SECURITY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT CLASS EXPOSED TO ROLE OF MEDICAL EXAMINER



Security and Law Enforcement teacher Steve Browning, Tyshen Finn (Newfane), Chloe Pilc (Royalton Hartland), Neal Hodgson, Courtney Garver (Lyndonville), Anthony Hanel (Barker) and Security and Law Enforcement teacher Dudley Gilbert. Security and Law Enforcement teachers, Steve Browning and Dudley Gilbert, recently invited retired medical examiner Neal Hodgson to speak to their juniors at the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center.

Mr. Hodgson talked to the students about his former career and showed the students an autopsy video and some photos from cases that he worked on. He talked to then about cases that made an impact on him and what they may encounter as law enforcement when attending accidents or crime scenes.

Chloe Pilc, a student who attended the lecture, says she found the autopsies interesting as well as Mr. Hodgson's observations and reactions. "He showed a photo of a little girl that was beaten to death and he got very emotional. I want to be a police officer and you have to think about that; you will see sad things like that." Classmate Tyshen Finn says he wants to go into the military. It would be hard to deal with dead bodies. "There was a crazy amount of information that he showed us. Some of it was very graphic."

Mr. Hodgson has been lecturing to students from elementary schools to college from over 50 years. He is known for being frank on his experiences and brings up subjects like opiate addiction and what he believes will be a rise in suicide in young adults who won't be able to hide their addiction once they graduate from school. "I have been preaching about this epidemic for years and no one would believe me and now it is happening everywhere from inner cities to affluent neighborhoods." Student Armanie Abrahams says he was shocked when Mr. Hodgson said that in their combined classes that one out of eight would become addicted. "I started counting around the class and how many people that would be, that is a lot of kids!"

Darien Monaghan says he thought Mr. Hodgson was very down to earth. "I think seeing all the pictures was pretty cool. I had a chance to talk to him and he told me no cop wants to be the one to go to the morgue. I really don't think that would bother me if I had to. I found it interesting what is inside a human body and in some ways my imagination was worse than what actually does happen."

The students said that so far in their time at Orleans/Niagara BOCES, they have enjoyed their Security and Law Enforcement program. Darian says, "I absolutely love this program. It's the highlight of my day. I really look up to Mr. Gilbert. He takes all that boring book stuff and makes it fun by telling us his own little stories and experiences." "I like it here a lot," says Armanie. "The teachers are a lot of help. They try to give everyone as many opportunities as they can."

QUESTIONS

Lately I have been getting quite a few emails and phone calls about various subjects and although I don't have definite answers for them all here are my best guesses.

Where have all the birds gone at my feeder? The big thing this year is the weather! By nature birds are used to foraging for seeds and insects with the use of feeders only becoming important to them when the weather turns stormy. Have you ever noticed that the birds flock to your feeders just before and during a big snowstorm? That's because it is more difficult

for them to fight the storm to forage and so they take advantage of your feeders. As we all know the summer has continued into the fall with some beautiful days to be out there in nature and so it is with the birds. Insects which are usually tucked in for the winter are active yet and that means protein for the birds. There has also been a mass crop produced by mother nature this year with many of the trees and bushes. My driveway has been covered with beechnuts this fall, so much that I had to use the leaf blower to move them. Of course squirrels and chipmunks love them, but so do many of the birds and they flock to them often times "holing up" in the surrounding area of the beechnut trees. Acorns in many places are abundant and the bigger birds such as blue jays and woodpeckers love them. My woods around the house are mainly sugar maple and they have produced a super crop of seeds this year. I got up on my metal roof, which is relatively flat, the other day to clean the chimney and there were piles of them laying around, not to mention how the driveway was just covered with them. Again another natural source of food for the birds.

