Fresh Fruit Crumble

This easy goes-with-everything crumb topping is a perfect addition to whatever fruit's in season.

For the Magical Fairy Dust Crumb Topping:

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 cup old-fashioned oats
- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon finely grated lemon peel
- 3/4 teaspoon apple pie spice
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 10 tablespoons butter, cut up

For the Fresh Fruit Crumble:
Peaches, plums, mixed berries, apples or pears
Sugar
Vanilla ice cream, for serving
Whipped cream, for serving

1. Make the Magical Fairy Dust Crumb Topping: In mixer, mix flour, oats, brown sugar, lemon peel, apple pie spice and salt until combined. Add butter; beat until coarse crumbs form. With fingers, squeeze to form large chunks. Transfer to resealable plastic bag; freeze for up to 2 months.
2. Prepare the Fresh Fruit Crumble: Toss chopped fruit (whatever's in season) with a little sugar. Top with crumb topping. Bake at 375 F for 45 minutes or until fruit is soft and bubbly; serve with a scoop of vanilla ice cream or whipped cream.

Pointers For Parents

Start The Conversation Early: Tips On Kids And Alcohol

Vincent, MS.Ed., NCAC II, CDP, NESAP Public Health Analyst (NAPSA)—Talking to your kids about alcohol may feel like a daunting task, but doing so can help prevent future health challenges and risks. It's important to broach the topic early: Many kids have their first drink as young as 9 years old, and 50 percent of 15-year-olds have tried alcohol. Young people often begin drinking alcohol after experiencing stress, peer pressure, and difficult life transitions such as moving or divorce. While many adolescents consider drinking to be a rite of passage, the reality is drinking poses a serious threat to a young person's growing brain, development and overall health. By having several small, low-key conversations with your kids about alcohol, you can create a comfortable and open space for them to discuss the dangers of underage drinking and strategies for avoiding it, without feeling awkward.

Studies show that parents have a significant effect on young people's decisions about alcohol consumption, especially when they create supportive and nurturing environments in which their children can make their own decisions. And since so many kids begin to use alcohol at a young age, the sooner you begin talking to your children about drinking, the better. "Parents are the number one influencers on a young person. If every parent communicated a strong message about underage drinking, we would already have a delay on the onset of alcohol use," said Frances Harding, Director of SAMHSA's Center for Substance Abuse Prevention.

Teen alcohol consumption is a significant public health challenge nationwide. Nearly 23 percent of people between the ages of 12 and 20 are current alcohol users, according to the most recent National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH) report, published annually by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). This age group consumes alcohol more than any other substance, including tobacco and other drugs. While teens tend to drink less frequently than adults, they drink larger quantities, often having five or more drinks during a single occasion. According to

Casual conversations with your kids about drinking when they're young can help prevent underage drinking.

NSDUH, over 5 million adolescents binge drink, while 1.3 million are heavy consumers of alcohol.

This trend in underage drinking comes with significant risks. Adolescents who use alcohol are more prone to have legal issues and participate in unsafe sexual behaviors. They are more likely to have memory problems and changes in brain development that cause lifelong effects. They are also at increased risk for using other drugs, hurting themselves or someone else, and being dependent on heavy drinking later in life. There's a fatal risk, too: Underage drinking is responsible for approximately 5,000 teen deaths per year—mostly from vehicle crashes, but also from alcohol poisoning and other accidents.

You can help your children prevent these problems by talking to them early, and on a consistent basis, about the dangers of underage drinking. Continuing the conversation throughout adolescence, when the pressure to try alcohol increases, is also important. SAMHSA's "Talk. They Hear You" campaign provides support and tips for parents preparing to have these small but important talks. Helpful resources and advice can be found on the campaign's website, www.samhsa.gov/underagedrinking, including the downloadable "Talk. They Hear You" app—a tool that illustrates the dos and don'ts of talking to kids about alcohol use.

"Underage drinking is a preventable problem, and parents play a critical role in helping to save kids' lives," said Harding. "We want to help parents talk to their children about this issue."

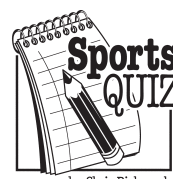

Don't Drive Damaged Goods

(NAPSA)—More than 725,000 vehicles driven on U.S. roads every day may be dangerous, according to new research from Carfax. These vehicles were damaged so severely in an accident, by fire or flood that DMVs across the country require permanent title marks to warn people about the damage. Still, thousands are back on the road in every state, and worse, many of the owners may have no idea they're driving a rebuilt wreck.

That's because some unscrupulous sellers resort to what's known as "title washing"; that is, they alter the car's documents. These criminals patch badly damaged cars back together, erase documented evidence of the damage and resell them to unsuspecting buyers in other states. Many of these cars are sold on free online classifieds sites, in busy parking lots and other high-traffic areas.

"I was shopping for a car for my daughter and arranged to purchase one off Craigslist that looked immaculate," said car buyer Scott Liker. "The seller asked if I could pay cash and told me the vehicle had a clean title. I went to Carfax and was shocked to find it was issued a salvage title out of Florida. Within days, the vehicle was titled in Tennessee and a month later was in Missouri, now with a clean title. I was shaking, because I had just dodged a bullet." North Carolina, Mississippi, New Jersey, California and Georgia have the highest number of these potentially dangerous vehicles.



