


PUBLIC NOTICE VILLAGE OF ALBION Fall Brush & Leaf Pick-up

SHERIFFS INVESTIGATE FATAL ONE-CAR CRASH **IN TOWN OF MURRAY**

The Orleans County Sheriff's Office is investigating a fatal one-car accident in the Town of Murray. The Orleans County 911 center received a call reporting

a one-car accident on Fancher Road. It appeared that a vehicle traveling northbound on Fancher Road went off the east side of the road and down into a ditch and traveled along that ditch until striking a culvert pipe. The sole male occupant, William H. Weidinger, 43, of Murray was transported by Monroe Ambulance to Strong West Hospital, where he was pronounced dead. LITTLE THINGS, **BIG PROBLEMS**

Well, bow season for deer is up and running and some nice bucks have already been taken. My neighbor Adam got a beautiful 8-point the first day that will score around 120 B&C. I have seen some really nice bucks late this summer and there seem to be more bucks around this year.

Beechnuts, apples trees and oaks are producing great amounts of fruits this fall, so if you know where some of these trees are in a out of the way place it would be a good idea to "guard" them with bow in hand!

If you connect or not there is something out there that is really small, but you should be on guard for – ticks. Especially the real small deer tick that seems to becoming more prevalent which can cause some serious health issues. This tick, smaller then a dog tick, can carry Lyme disease bacteria and when left untreated can become serious. Rashes, fever, fatigue, muscle aches and other flu-like symptoms can ensue. The infection can be treated with antibiotics and cases can progress to more serious and long-lasting illnesses.

These ticks can be picked up from brushing up against grasses and shrubs that these ticks linger on to grab on to a passing host. Mice are a big carriers of these ticks and also deer. With the warm weather we have been having the ticks are still quite active and so bow hunters needed to be on alert for them on their bodies. A deer hunter who is successful may unknowingly get a tick or two while field dressing or when carrying his or her deer out of the woods.


If the tick is removed before it has gorged itself with the victim's blood they maybe be OK, but keep an eye on the area that it was attached to. Of course the best thing is to find it before it attaches itself to your skin.

So how can you prevent getting this tick on you? Spray a repellent containing a 20 percent concentration of DEET on clothing and exposed skin. You can also treat clothing (especially pants, socks and shoes) with permethrin, which kills ticks on contact, or buy clothes that are pre-treated. (Do not use this product on your skin, though.)

Another precaution is to check for ticks on all parts of your body after being outdoors. Usually ticks have to be attached for at least a day before transmitting the bacteria that cause the Lyme disease.

Remove the tick with tweezers by grasping the tick as close to the skin as possible and with a steady, slow motion pull the tick's body from the skin. Cleanse the area with an antiseptic. Ticks can also be clinging to your clothing so it would be a good idea to run them through a hot dryer to kill them. The early diagnosis and proper treatment of Lyme disease are important strategies to avoid the costs and complications of late-stage illness. As soon as you notice a characteristic rash or other possible symptoms, consult your health care provider.

Lyme disease is usually marked by a red bullseye rash at the site of the bite, fatigue, chills and fever, headache, muscle and joint pain or swollen lymph nodes. Many of the symptoms of Lyme disease are similar to those of other diseases such as arthritis so it is always wise to check with your doctor.

Pets are at risk too and they can transport the ticks into your home. The Medina Veterinary Hospital has had a number of Lyme disease cases this past summer so you need to make sure you pet is protected too.

As this Lyme disease spreads, and it seems to be doing that, us outdoor folks need to take more preventative measures and keep alert to possible ticks on our person.

Blackberry-Ripple Lime Cheesecake

Serves 10



1 1/2 cups pecans
 2 tablespoons sugar
 1/4 cup (1/2 stick) unsalted butter, melted

FILLING

- 2 6-ounce packages ripe blackberries
 2 tablespoons packed light brown sugar
 1 teaspoon cornstarch
 1 1/2 pounds cream cheese, at room temperature
 1 14-ounce can sweetened condensed milk
 2 teaspoons finely grated lime zest
 1/4 cup fresh lime juice
 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- 3 large eggs, at room temperature



1. Position a rack in the middle of the oven and preheat the oven to 350 F. Generously butter the bottom and sides of a 9-inch springform pan.

2. To make the crust: Pulse the pecans, flour and sugar in a food processor until the nuts are finely ground. Add the butter and pulse just until combined. Press the crust evenly over the bottom and 1 inch up the sides of the pan. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes, until light brown. Transfer to a wire rack and cool completely. Reduce the oven temperature to 300 F.

3. To make the filling: Mash the blackberries and sugar together in a medium saucepan with a pastry blender or a fork. Cook over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until the berries begin to release their juices. Stir in the cornstarch, bring to a boil over medium-high heat, stirring constantly, and boil for 1 minute. Pour the purée through a coarse strainer set over a small bowl, pressing hard on the solids to extract as much liquid as possible. Refrigerate, tightly covered, until thoroughly chilled.

Gradually beat in the condensed milk, zest, lime juice, and vanilla, scraping down the side of the bowl as necessary. Reduce the speed to medium and add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition. Pour the batter into the pan.

5. Transfer the blackberry purée to a small glass measure. Drizzle it in a spiral pattern over the batter, then swirl a table knife through the batter to marbleize it. Bake for 55 to 60 minutes, until the cheesecake is puffed on the sides and still slightly jiggly in the center. Let cool on a wire rack.

6. Refrigerate the cheesecake, tightly covered, for at least 8 hours, until thoroughly chilled and set, or for up to 2 days.

7. To serve, run a sharp knife around the edge of the pan to loosen the cake and remove the side of the pan. Cut the cheesecake into thin wedges with a sharp knife dipped into hot water and wiped dry after each cut.