It was also a great season for apples and walnuts which are not really food sources for birds, but they sure are keeping the squirrels and deer happy! And speaking of deer I have also been getting a few calls from folks who have neighbors that are putting apples out in their neighborhoods to feed the deer in order to observe them. This of course is illegal with the reason being it concentrates deer in small areas which can lead to diseases being spread. With the big concern with chronic wasting disease among our deer today this feeding of deer could spreading this fatal disease and others. The other problem is that as more and more deer begin to show up (they are able to find this bonanza of food through the scent and trails of the deer already using the feeding site) the neighbor shrubbery and flowers get completely eaten. With Lyme disease becoming more prevalent now there is also real concern that all these deer are bringing in the deer tick that causes it. This in turn makes backyards an unsafe place for ourselves, our pets and children. Keep feeding the deer in your backyard and it will come back to bite you and your neighbors in the butt.

Another popular question right now is: What happened to our fall colors? I know some folks who headed up to the Adirondacks for the big "color burst" the end of September, but there wasn't really much. Around here the leaves are drying up and falling with out changing color. I usually look for a great fall foliage show around camp (Allegheny County) around the 10th of this month, but there wasn't much going on. Many of the trees around here have shed their leaves already and I have had to look hard to find any fall colors to photograph. So what has happened?

Weather is responsible for this too; high temperatures and a dry September. It has just been too warm and it has put mother nature out of sequence. This summer was followed by a very hot, dry September, which allowed the leaves to continue producing the chlorophyll that keeps them green. Thus, the reds, oranges and yellows (hidden inside those green leaves) are not getting a chance to show. It looks like most are falling now just because they are drying out and we probably have lost our "WOW, look at the foliage" chance for this year.

Now I have a question for my readers. Why is it that folks coming to observe and enjoy our two state wildlife management areas and the Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge are such litter bugs?

The trash along our roads is a real eye sore and it comes from the "butt heads" traveling through our area and just tossing their crap out the vehicle windows, but what about the trash I see at the parking areas and overlooks on the refuges? Gee, come to see the beauty then throw your crap out the windows and leave. I often thought it would be nice to follow someone like that to their home and then come garbage day take all my garbage and dump it in their yards!

Pheasant season opened Oct. 21, and the duck and goose season opens Oct. 28, just so you know we are not at war!





Gift Auctions Can Successfully **Raise Funds**

In an effort to add some creativity traditional fundraisers, many charitable groups have begun to rely on gift auctions. Gift auctions, sometimes referred to as a "tricky tray," ask participants to silently bid on various prizes. Each prize is put on display and participants go around and place prepurchased raffle tickets into bowls or bags beside the prizes. After bidding has concluded, an emcee will select a winning ticket from each collection of entries and read out the winner's name or ticket number. Depending on how many prizes are available, gift auctions provide hours of fun-

Organizing a gift auction requires a team of dedicated volunteers. Here are some guidelines to begin.

- · Establish the event date and venue Before any gifts can be collected, set the date for the auction and secure a location. The location should be large enough to display all of the prizes. A school gymnasium or the party room of a firehouse or fraternal lodge may suffice. The date and time should be convenient for adult participants, as gift auctions are often to events that cater to adults.
- Collect prizes. The prizes can be purchased by the organization hosting the auction, but organizers can also solicit donations from local businesses and individuals. Prizes can range from photography packages with a local photographer to gift certificates to area restaurants to vouchers for trips to zoos or other family-friendly activities. Prizes also can be categorized by value For example, grand prizes may include vacations or furniture. Categories can be determined once all the gifts have been purchased.
- Sell entry to the event and prize tickets. Some organizations prefer to sell entry packages to participants. This may include an entrance fee to the event as well as a number of tickets that can be used at the auction. Naturally, more tickets will be available for sale at the night of the event. Advertise the gift auction well in advance to generate interest. Mention a few of the bigticket prizes in any advertisements to increase interest.
- Enlist a team of gift-wrappers. Presentation may determine bids and increase those bids. Ask for donations of baskets and wrapping materials, such as ribbon and cellophane. Each bidders to bid high and bid often.
- Deliver all of the prizes to the venue and configure the room. Create a festive atmosphere for the gift auction. Place prizes on tables around the perimeter of the room so they can be easily viewed. Set up the middle of the room with tables where participants can sit. You may want to assign tables to certain large groups of friends who prefer to sit together.
- Encourage participants to enjoy food and drink. Refreshments can make the event more lively, and selling refreshments is another way to raise money. Offer a selection of beverages, both alcoholic and nonalcoholic, as well as chips and other finger foods. Consider catering the event or asking for volunteers to bring in food pot-luck

