that for the seller. Running home for lunch to get the dog or put up dirty dishes, wondering all the time: "What did they think? How did the house look? Waiting for that any minute phone call that an offer is coming. You just can't worry about it. Provide the

information requested and try and think about something else. If someone is seriously interested in your home, they will follow through and you'll know it. Let your agent work to get the feedback, but if the buyer doesn't respond, it's just time to move on. I know it's frustrating, we deal with it everyday, but it's really all you can do...

Of course, you'll always wonder what happened to them. :) -mr