Thousands of people are driving potentially unsafe vehicles—but you don't have to be among them.

Crooks also seem to be moving and reselling these vehicles in cities along the I-40 corridor, the research suggests.

"Hundreds of thousands of people driving unsafe vehicles is a serious threat to public safety," said Larry Gamache, Carfax communications director. "In addition, anyone duped into buying one often pays thousands more than the car's really worth. Insisting on a vehicle history report and mechanic's inspection first will help you avoid unknowingly buying a car with major problems that crooks made disappear on paper."

Hints For Home Buyers

Buying A Home May Be Easier Than You Think

(NAPSA)—For anyone dreaming of owning a home, a look at one young couple's success story could prove inspirational.

Recent college grads Jacob and Katherine closed on their first home a week after their wedding.

- 2. Don't Let Student Loans Get In The Way.** Jacob explained that he had some pretty heavy student loans. "But I focused on paying off those with higher interest rates. Once we got those under control and started saving again, we started the home-buying discussions."
- 3. Trust Your Real Estate Agent.** "Our real estate agent spent a lot of time with us. He got straight to the point and was very honest. He helped us figure out what we wanted, where we wanted to live and what we could afford," Jacob said.
- 4. Look In The Basement First.** "Our real estate agent advised us to look at the guts of the house first. Don't be distracted by things like granite countertops and stainless steel appliances," Katherine said.
- 5. If You Don't Have A 20 Percent Down Payment, Consider Private Mortgage Insurance.** Katherine and Jacob had saved up for a down payment, but it wasn't enough for the 20 percent down required by many lenders for borrowers who don't finance with mortgage insurance. With private mortgage insurance, borrowers can buy a home with as little as 3 percent down.
- 6. Down Payment Funds Can Come From A Gift.** Although they were good savers, Katherine explained, most of the funds for their down payment came from their parents.

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- On Oct. 16, 1773, the first public statement against the British Parliament's Tea Act, a document known as the "Philadelphia Resolutions," urges all Americans to oppose the British tax. Two months later, a group of colonists disguised as Mohawks boarded three British tea ships and dumped 342 chests of tea into the harbor.
- On Oct. 22, 1797, Andre-Jacques Garnerin makes the first parachute jump from a hydrogen balloon 3,200 feet above Paris. As he had failed to include an air vent at the top of the prototype, Garnerin oscillated wildly in his descent, but he landed shaken but unharmed.
- On Oct. 17, 1906, Wilhelm Voigt, a 57-year-old German shoemaker, impersonates an army officer and leads an entire squad of soldiers to help him steal 4,000 marks from the mayor's office. Voigt humiliated the German army by exploiting their blind obedience to authority. The Kaiser thought the story was funny.
- On Oct. 20, 1944, U.S. Gen. Douglas MacArthur wades ashore onto the Philippine island of Leyte, fulfilling his vow to return to the area he was forced to flee in 1942 under orders from President Franklin Roosevelt.
- On Oct. 21, 1959, the Guggenheim Museum, home to one of the world's top collections of contemporary art, opens in New York City. The bizarrely shaped white concrete building resembled a giant upside-down cupcake. Today, 900,000-plus visitors visit the Guggenheim yearly.
- On Oct. 18, 1968, John Lennon and Yoko Ono are arrested for drug possession in London. Days earlier, an announcement that Ono was pregnant created a scandal because both were married to other people.
- On Oct. 19, 1985, the first Blockbuster video-rental store opens, in Dallas. The store had 8,000 tapes displayed on shelves and a computerized checkout process. At it's peak in 2004, Blockbuster had 9,094 stores.

Now here's a tip! by Jo Ann Derson

- Use Lego people to hold your charging cables when not in use. Their hands are the perfect size to hold cords, and you can stick the figures to a small Lego base that's secured to whatever is convenient — a table edge, your night stand or even the wall itself — with some double-faced tape.
- "New shoes too tight? Wear a pair of thick socks, and slip your shoes on. Run a hair dryer over the areas where it's too tight, and the heat will help those spots expand. Test in an inconspicuous area first if you are unsure that the fabric can take the heat!" — C.W. in Oregon
- Got your cellphone wet? Try the rice trick first. Power down if possible and remove the protective cover, then fill a zipper-top plastic baggie with plain uncooked rice. Insert your phone and seal the bag, making sure that all parts of the phone are surrounded by the rice. Let it sit for 12 hours so the rice can draw the moisture from your device. Then try to power up.
- "Want to seal your sugar bag (or any all-plastic bag)? Fold over the top at least an inch, and cover the fold with a strip of aluminum foil — both sides. Lay the bag on its side. Iron the fold, which is trapped inside the foil. It melts the plastic inside. Let cool and remove the foil!" — R.Y. in Kentucky
- Need to get into a crevice for cleaning? Position a condiment cap (the ones that come with a squirt bottle) on the hose of a vacuum. Now you can get the crumbs in a keyboard or that little spot under the fridge, etc.