 Enlist day-of-event volunteers. Volunteers willing to work during the event can carry the prizes to the winning bidders and answer any questions guests might have throughout the auction.







Why Clean **Air Filters Are Important**

Vehicle owners likely know to check fluid levels and get their cars' oil changed, but air filters may not be at the top of their maintenance checklists. Despite being a relatively inexpensive part, air filters often go overlooked.

Air filters have an important job in a vehicle, prolonging the life span of engines and helping cars run more smoothly and efficiently.

Purpose of vehicle air filters

Vehicle combustion engines operate with a mixture of fuel and air. Without oxygen, gasoline or diesel fuels cannot burn properly and power the engine. The air filter's job is to prevent dirt, dust and other debris from being sucked into an engine. Otherwise, grime can build up and impede engine performance or cause erosion of parts under the hood.

It is much more cost-effective to routinely change air filters than replace expensive engine parts. Rather than ignoring air filters until the last minute, drivers can take steps to keep filters clean and functioning at peak performance.

- · Improve fuel efficiency. Clogged air filters reduce air flow to engines, resulting in an improper ratio of air to fuel. As a result, spark plugs can be negatively affected and the engine may idle roughly or misfire. These scenarios can greatly affect fuel efficiency as well as cause engine deposits from rich fuel. To save money and trips to the fuel pump, replace filters regularly. According to GearHeads, for older cars, studies have indicated that by replacing a dirty air filter, one can improve gas mileage by as much as 14 percent.
- Reduce stress on the engine. Because of the air-to-fuel mix in engines, even a mixture that is slightly off balance can affect what is going on under the hood. That means the engine must work harder to get enough clean air into the chamber to complete the combustion cycle, says the Automotive Training Center.
- Enjoy more power. A filter that is saturated with dirt will restrict air flow. In such instances, drivers may notice a lack of power during acceleration. Replacing the filter can easily restore that pep.
- Reduce vehicle emissions. Environmental concerns are a priority for many people. By keeping the engine working properly, with the advantage of clean, unobstructed air entering the chamber, a vehicle may produce lower emissions.

Replacing air filters is an easy fix that many drivers can do themselves, or ask their mechanics to do during oil changes or other repair shop visits.

Signs Rotors May Need to be Replaced

The braking system of most vehicles consists of brake pads, calipers and metal discs called rotors that work to slow down a vehicle. When the vehicle needs to stop, the calipers squeeze the brake pads against the spinning rotors. Because a lot of friction is generated, rotors, like brake pads, need to be replaced periodically. However, drivers may not know when these components need to be changed or if other services can be done to prolong the life of the rotors a little longer.

The first step is to inspect the braking system. A healthy brake rotor will be smooth and have an uninterrupted surface that is free of dust, grooves and grit. If brake pads have caused grooves to form, the pads or the rotors may need to be replaced.

Another tactic is to listen for brake noise when driving. Mechanics state that noise is commonly associated with bad brake rotors. If the rotors produce squealing or squeaking noises or even scraping noises while braking, they may need to be replaced.

Warped rotors also may produce vibrations that can be felt when the brakes are applied. A pulsing or rough feeling can vibrate through the entire chassis.

