Mayor proclaims October Housing America Month in Laurel

The signing of a proclamation by Laurel Mayor Johnny Magee Thursday, October 12, declaring October as Housing America Month in the City of Laurel recommitted the city’s endorsement of the National Housing America Campaign, its goals, objectives and purposes. October is part of a year-long national campaign to inform the public and decision makers in a community of the critical need to address the nation’s housing and community development concerns.

Magee was joined by members of the Laurel Housing Authority staff, resident leaders, and board of trustees for the proclamation signing. Board of Trustees members present included Rev. George Barnes – Chair, Sandy Holifield, and Tensie Wheeler.

Laurel Housing Authority Executive Director Ailrick Young thanked the Mayor and all for attending the event. He expressed how important it is to continue to bring awareness of the need for affordable housing. “Most people do not realize the challenge of availability for those seeking affordable housing,” said Young.

The proclamation states, “According to the State of the Nation’s Housing report, nearly 41 million households now pay more than half of their income for housing. More than four out of five households with incomes below \$15,000 paid more than 30 percent for housing. Accord-

ing to current estimates, on any given night, there are nearly 650,000 homeless nationwide and up to 3.5 million persons who experience homelessness at some point throughout the year. According to the National Low-Income Housing Coalition’s 2017 Out of Reach report, in no state can a full-time minimum wage earner afford either a one- or two-bedroom rental unit at Fair Market

Rate. Public housing is home to more than 2.3 million people, 37 percent of who are children, and faces an estimated more than \$26 billion backlog in capital repairs.”

According to Young, future plans for the Laurel Housing Authority include the renovation of existing affordable housing as well as the possibility for new construction.



MS Bicentennial Gallery of Laurel Storytellers on display

In celebration of the Mississippi Bicentennial, Laurel was chosen to be one of ten cities across the state to participate in a project facilitated by Blue Magnolia Films entitled “Celebrating Storytellers: Home is Our Heritage.” A walking gallery of the project is now on display in storefront windows throughout downtown Laurel.

In July, the City of Laurel engaged community leaders to produce a series of photo documentaries based on the unique characteristics of Laurel’s founding, its ability to maintain its traditions as well as attract a steady trend of young people moving here today. The project, sponsored by The Chisholm Foundation, debuted nine works in a public screening at Lauren Rogers Museum of Art.

Those participating in the project and the title of their video includes Akeem Davis (free agent, NFL); “Brick by Brick,” Katrina Cox (Choral Director, Maddox Elementary School); “The Gift,” Samantha Nowicki (Lauren Rogers Museum of Art); “The Legacy of Lauren Rogers,” Richard and Portland Brown (Hair World); “The Chair/1964” about his life as a barber, Larry and Pamela Thomas (Thomas Pharmacy); “Like Father, Like Son,” Chris Wilson (realtor); “The 8th of May” a story about his wife, Holly, Joseph Cooley (artist); “The Woodcut Fun House,” highlighting artist Sean Star Wars, Katelyn Bryant (teacher, Maddox Elementary School); “Papaw”—Charlie Bryant and Brooke Davis (Black Horn Productions); “For the Love of Okra,” a story about Pearl Campbell, who just opened The Pearl Diner in downtown Laurel.

A walking gallery of the nine projects has been set up in downtown Laurel with 20 five-foot by five-foot gallery quality photo images displayed in the store windows of several buildings.

“Each display has a QR Code in the shape of Mississippi where anyone can walk down the street, scan that QR Code, and interact with each story,” explained Alison Fast, founder of Blue Magnolia Films. “The video will pop up on your phone and both visitors and residents alike can celebrate with some of the people of Laurel and the rich history, identity and values of Laurel while they’re in the

downtown area.”

The gallery in Laurel is one of ten galleries being displayed around the state to commemorate the MS Bicentennial. By December 9, the Laurel gallery along with the other nine galleries across the state will be taken to Jackson and all 100 stories will be displayed in the downtown Jackson area. One story from each city will be integrated into a final screening.

The gallery and screening will coincide with the opening of the Civil Rights and History Museum in Jackson.

Fast added, “Storytelling is a powerful way to pay homage to the themes that have carried Laurel from its beginnings and will continue to guide the success stories of people who live here and make Laurel ‘home’.”

In talking about the initial work on the project, Fast said additional support was provided by Laurel Mayor Johnny Magee, Laurel Chamber of Commerce, and local caterers Marilyn Fuquay and Rod Hol-

lins/Hi5Eats.