Speak with a qualified mechanic to see if a lathe can be used to shave off a little of the rotors and get a few more miles out of them. Otherwise, to ensure safe, adequate braking, rotors will need to be replaced anywhere from 30,000 to 70,000 miles depending on the type of brake pads and motorists' driving

VIN Etching

Vehicle identification number etching, or "VIN etching," is a theft deterrent in which an automobile's VIN, 17-character code consisting of letters and numbers unique to each vehicle, is etched onto the vehicle's windows. Some manufacturers may etch the VIN onto the windows of all of their vehicles, while others may not. Dealerships may charge VIN etching fees to buyers of new vehicles, but buyers should always consult their insurance companies before agreeing to pay such fees. Some insurance providers do not discount premiums for vehicles with VIN etching, while others might. Drivers may not want to pay VIN etching fees if their insurance providers will not discount their premiums, so it pays to consult with providers before purchasing a new vehicle. In addition, drivers who want to save money on etching fees but still do all they can to deter prospective car thieves may want to purchase their own VIN etching kits, which typically cost around \$20. ■



Prevent Breakdowns with Battery Care


Many drivers have experienced the misfortune of getting into their vehicles only to realize their engines won't turn over. Although there may be plenty of reasons why a car will not start, quite frequently a dead battery is to blame.

Car batteries can last for five years or more when properly cared for, but many batteries wear down and become inefficient within three years of daily use. According to the UK-based company Warranty Wise, car batteries deteriorate with every charge from a vehicle's engine. Naturally, drivers who are stranded by dead batteries wish they had done more to prevent their battery dying while they're on the road. Certain factors might offer clues as to how much life vehicle batteries have left.

- · Longer start time: A dying battery may cause the engine to crank, but it can be slow to start or not seem to exude a lot of power.
- · Cranks but doesn't start: You may turn the key to hear the engine trying to turn over, but it won't. Even if the vehicle eventually starts, have the battery checked and, if necessary, replaced by a mechanic.
- · A jump start has been necessary: Batteries that have required a jump or multiple jumps are on their last legs and should be replaced immediately.
- · Dim lights or check engine indicator: Batteries powers the electric components in a vehicle, so dim lights could be indicative of a loss of power. Having the "check engine" light come on also can be a clue.
- · Extreme temperatures: According to Firestone, hot or cold temperatures can shorten a battery's life. If you live in an extreme climate, your battery may not last as long as the manufacturer suggests it should.
- · Short driving trips: People who take many short trips (less than 20 minutes each) may find their batteries do not have enough time to fully recharge, shortening their life expectancy.
- · Pungent aroma: Leaking and corrosion around the battery terminals can cause battery issues. If there is a rotten egg smell under the hood, it may be a leaking battery on its way to dying.

Drivers can have their vehicle batteries tested by mechanics. Batteries can be replaced at home or at a garage. Servicing the vehicle frequently can prevent performance inefficiencies and help determine if any components are straining the battery and causing premature loss of battery life.







Buying a Condo Not the Same as Buying a Home

Stringent lending policies and the escalating costs of home ownership have led many prospective home buyers to consider condominiums instead of single-family homes. Condos are typically less expensive than single-family homes, which makes lenders and borrowers alike feel more comfortable. Lenders feel better because the loans aren't as large, while borrowers are more comfortable because such loans allow them to improve their standing with lenders, potentially setting the table for a low-interest home loan down the road.

But the differences between buying a condo and buying a single-family home go beyond the bottom line. The following are a few things prospective buyers should know about condos before they view any properties.

- · Condos come with fees. Unlike single-family homes, condos come with homeowners association fees. These fees cover the cost of maintenance and repairs to the property. This includes landscaping and garbage collection, as well as general repairs throughout the condominium complex. Fees vary significantly from community to community, and the best deal is not always the one with the lowest homeowners association fees. Low fees tend to provide less bang for the buck, generally covering only the most basic services. Higher fees often mean the community offers more amenities, such as a private pool and gym for residents. Some people prefer such amenities, while others would rather find better deals on their own. But prospective condo buyers must include fees in their monthly budgets when determining how much they can afford to spend.
- · Condos come with rules. Owners of single-family homes can create their own rules for their households, while condo owners must agree to follow rules established by the homeowners association or the property management firm responsible for maintaining the community and enforcing the rules. Rules may not allow pets or only allow pets of a certain size. Other rules may restrict how owners can decorate their condos during the

holiday season or how they can furnish the exterior of their properties, limiting patio furniture to a set number of chairs or tables. Some condo owners are glad such rules are in place, while others might find such stipulations intrusive. Each community has different rules, and prospective buyers should familiarize themselves with a community's rules before buying any properties within that community.