“This process went way beyond just telling a story,” exclaimed Chris Wilson. He went on to explain how an invitation to “come and let’s talk,” turned into an experience that all participants will not soon forget. How a small group of diverse individuals who grew up in different times and cultures began to break down barriers and build lasting relationships. “In just two hours of talking in a circle and eating a catered dinner, suddenly there was a common goal. We were talking among one another and in between one another so that there wasn’t a barrier between us.”

“The community screening elicited unexpected emotions from teary eyes, to big smiles, to nods of hometown pride,” stated Magee. “Never in a million years would I have thought that Laurel could be such a successful part of this Bicentennial collection. Laurel is a very special place and this project reveals it for all to see.”

West Jones takes down Laurel in Soso

Call it for what it is.
Soso had itself a night of biblical proportion late Friday when West Jones took down Laurel at Mustang Field, 17-7.
The David and Goliath match, when considering the past several years, shook at the core of Region 3-5A as the script of recent years was flipped. West Jones (6-2) improves to 4-0 in 3-5A as Laurel (4-4) falls to 2-2 in 3-5A.

"The difference in the game was we got enough first downs to keep their explosive offense off the field," said WJ head coach Scott Pierson. "Laurel wasn't able to get in a rhythm because when they start rolling, you can't stop them. They never got on a roll tonight."

EERIE FLASHBACKS
It felt like 2015 all over again at the half. The last time West Jones hosted Laurel in Soso — just over two years ago, September 25, 2015 — the first half was a defensive

standoff. Neither team had points to show for.
Friday night, after two quarters of play, West Jones had the only points of the night. Junior Walker Thompson sailed his 39-yard field goal attempt through the uprights with 5:30 to go in the first stanza. It gave West Jones a 3-0 lead, a score that held till the clock struck 1:52 in the third.
In 2015, Laurel scored 37 second-half points to put the game away. Friday night, Laurel wasn't so lucky, and West Jones was just that good.
The Mustangs out-scored the Tornadoes in the second half, 14-7, to pull out the stunning victory.
MUSTANGS DEFENSE
West Jones' defense held Laurel to 200 yards of offense.
Pierson believes his defensive front is his best during his tenure in Soso.
"We've known all year that our defensive line would be

our strength," Pierson said. "We didn't play well early in the year, but we went back and got a lot of techniques fixed.
"If you go back to the first of the year, I said we have the best defensive line we've ever had here. And now they're starting to play up to their potential."
Anchored by the nation's No. 17 junior defensive end,

Byron Young, West Jones kept Laurel behind the sticks for the majority of the night with sacks and tackles for loss.
At the end of the first half, Laurel only managed 23 yards of offense on 17 plays. West Jones, on the other hand, advanced the ball 174 yards on 41 plays.
The Mustangs allowed Laurel just 10 first downs

compared to the 17 it gained. Senior running back Austin Land kept the chains moving for West Jones, rushing the ball 36 times for 168 yards.
LAUREL COMEBACK ATTEMPT
With just over three minutes remaining in the game, Laurel junior quarterback Sinclair Ulmer hit senior wide receiver Brandon Gordon on an eight-yard touchdown pass to narrow the lead held by West Jones to 10-7.

West Jones shut the door with an answer on its following possession. Facing fourth down and four yards to go on Laurel's 25-yard line, quarterback Dusty Cook found senior wide-out Garrick Randolph down the middle of the field for a game-sealing TD pass

with 2:41 left to play.
"To be honest we were trying to milk the clock," said Pierson. "I looked at Coach Blackledge and asked him if he had anything he really liked. He said 'yeah, I like seven on the post.' I told him let's do it. And fortunately for us, it was the right call."
The Mustangs forced a Laurel fumble on the kickoff to run down the clock and further kill hopes of a Laurel comeback.

WHERE THEY GO FROM HERE?
West Jones travels to the Reservation to take on South Jones in a Region 3-5A and county showdown. Laurel returns home to take on Forest Hill. Kickoffs are slated for 7 p.m.

accelerator the whole night, even after grabbing a big lead. That's an important trait for a team wanting to go deep into the playoffs.

MISSED TACKLES
The Braves missed some tackles early against North Pike, although the defensive coaches had them in position to make plays. The defense eliminated a big chunk of those misses in the second half. One thing you can be assured of with this Braves' de-

fense — they have some guys that will flat out hit you. Two names that come to my mind as I jot this down are Jason Jarrell and Terrell Keys. Opposing quarterbacks and running backs would do well to find No. 28 and No. 55 on the Braves' defense, before the ball is hiked, and try to find somewhere else to run. There is a price to pay to run their way.

high school football is the halftime show, especially when the show is really good. Well, the South Jones band and the dance team are both really exceptional!