- Condos often have management firms. Property management firms can be great to deal with, but they can be troublesome as well. A good property management firm produces satisfied community members who speak glowingly of their communities, while a poorly run management firm can frustrate homeowners who feel they are not getting what they're paying for. Some property management firms fail to collect homeowners association fees for months at a time, only to send letters demanding back dues down the road. Others simply don't live up to expectations, failing to make repairs in a timely manner while letting the property fall into disrepair. If possible, speak to current community residents about how the property is managed. If residents are not available, potential buyers should attempt to attend a homeowners association meeting, which can shed light on what it's like to live within a given community and how accessible the management firm is to community members and how well it tends to those members' needs.
- Condos are not as private as single-family homes. Much like apartment dwellers, condo owners often share walls with neighbors. That means condo owners will have to sacrifice some privacy. Prospective buyers who consider privacy a top priority may want to continue living in an apartment until they can afford to buy a single-family home. Though condo owners rarely have someone living above or below them, sharing walls with neighbors is still not as private as owning a single-family home.

Condominiums are great options for people who want to own their homes but don't have enough money or credit history to buy a single-family home. But buyers must educate themselves about condominium life before signing on the dotted line. \blacksquare



Strategies to Avoid Holiday Weight Gain

Staying fit during the holiday season can be quite challenging, even for the most ardent fitness enthusiasts and disciplined calorie-counters. Between Thanksgiving and New Year's Day, many people are offered a wide assortment of foods, beverages and other indulgences - typically in mass quantities.

According to researchers at Stanford University, although the average person only gains around one pound during the holiday season, quite frequently that pound sticks around, and those extra pounds add up year after year. As a result, it doesn't take too many years of holiday bundt cakes to gain a considerable amount of weight.

Holiday season weight gain is not unique to the United States and Canada. Investigators at Tampere University of Technology in Finland tracked weight gained in the United States, Germany and Japan during those countries' festive times and found that each country's participants gained weight, particularly during the holiday season. Annual holiday weight gain can contribute to weight-based problems such as obesity, heart disease and Type 2 diabetes.

The holiday season might not be the best time to start a diet, but holiday eating does not have to derail healthy lifestyles. The following are ways to avoid holiday weight gain and still enjoy all of the parties, adventures and time spent with friends and family.

- Focus on festivity instead of food. When hosting holiday festivities, make the bulk of the celebration about an activity rather than food. If guests are focused on fun, such as a sing-a-long, dancing or tree-trimming, they may be less likely to overeat.
- Don't show up starving. Eat a light, healthy snack before participating in any holiday revelry. Hunger pangs may drive one straight to the buffet table.
- Survey your options prior to eating. Guests should scope out the food choices and then make the smartest selections possible. Avoid creamy sauces, greasy foods and those that are heavy on cheese. Fill up on vegetables and then you won't feel bad about splurging on a dessert.
- Go sparingly on alcohol. People seldom realize how quickly calories from beverages can add up. A 12-ounce glass of beer has about 150 calories, a five ounce glass of red wine has about 125 calories and a 1.5-ounce shot of gin, rum, vodka, whiskey, or tequila has about 100 calories, according to the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism. Furthermore, alcohol lowers inhibitions, so you may be more likely to overindulge in more spirits or extra food when intoxicated.
- You can't buy back calories with exercise. Putting in a marathon exercise session the next day probably will not undo the damage done from overeating the night before. Maintain a consistent workout schedule all
